RET SUBMITS ADDITIONAL MEMORANDUM ASKING UNCIO TO GUARANTES JEWISH RIGHTS IN PALESTINE

SAN FRANCISCO, May 14. (JTA) -- A five-point supplementary memorandum my specific amendments to the various trusteeship proposals which would guarantee with rights in Palestine was summitted by the with gency to the United Nations Conference on International Organization during seeing, it was disclosed today at a press conference addressed by Henry Monsky W. Mehum Goldmann.

Another memorandum asking that the Big Four joint amendment to the Dumwim Caks proposals be enlarged so as to call for not only promotion and encouragestd respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms, but for protection and signating of those rights and freedoms was submitted to the UNCIO by the joint multee of the American Jewish Conference, the World Jewish Congress and the Board families of British Jews, Monsky revealed.

Dr. Goldmann announced that two American engineers who have been working to TA have been sent to Palestine in connection with the Lowdernilk plan which wides for the irrigation and electrification of large areas in Palestine so as to be possible the absorption of additional hundreds of thousands of Jewish immigrants. Dr. Goldmann defined "Jewish Commonwealth" as meaning "a majority of the blitants in the country to be Jews." Asked whether the Jews would be willing to accept a plebisoite in Palestine, a foldmann replied that such a plebisoite would have to be conducted also among Jews satisfied Palestine since the Palestine mandate affects the Jewish people as a whole and recognize the Jewish Agency, which represents the Jewish people of the world, as the official representative for Palestine.

In explaining why the Jewish Agency found it necessary to submit a suppleminy remorandum to the UNCIO, Dr. Goldmann said: "It has been repeatedly stated but the Falestine question will not be on the agenda of this conference because terintrial questions are not to be discussed. We are, therefore, vitally concerned the my trusteeship plan which is written into the United Nations charter shall expessly sefeguerd the rights of the Jewish people to Falestine and shall place no chateles or impediments in the way of the exercise of those rights.

"An examination of the various trusteeship proposals reveals that the defluition of the purposes of the trusteeship is couched in general terms," Dr. Goldmann antimed. "As a result adequate allowance is not made for the unique character of the Relstine mandate with its dynamics in matters of population and its objective of meeting a national home for a people still to come to the country.

The five proposals offered in the supplementary memorandum of the Jewish keep urged the UNCIO to:

- "l. Include in the chapter of the charter of the United Nations dealing with international trusteeship a clause designed to preserve existing Jewish rights expired under the mandate system of the Lague of Nations.
- "2. Center responsibility for the transfer of League of Nations mandates to the authority of the United Nations in the hands of the permanent members of the namity council together in the case of any particular territory held under manist by a United Nation not a member of the security council with the nation holding meh mandate.

"3. Define the beneficiaries of the trusteeship system so as to take into account the rights of the Jewish people as a whole to Jewish immigration and attach in Palestine.

- "4. Qualify provisions for non-discrimination or the 'open door' in reput to trusteeship areas by imposing requirements of reciprocity.
- "5. Vest the General Assembly and the Social and Economic Council with Per sufficient to enable them to carry out their supervisory functions in regard to tratechip areas."

ROME, May 14.
