MINH AGENCY MEMO TO SAN FRANCISCO DEMANDS GUARANTEE OF JEWISH RIGHTS TO PALESTINE

SAN FRANCISCO, May 2. (JTA) -- A formal memorandum was submitted here today with Jewish Agency for Palestine to the United Nations Conference, demanding that with rights to Palestine should be "expressly reserved and safeguarded," in the settir up of any general mandate or international trusteeship plan. The memorandum was simed by Dr. Chaim Weismann.

Recognizing that specific territorial questions may not be considered at to conference, the Jewish Agency submitted three proposals which it considered "impative for the preservation" of Jewish rights pending action in fulfillment of te obligation to establish Jewish nationhood in Palestine. The three proposals are:

- 1. In view of the unique character of the Palestine mandate and the spedil rights of the Jewish people thereunder, any plan which may be adopted for a manhis system or an international trusteeship in succession to the existing system of the league of Nations mandates should be sufficiently flexible and broad in scope to Finit within its framework of the solution of the Palestine problem in accordance nth the underlying intents and purpose of the Balfour Declaration and the Palestine Emate.
- 12. No action should be taken at the San Francisco Conference which would wimonsistent with or prejudicial to the special rights of the Jewish people under the Balfour Declaration or the Palestine mandate, and all such rights should be exressly reserved and safeguarded.
- 3. The Jewish Agency for Palestine, as an internationally recognized immenan of the Jewish people, shall be consulted and given representation on any inbintional body or commission which may be set up in so far as they may have before Lia matters affecting the future status of Palestine and the rights of the Jewish pople with respect thereto."

Outlines Program to Meet Present Needs of Jewish People.

The memorandum of the Jewish Agency outlined five steps which it believes but be taken if the original intention of the mandate, and if the present day needs "the Jewish people are to be fulfilled. The program includes:

- 1. The immediate announcement of a determination by the responsible powers b reconstitute Palestine as a free and demogratic Jewish commonwealth thus carrying with underlying intention and purpose of the Balfour Declaration and the mendate.
- *2. The abolition forthwith of all present restrictions and limitations on in device immigration into releatine and the rights of Jews to purchase and settle on the land theres
- 13. The vesting of the Jewish agency for Palestine with full authority our immigration into Palestine and with the necessary powers for upbuilding the watry, including the development of unoccupied and uncultivated land.

The granting to the Jewish Agency for Palestine of the right of consulting and representation in any international conference or commission which may be stup, in so far as such conference or commissions may have before them matters of noting the future status of Palestine and the rights of the Jewish people with respect thereto."

The memorandum concludes with a plea for a solution of the problem of Jewish hoselessness. It gives the solemn assurances of the Jewish Agency that "the Jewish fate will have sorupulous regard for the preservation of the personal and propity rights of the Arabs and other non-Jewish populations of Falestine." It plages
father the civil and religious equality of all the inhabitants of Falestine before
the law, and says that "the inviolability of the holy places of the various religions
will be guaranteed by appropriate international agreement."

The Hebrew Committee for National Liberation announced at a press conference today that it had submitted a formal demand to the Secretary General of the conference urging the seating of a "Hebrew national delegation" here and the inclusion of a "Hebrew national movement" in the General Assembly of the proposed security ormanisation.

In urging such representation, Peter Bergeon, speaking for the liberation committee, asserted that the United Nations had already set a precedent for such a step by giving official recognition to the White Russian and Ukraine republics.

Arabs also Submit Views on Palestine to Conference

The league of Arab States recently formed in Cairo today submitted its tharter to the secretary general of the conference, thus placing on record, smong other things, the attitude of the pan-arab league towards the Falestine question.

Addressing yesterday's plenary session of the conference the Iraquian Fweign Minister Arshad Al-Omari, who heads Iraq's delegation here, emphasized that file of the states who joined the leggue are attending the conference and "are resolved to assist in creating an international organization capable of realising all or ideals for the welfare of humanity." He urged the conference "to have due regard for fair regional representation" in the new world organization.

At least one member of the American delegation has voiced a warning against including members of the Arab delegations on "Committee Number Four," which will deal with international trusteeships, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learns from reliable sources. The member, whose name cannot be revealed, warned becretary of State Stattiuss and other leaders of the conference that the work of the committee may be pre-ladied by having Arabs on it since the latter have a special interest in the Palestime mandate.

Field Morehal Smuts, addressing the plenary session of the conference in lehalf of South Africa, pleaded for an international bill of rights and for establishment of a commission on human rights.

Judge Joseph M. Prograuer, president of the American Jewish Committee, who is one of the consultants to the U. S. delegation here, addressing a meeting in the Sectian Rite auditorium, last night, under the auspices of the Rational Conference of Christians and Jews, explained that an international bill of rights must be adopted in order that the security conference may be able to give direct protection against the excesses of nationalism in various countries.

RID APPRAIS TO U. S. DRIEGATES AT SAN FRANCISCO TO BACK JEWISH COMMONWEALTH

WASHINGTON, May 2. (JTA) -- An appeal for establishment of a free, democrath Arish commonwealth in Pelestine was made today by Senator James Me Mead, Democrat of Mr York, in a telegram which he sent to the four Congressional representatives on the United States delegation at the San Francisco conference.

Urging "the principle of fair treatment for the Jews," Senator Mead called for imdiste unrestricted Jewish immigration and colonization of Palestine. He said that the kws have borne the brunt of the burden of Nazi atrocities and "should at least us to able to find comfort in Palestine which has bloomed as a product of Jewish enterpies." The Senator asked the Congressional representatives to take affirmative which guaranteeing fulfillment of promises made to the Jews after the first world war.

