106 EAST 41st STREET, NEW YORK 17, N. Y. EL-GURION WARNS OF "BLOODY" EVENTS IN PALESTINE: SAYS JEWS WILL NOT TOLERATE "GHETTO"

NEW YORK, June 21. (JTA) - Reiterating his warnings of bloody events in blestine if the White Paper is not abolished by the British Government, David Benbrion, chairman of the executive of the Jewish Agency, told a press conference here they that only American public opinion can prevent "a big tragedy" by convincing Mittin that Palestine must be open to Jewish immigration.

"I speak in the name of all the 600,000 Jews of Palestine when I say that we we not ready to tolerate any longer the White Paper restrictions," Ben Gurion said. 'I not for our strong desire to help the Allies in winning the war, we would have cased tolerating these restrictions long ago. But the war in Europe is over, and we will not agree any longer to a ghetto regime imposed upon us by a power which we consider an alien in Palestine.

The leader of the Jewish Agency emphasized that during his stay in the United Mates he will make an effort to bring about unity among all Jews in this country for the purpose of winning the support of the United States for Jewish claims on Pales-

"We are on the eve of historic decisions with regard to Palestine," Benfurion declared. "These decisions may be in favor of our demand for the establishment of Palestine as a Jewish State, or they may be against us. Both are possible. But om thing is certains should britain decide to maintain its White Paper restrictions, the will be able to do it only through a regime of bloody terror." He added that there are no less than 250,000 able-bodied men and women among the 600,000 Jews in Palestine .

Charges Britain With Responsibility for Jews Massacred by Masis

Reviewing the difficulties created by the White Paper for the Jewish development of Palestine, BeneGurion charged the British Government with responsibility for the mass-murder of many thousands of Jews in Europe during the Masi regime, pointing out that these Jews could have been absorbed in Palestine had Britain not introduced imigration restrictions. He said that Palestine can easily absorb a million more lews if the country were open to Jewish immigration.

During the last few years the Jews of Palestine raised among themselves about thelve million dollars, primarily for the work of resouing Jews from Mezi Europe, Len-Surion reported. He rewealed that many Jewish young men and women from Palestine volunteered for dangerous rescue missions which took them behind the German lines. They operated in Rumania, Hungary and other countries which were under German domination. He also disclosed that one-third of the Palestine Arabs who joined the British forces deserted after a few months of scryicee

The Zionist leader also reported that in France, which he recently visited, many Jews are adopting Catholicism, but on the other hand many Jews who were never action list-minded are now staumoh supporters of Zionism and are ready to fight for the establishment of Palestine as a Jewish States

ES IN SWEDEN ASK EASING OF REGULATIONS FOR STATELESS REFUGEES SPEEDY NATURALIZATION

STOCKHOLM, June 21. (JTA) -- Jewish organizations here, and in Goteborg and Elme, have submitted a memorandum to the Minister of Justice drawing his attention to me status of stateless refugees now in Sweden, it was reported today.

The memorandum asked that the stateless persons should be placed in the same attgory as Baltic refugees, who are permitted to seek employment here and urged that hgislation be drafted to accord them legal rights and to allow them to become naturalized without waiting for the ten-year period required under present laws.

MATY JEWS LEAVE PALESTINE FOR UNITED STATES; SEVERELY CRITICISED BY HEBREW PRESS

JERUSAIEM, June 21. (JTA) -- The Spanish steamer Flus Ultra, which brought mer 500 Jewish refugees to Palestine this week, left here today earrying 40 Palestine maidents bound for the United States.

The Hebrew press has been railing recently against persons who came here unber the White Paper quota, using precious immigration certificates, and are now leaving for other countries.

Eliahu Dobkin, immigration chief of the Jewish Agency, is flying to France tworrow to arrange the emigration of Jews planning to come to Pelestine, it was smounced today.

ENOMENDATIONS ON FUTURE OF GERMAN COLONY IN PALESTINE SUBMITTED TO GOVERNMENT

JERUSAIEM, June 21. (JFA) — A memorandum containing recommendations concerning the future of the German colony in Palestine has been submitted to the Palestine Screnment by the Jewish Agency, it was revealed today by Moshe Shertck, political thief of the Agency, addressing a meeting of the Small Zionist Actions Committee.

Mr. Shertok disclosed that, in addition to the memorandum submitted last much to the British Government, demanding the establishment of a Jewish state, the Jeway sent a memorandum to the Palestine Government urging mass immigration of surviving Jews from Europe.

The meeting of the Large Zionist Actions Committee, which was scheduled to come in London the end of next month, will not be held because of technical difficulties, it was announced at the meeting. In its place, a conference of members of the Smeller Actions Committee, chosen on the beaks of party representation, will be held in London, and other Zionist leaders will be inwited.

The committee, at today's session, elected Abraham Harsfeld of the Palestine labor Party; Abraham Kestenberg, of the Poals Misrachi; Jacob Hesan of the Hashomer lastir and Joseph Janower, veteran Zionist leader from Scuth Africa, to the board of directors of the Jawish Mational Fund.

THE JEWS ASK TRIAL IN GREECE OF NAZIS WHO ORGANIZED PERSECUTION OF JEWS

ATHENS, June 21. (JTA) — The executive committee of the ocumoil of Jewish tomunities has cabled to the Greek representative on the United Nations war Crimes formission in London listing German war oriminals who organized the persecution of Greek Jews and urging that they be extradited to Greece for trials.

