BRITISH DELEGATION BELIEVES PALESTINE QUESTION WILL NOT COME UP AT SAN FRANCISCO

SAN FRANCISCO, April 24. (JTA) -- British Deputy Prime Minister Clement R. Attlee, addressing a press conference today in behalf of the British delegation to the United Nations Security Conference, which opens tomorrow, said that he did not believe that the Palestine problem would come up at the conference even in connection with the question of international trusteeships for mandated territories.

Queried by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency as to how this international trusteeship idea over mandated territories would affect Palestine, he said that that would have to be worked out at the conference which will establish machinery to deal with the problem. But the British delegation, he stated, did not come to San Francisco with any recommendation concerning an international trusteeship over Palestine.

The question of whether Palestine should be put under an international trusteeship should be "put up to the Palestinians," Mr. Attlee added. He emphasized that the idea of an international trusteeship was designed to raise the standard of living of people in the mandated territories.

Pointing out that the depression which followed the last war was responsible for promoting Nazism and increasing anti-Semitism, Mr. Attlee said that he wanted the San Francisco Conference not only to set up a security organization to prevent wars, but also a prosperity plan through the Economic and Social Council in order to make such phenomena impossible.

THOUSANDS OF JEWS AMONG RUSSIAN AND POLISH TROOPS FIGHTING INSIDE BERLIN

MOSCOW, April 24. (JTA) -- Thousands of Jewish soldiers are among the Red Army-men who are fighting today in the streets of Berlin. Also participating in the battle for the German capital is the First Polish Army in whose ranks are many Jews whose families were killed by the Germans and whose homes were destroyed.

In two orders-of-the-day issued last night, Marshal Stalin mentioned many high Jewish officers among those cited for breaking into the Reich's first city. Among them were Maj.-Gen. Bukshtynovich, Lieut. Gen. Kazankin, Tank Maj. Gen. Weinrub, Artillery Maj.-Gen. Folkenstein, Col. Glessner of the Engineers and others.

BUCHAREST JEWS HOLD MASS MEETING IN SUPPORT OF SAN FRANCISCO; ASK JEWISH STATE

BUCHAREST, April 24. (JTA) -- Ten thousand people jammed the Bucharest synagogue and adjoining streets today at a meeting called by all Jewish organizations to urge consideration of Jewish problems at San Francisco.

The audience adopted a resolution urging a Jewish State in Palestine, after participating in special prayers for the success of the conference. Minister of Public Works Gheorghiu Dej urged full Jewish participation in the fight to smash fascism in Rumania and reinstate democracy. Members of Jewish youth groups paraded before the American, British and Russian legations following the meeting.

POLISH ARMY COMMANDER CHARGES UNITS OF LONDON GOVT'S FORCES IN POLAND KILLING JEWS

MOSCOW, April 24. (JTA) -- Some members of the Polish Home Army, affiliated with the Polish Government-in-Exile in London, have gone underground and are attacking Jews in many small towns, Gen. Michal Rola-Zymierski, commander-in-chief of the armed forces of the Polish Provisional Government, charged today.

Gen. Rola-Zymierski told correspondents that the chief offenders were sections of the "NSZ" units of the Home Army, which were formed by the anti-Semitic Endek Party. He stated that in addition to physical assaults on Jews, during which some have been killed, these underground forces are spreading anti-Semitism in Poland.

"They are no longer an army, but a political group," the Polish commander said, "and we plan to liquidate them in due time." Confirming earlier reports that last month several Jews were killed by these units, Gen. Rola-Zymierski said that "by attacking defenseless Jewish people, they only prove their own rottenness."

The Lublin radio reported today that seventy percent of the workshops in Cracow whose Jewish owners were killed by the Germans have been reopened. It also disclosed that Dr. Boleslaw Drobner, a member of a well known Cracow Jewish family, has been appointed mayor of Breslau.

