LA WILL ASK INTERNATIONAL SAFEGUARDING OF HUMAN RIGHTS AS AMENDMENT TO DUMBERTON OAKS

SAN FRANCISCO, May 3. (JTA) - Speaking on behalf of the American delegation to the United Nations Conference on International Organization, Commander Harold E. besen told a press conference today that the delegation has pledged itself to work to sh the development and safeguarding of human rights, without regard to race, or relinon, one of the basic purposes of the international organization which will be established here

Provisions for international implementation of that purpose will also be nommended by the U.S. delegation, Commander Stassen said, emphasizing that this Medies will be one of the amendments to the Dumbarton Oaks proposals which the delegation will submit to the conference.

The decision of the U.S. delegation to embody the demand for safeguarding d human rights among its amendments to Dumbarton Oaks was taken last night, and came as insult of a petition signed by 25 of the civic organizations who are consultants to the delegation, including the American Jewish Conference and the American Jewish Comnittee .

Led by Prof. James Shotwell and Judge Joseph M. Proskauer, president of the Merican Jewish Committee, these consultants insisted, in an interview with the U. S. blegates, that a Commission on Human kights must be established as part of the propred international organization and that the U.S. delegation must take the lead in demnding the establishment of such a commission.

Not all members of the U. S. delegation were at first agreeable to this de-EM, it is understood, but after the consultants met late in the afternoon with Secretary of State Statinius, he promised that he would place the petition before the Merican delegation and use his influence to have the principles it outlined included is the Dumberton Cake emendments.

Stassen Says Palestine Mandate "Will Remain Where It is"

Commander Stassen, who has been designated by the American delegation to decl With the trusteeship question in behalf of the United States Government, today told this correspondent in an exclusive interview that "the Polestine Mandate will remain there it is and that no changes are contemplated now.

He explained that the committee dealing with the trusteeship system will first attempt to secure the agreement of all members of the United Nations in its re-Aut which will not refer to any specific territory. He indicated that a recommendation with regard to the Palestine Mandate will have to come from Britain as holder of the mendate some time after the machinery for dealing with mandated areas is established.

Meanwhile, leaders of the American Jewish Conference have approached members

d the committee on trusteeships, requesting that the Jewish Agency be consulted before the committee adopts a formula on the trusteeship plan.

The member of the New Zealand delegation who will be named chairman of the memtes is known to have pro-Zionist sentiments. OUT FRACTION OF JEWS IN NORTHERN ITALY STILL ALIVE: JDC REPRESENTATIVE REPORTS

MIAN, May 3. (STA) -- Only a fraction of the pre-war Jewish population in untern Italy is still alive, it was reported today by Reuben Resnik, Joint Distribution Committee representative in Italy, who raced through the recently liberated titles with an artillery regiment of the 34th Division.

Resnik said that he found that only 400 of Bologna's 1,200 Jews remained; in kdem there are 150 of 300; in Ferrara 60 survivors of 600; 70 of Parma's 600; and may 500 in Milan, which had a Jewish population of 10,000. However, Resnik said, 1,000 Milanese Jews fled to Switzerland and others may be hiding in the hills, and mill eventually return.

STRANSST NEWSPAPER CHARGES DR. WILLIAM FILDERMAN WITH COLLABORATING WITH ANTONESSU HIGHM

LONDON, May 3. (JTA) -- Dr. William Filderman, president of the Union of memias device Communities, is charged with collaborating with the Autonesou Government in the restrictive measures which it imposed upon Jews, in an article in the lefting busherest newspaper Romania Libera, according to information received here.

(JTA) -- A violent attack on German refugees residing in within was voiced in the House of Lords today by Lord Ailway who charged that there we 40,000 "Germans" in England occupying thousands of homes. HOW BOWER CONGREGATION ADOPTS ANTI-ZIONIST BY-LAW; ASKS WARC QUIT JEWISH CONFERENCE

EATON ROUGE, La. May 3. (JTA) — In a statement assailing what it alleged at interpresentation occasioned by Zionist leaders who presume to speak for all of briefs Jewry. At the same time, the congregation released the text of a letter sent to had werice Elsendrath, director of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, containing resolutions protesting against the membership of the Union in the American with Conference, which is described as "becoming more and more a mere cover up import of the Zionist Organization of America." Flexner was associated with the Joint Distribution Committee in various specifies since shortly after World War 1 when he went to Eastern Europe for the DC stream on the executive committee until 1939. Tribute to his "unforgetable record terms" was paid today by Paul Baerweld, chairman of the DC.

Mr. Flexner was born in Louisville, Ky., on Peb. 26, 1865. He is survived to brothers, Dr. Abraham Flexner, former head of the Institute for Advanced Study threeton University and Dr. Simon Flexner, formerly of the Rockefeller Institute is Edical Research, and a sister Mary.