MINERIAND NOTIFIES BERGEN-BEISSN REFUGEES THEY WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO CAMP IN ITALY

GENEVA, June 21. (JTA) -- Swiss authorities today notified the Jewish refums transferred from Bergen-Belsen before the capitulation of Germany that they all have to leave Switzerland within a week's time, in accordance with an understandtranshed between Switzerland and the United States at the time the Swiss Governmak agreed to admit them to this country.

It is understood that of the 1,670 sewish refugees who came here from Bergenhlen, about 1,000 are Dutch and Belgian citisens. Their respective legations have hen the responsibility for their repatriation, and they will, therefore, be perdited to remain in Switzerland a little longer. The remaining refugees, including men and children, will be deported next week to an UNRRA camp in Southern Italy, the most of them are stateless or citisens of East European countries.

The deportation of these refugees was scheduled to have taken place recently, it was postponed. However, today the refugees were notified by the Swiss authorities that there will be no further postponement. The refugees insist that they either sent to Palestine, or permitted to return to their native lands but not via still mather comp.

MERCUS ANTI-SEMITIC UNDER-CURRENTS PRESENT IN AMERICAN LIFE, FERC REPORTS

WASHINGTON, June 21. (JTA) -- Dangerous anti-Semitic under-currents are premut in American life, and "the mergin of our victory over religious intolerance has hen merow," the Fair Employment Practice Committee states in a report to President Tumn released last night by the White House.

"In war industries and government service citizens of the Jewish faith have hen denied opportunity to serve their country," the report added. "Yet it may still he said that such cases, however symptomatic, have been relatively few in number. The spread of religious intolerance has so far been kept in sheek by the force of the number opinion of the American public."

It discloses that 355 out of a total of 4,081 complaints of employment dismination to the FEFC during the fiscal year July 1 to June 50, 1944 were bn grounds of creed, and of these 255 or 72.7 per-cent concerned Jews. The report quotes the lartesn Jewish Congress as finding that economic discrimination against Jews in the feeter New York area exists in many industries and in many forms.

Of 1,000 discrimination complaints studied, almost half were in financial institutions, professional and related work, machinery and metal trades, chemical in allied industries and employment agencies. The report says "FER experience indicates that at the outset of the war there was considerable discrimination against the sew in the aircraft and instrument industries. Complaints were also received from War and Navy Department establishments, shipbuilding and repair, iron and steel industry and other activities wital to the war effort.

The report notes good results from campaigns to eliminate religious specilisations in advertisements, notably in New York and in Cleveland where officials if mjor newspapers agreed to her such ads. MI ONE FERCENT OF DEPORTED JEWS SURVIVE, SAYS DR. SCHWARTZ; DO NOT WISH TO RETURN HOME

NEW YORK, June 21. (JTA) -- Only about one percent of the Jews deported to ham and Germany have survived to be repatriated and in all of Europe there are probly so more than 1,250,000 Jews, Dr. Joseph Schwartz, European director of the Joint Euritution Committee, told a press conference today. Of these about 200,000 are still in Germany, in and outside of comps.

Dr. Schwartz, who has just returned to the United States after spending eight saths visiting Jewish communities in liberated Burope, confirmed previous reports is the majority of the surviving Jews do not wish to return to their homelands, from there they are at present, and many of those who were not deported, for one reason wither, also want to emigrate.

The most pressing problem facing Jewish relief groups, the JDC official said, is that to do with the thousands of orphaned Jewish children who are scattered throughest Burope, many in camps and many in non-Jewish institutions and homes. He disclosed that transpenents have been made to bring Jewish children from camps in Germany to beland, France, Switzerland and, probably, Sweden; and negotiations are going on to transfer children under non-Jewish custody to the care of Jewish groups. Dr. Schwartz agressed doubt that all of this latter group will be "reclaimed" by the Jews.

The problem of re-establishing Jews in homes and vocations where they can keems self-supporting is complicated, he said, by the increased anti-Samitism which as he found in most European countries. But, Dr. Schwartz added, the picture is not all black since left-wing groups, such as Socialists, Communists and resistance organishing, have displayed a great deal of sympathy for Jews and in countries where they are will become influential the situation will improve.

Moriber served in Italy and France. He received the Silver Star for capturing a machine gun nest. For leading his company to the capture of sixty Germans in a warry, somewhere in Italy, he received the Bronze Star. The following day he and three others were on reconnaissance duty when he decided that there might be more termans where the sixty had come from. They set out to find them.

"I was leading the patrol," Moriber reported, "when we came across four Germms. We had a skirmish and killed the four. But my pistol was hit by gunfire and remared useless. Others in the patrol had little or no ammunition. We continued on to the stone quarry and I ordered the Germans to come out, telling them they were surtounded by U. S. troops. Eight came out with their hands up and dropped their guns. The others inside opened fire. Then the going got tough I was able to get my hands on gun that would shoot, We killed eight Germans in the skirmish. After that the Germs remaining in the quarry obeyed and surrendered. They were marched back to camp. here were 100 in all.

For his part in capturing those 100 Germans, Moriber was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross.