Premier of Govt.-in-Exile Denies Underground Failed to Aid Ghetto Uprising

NEW YORK, April 24. (JTA) -- The Polish Telegraph Agency today released a statement by Polish Premier Tomasz Arciszewski, in London, which took strong exception to an alleged charge by Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum, president of the American Federation of Polish Jews, that the Polish underground had refused to help the uprising in the Warsaw Ghetto in April, 1943. Dr. Tenenbaum is reported to have made the charge at a meeting in New York last week to commemorate the uprising.

"I was in Warsaw during the Ghetto uprising, and as one of the leaders of the Polish underground movement - in the ranks of the Polish Socialist Party - I am witness to the fact that all Poles, both official and unofficial, did their utmost to help their Jewish fellow-citizens in their heroic struggle," the Polish premier stated. "I would like to add that many entire Polish families were murdered by the Germans for the very offence of trying to conceal Jews."

JE WHO LED COMMITTEE OF LIBERATION IN BOLOGNA SENT TO REICH, BELIEVED KILLED BY NAZIS

BOLOGNA, April 24. (JTA) -- Mario Jacchia, a Jewish lawyer who headed the Committee of National Liberation in Bologna, was abducted and probably killed by Mussolini's Black Brigades last October, a Jewish Telegraphic Agency correspondent learned today.

Mario Vistoli, an anti-fascist lawyer who was in hiding here until the city was liberated on Saturday, told the correspondent that Jacchia, who was famous throughout all Italy, vanished last October. In November, the Black Brigade announced he had been captured and taken to Germany, alleging that a list of 180 anti-fascists had been found upon him.

600,000 OF HUNGARY'S 900,000 JEWS KILLED DURING OCCUPATION, SWEDISH DIPLOMAT REPORTS

STOCKHOLM, April 24. (JTA) -- Six-hundred thousand of Hungary's 900,000 Jews were killed during the German occupation of the country, according to a statement by an attache of the Swedish legation in Budapest published in Stockholm newspapers. Not all Jews were sent to Germany to die, he said, reporting that it was a common sight to see Jews undressed on the embankments of the Danube, shot and thrown into the river.

GROUP OF JEWISH DEPORTEES REACH SWITZERLAND FROM SLOVAKIA; PLACED IN INTERNMENT CAMP

BERN, April 24. (JTA) -- Sixty-nine Jewish deportees from Slovakia, including men, women and children, have arrived in Kreuzlingen, the Neue Zurichser Zeitung reports.

The paper says that two trucks carrying the deportees were allowed to cross into Switzerland, and after being fed at Kreuzlingen, the arrivals were transferred to an internment camp. Among them are Rabbi Halberstam from Stropkow and Rabbi Weismandel from Mitva.

YUGOSLAV GOVERNMENT ALLOTS \$250,000 FOR AID FOR DESTITUTE JEWISH WAR ORPHANS

LONDON, April 24. (JTA) -- The Yugoslav Ministry of Social Welfare has allotted 10,000,000 dinars (nominally \$250,000) to aid Jewish orphans without relatives or property, the New Yugoslav Telegraph Service reports today.

The announcement said that "although a very small number of Jews survived the horrors of Belgrade and the concentration camps at Jajince and Poland, the care of this small number is still a difficult problem. Therefore, the Jewish Community, not having financial means, appealed to the Ministry for help."

JEWISH BOY SCOUTS GREETED BY CHEERS AS THEY PARADE DOWN CHAMPS ELYSEES

PARIS, April 24. (JTA) -- Five hundred Jewish Boy Scouts were greeted by enthusiastic cheering today as they marched down the Champs Elysees as part of a parade of 35,000 scouts, which was organized by Lady Baden-Powell, widow of the founder of the scout movement, and Gen. Pierre Koenig.

The Jewish scouts, headed by Capt. Robert Gamzon, rescued 2,000 children during the German occupation, issued 25,000 false identification papers and formed a Jewish signals unit which lost 40 killed and 30 captured and deported in battles with the Germans.