COMISSIONER NAMED TO ASSIST MILAN JEWISH COMMUNITY: AMERY SAYS JEWS WORSE THAN NAZIS

MILAN, May 2. (JTA) -- The National Liberation Committee's commissioner here smanned today that, in view of the fact that most of the members of the Milan Jewish examity council are missing. MAY JEWISH GROUPS IN PARTS MAY DAY PARADE: SURVIVOR OL OSWICEIM AMONG MARCHERS

PARIS, May 2. (JTA) — Exhausted and bruised, and still garbed in his striped Fison clothes, Alexander Braun, a 48-year-old Paris Jew, yeaterday merched in the May By parade here, bearing aloft a placard reading: "I am a survivor of Oswiecim."

S. soldier Pased by in a jeep, they greated him in Yiddish and he smiled, waving his hand in Greting.

ETRN HOME OF ALL SOVIET CITIZENS WEG SOUGHT REFUGE IN PAIRSTINE WILL BE FACILITATED

JERUSALEM, May 2. (JTA) - Lieut. Col. Karesov of the Soviet Commission for the Repetriation of Soviet Cittisens and Mar Phisoners, who arrived here this week, anmaned today that all Soviet citisens and service personnel who were compelled by the France to leave their homes, and who, after confinement in Germany or other countries, Needed here may return home immediately and do not have to wait for the end of the war.

EVALUATION JUST RELEASED FROM BUCHENWALD NAMED MAYOR OF WEIMAR BY U.S. AUTHORITIES

IONDON, May 2. (JTA) -- Professor "X", a Jew whose name cannot be given for sentity reasons, has been named Lord Mayor of Weimar, which adjoins the Buchenwald secondation camp from which he was liberated a few days ago, the Daily Express results.

The paper quotes the U.S. military governor of the area, Major William Som, as stating that "We will try at least at Weimar to found a new Germany based mirredom and peace. Weimar was the seat of the post-World Wer I German constitutional assembly which gave its name to the pre-Hitler republic.

A News-Chronicle correspondent in Germany, reporting on a visit to the Sandkestloon, says that 243 children there, most of them Jewish, owe their lives "and matremains of their health" to one of the heroes of the camp, Oscar Friedmen, a Beljan war prisoner, who, because he was a Jew, was sent to the worst camps.

When the demoralized children arrived at the camp, the correspondent says, they are the rey of oriminal elements among them who sought to curry favor with the gards by killing their companions, thus securing larger food rations. Friedman, he says, "taught the boys the value of sticking together and organized their rations."

ES AT BUCHEMIAID URGE ADMITTANCE TO PALESTINE OF ALL SURVIVORS IN CONCENTRATION CAMPS

LONDON, May 2. (JTA) — The Parliamentary delegation which recently visited Mehameld received while there an appeal from the Jewish aid committee formed in the camp, urging them to allow Jews freed from concentration camps to enter Palestine, it was learned today.

The text of the letter reads as follows: "Dear Sirs: You are visiting Germa consentration camps. The Jews still there are the last of continental Jewry. Maware, at the most, a few tens of thousands men or women and very few children. All the others have been murdered.

"In the name of the Zionists left alive we beg you to open the gates of Alestine and make it possible for these people, after the inexpressible horrors of the last few years, to make life worth living, in a Jewish community. Give them a chance to start a new life."

Haned by Rep. Diekstein of New York, chairman of the committee, the sub-comdities will deal with all naturalisation and citizenship problems, with the Fort Ontaic refugee camp at Oswego, and also with prisoners of war, the Japanese in this saning and deportation matters.

NUMER MAYOR OF JERUSALEM NAMED HEAD OF ARAB PROPAGANDA BUREAU IN WASHINGTON

MEW YORK, May 2. (JTA) - Dr. Hussein Fakhri El-Khalidi, one time mayor of grusslam, and president of the Arab Reform Farty in Palestine, has been mamed chairas of the Arab Bureau of Propaganda in Washington, the Institute for Arab American judits has announced.

The Institute, whose headquarters are in New York, also announced that its resident, Faris S. Malouf, has been sent to San Francisco to assist the Arab delegitions there, and to establish branches of the organization in San Francisco and los igales. The New York Arab newspeper As-Sayeh reports that the institute has resided gifts, recently, totalling \$4,000, and urges its readers to give generously to the organization, which, it says, is helping "defemi the Arab cause by upholding man rights in Pelestine and other lands."

Another Arab newspaper, as-Sameer, commenting on the composition of the Arab algation at San Francisco, points out that professors of history and philisophy are in the delegations, and adds: "Zionist propagandists at San Francisco will have to with their well-known tortuous sophistry to show how their case can stand on the music of either historic fact or of pure reason."

MEMBAUN IN REPLY TO ARCISZEWSKI REITERATES CHARGES POLES FAILED TO AID WARSAW JEWS

NEW YORK, May 2. (JTA) -- Replying to a statement by Premier Tomas Arcissemin of the Polish Government-in-Exile, which challenged charges by Dr. Joseph Tenentma, president of the American Federation of Polish Jews, that the London Government's unlerground forces in Poland did not assist the participants in the Warsaw that revolt, Dr. Tenenbaum today reiterated his accusations, citing evidence given brollsh Jews now in France and Palestime.

Declaring that although many individual Poles undoubtedly gave their lives to help lows, Dr. Tenenbaum quoted testimony by refugees in Paris who stated that "ht small groups, but tens of thousands of Poles have given help to the German occumition authorities in the externiation of hunireds of thousands of Jows and the externiation of Jewish property." Similar reports, he said, "are coming in constantly tom fel Ariv, from prisoners of war freed by the Red Armies. As for the charge that is Polish underground did not help the uprising in Warsaw, I choose from a mass of lists the statement of Dr. Berman, head of the Jewish underground in Poland, released it a conference of the members of this organization in Warsaw a few days ago.