BRITISH AUTHORITIES PROMISE TO PROBE DISTRIBUTION OF ANTI-JEWISH LITERATURE

LONDON, April 24. (JTA) -- The Attorney General's office has promised to investigate the distribution of anti-Semitic literature by a former member of Sir Oswald Mosley's British Union of Fascists, it was disclosed here by D. N. Pritt, Laborite, M.P.

Mr. Pritt informed the Attorney General that Victor Burgess, the former BUF member, was using his bookshop in Middlesex as a distribution center for anti-Jewish leaflets and pamphlets. Burgess is director of propaganda for the League of Ex-Servicemen whose meetings in Hyde Park last winter aroused strong protest because of the anti-Semitic remarks made by the speakers.

SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT URGED TO SEND PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION TO BUCHENWALD

JOHANNESBURG, April 24. (JTA) -- Government party deputies, shocked by the disclosure of German atrocities at the Buchenwald and other camps, suggested today that a delegation of parliamentarians, including several of the nationalist anti-war members, be sent to Germany to inspect the camps. One member urging this said that "that is the only way in which anti-war elements in South Africa can be shown how their 'friends' have shocked the world."

THE THREE ASKED TO REPEAT WARNING TO GERMANS ON CAPTIVES, SPECIFICALLY MENTIONING REICH JEWS

LONDON, April 24. (JTA) -- The Big Three's failure to mention German Jews in their note issued yesterday, warning Gestapo men and other guards not to molest Allied war prisoners or deportees, was protested today in a memorandum sent to Prime Minister Churchill by the New Zionist Organization.

It pointed out that a repetition of the warning with specific reference to non-allied Jews, such as "stateless" persons and Axis nationals, would relieve the anxiety felt in Jewish circles and would remove the possibility that Allied policy might be misinterpreted by the Germans.

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF POLISH JEWS WILL BE HELD IN NEW YORK NEXT MONTH

NEW YORK, April 24. (JTA) -- An international conference of Polish Jews will open here on May 26, with delegates from Poland, England, Palestine, Canada and Latin-American countries in attendance, it was announced today by the American Federation of Polish Jews which is sponsoring the meeting.

Addressing a press conference here, Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum, president of the federation, also reported that the organization is launching a campaign for \$500,000 for the cultural rehabilitation of Polish Jewry. Discussing the need for clothing, food and medicine, he said that about \$350,000 in cash and supplies have already been collected for that purpose, and some supplies are already en route to Poland.

ARGENTINE JEWRY URGED TO INTENSIFY EFFORTS ON BEHALF OF JEWISH WAR VICTIMS IN EUROPE

BUENOS AIRES, April 24. (JTA) -- Intensification of efforts on behalf of Jewish war victims was urged here today at the annual meeting of the DALL, central organization of Argentine Jewry, attended by more than 100 delegates representing fifty affiliated organizations and seven branches of the DALL outside of Buenos Aires.

Dr. Moises Goldman, who was re-elected president of the DALL for a two-year term, reported on the organization's recent activities in connection with anti-Semitic agitation here, the prohibition of ritual slaughtering and the question of religious instruction in the public schools. Dr. Goldman reported that the DALL has made contact with non-Jews for joint action to defend Jewish rights.

QUITO PAPER HAILS N.Y. ANTI-BIAS LAW; CITES SIMILAR PROVISION IN ECUADOREAN CONSTITUTION

QUITO, Ecuador, April 24. (JTA) -- The adoption by New York State of legislation barring discrimination in employment has aroused considerable interest and editorial reaction here.

The influential newspaper El Dia, in an editorial commenting on the JTA dispatch reporting the new law, points out that a similar provision is in the recently adopted Ecuadorean constitution, although little publicity has been given to it. It cites Paragraph 2 of Article 141 which declares: "The State guarantees equality before the law. All discrimination based on class, sex or racial differences is punishable."
