HOTSDAM AGREEMENT ABOLISHES ALL ANTI-JEWISH LATS IN GERMANY; FROVIDES EQUAL RIGHTS

HEW YORK, Aug. S. (JTA).—Leaders of all major Jewish organizations today hailed the decisions of the "Big Three" at the Potsdam Conference which, among other things, provide for the complete abolition of the Mazi racial laws and which ensure rights for all citizons of Germany irrespective of race, nationality, or religion.

The text of the tripartite agreement on the political principles to govern the treatment of Germany in the initial control period, contains a clause reading. "All Rei laws which provided the basis of the Hittler regime or established disordination on the grounds of race, creed, or political opinion shall be abclished. No such discriminations, whether legal administrative or otherwise, shall be tolerated."

Another clause in the agreement dealing with the establishment of a judical system in Gormany reads: "The judical system will be reorganized in accordance with the principles of democracy, of justice under law, and of equal rights for all citizens without distinction of race, nationality or religions."

HUMANIA ORDERS RETURN OF ALL JEWISH PROFERTY INCLUDING THAT SOLD UNDER DURESS

IMMON, Aug. 5. (JTA)—The use of "backdoor diplomacy" in the struggle for which rights in Palestine was strongly condemned today by Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, co-chairman of the American Zionist Emergency Council, addressing a closed session of the Morid Zionist Conference.

"Thatever the situation is, we must clearly state our aims end not use roundshout methods," Dr. Silver said. He paid tribute to the efforts of the World Zionist Executive, which, he said, were made against terrible odds during the last six years, and emphasized that in expressing disagreement, he was not assailing those at the helm of the world Zionist movement.

The American delegation, Dr. Silver strossed, came to the World Zionist Conference united. He lauded the services of Rabbi Stephen S. Wise to the cause of Lawrican Zionism and added that whatever the differences between him and Dra Wise rearding methods of work, the Zionist movement in the United States remains unshaken.

"We have heard Dr. Weismann warning us not to have too much confidence in guernment leaders," Dr. Silver told the delegates, "I said it in 1944 at the conventum of the Zionist Organization of America. But then the executive and its officers were insisting on our putting all our trust in Roceevelt and in Churchill. Now Churchill is out, and Roceevelt is unfortunately dead. We are more hopeful regarding the Labor Government, but that is because of the public stand which the Labor Party has taken with regard to the Falestine issue and not because we base our hopes on our personal relations with this or that politician, however important he may be."

"Refugeeism" Must Not Be Substituted for Zionism, Silver Insists

Dr. Silver praised David Ben-Gurion's recognition of the fact that the victory of

the labor Party in England does not automatically mean a Zionist victory, and, therefore, the Zionist demands must be pressed as vigorously as ever.

"We must fight against anti-Zionism from the right as well as from the left," be wreed. "Beware of refugeeism as a substitute for Zionism! We must save the wish remnants, but the two things are complementary and do not cancel out each

ENTISH FRIE MINISTER APPOINTS FRO-ZIONIST LABORITE AS COLONIAL MINISTER

LONDON, Aug. 3. (JTA) -George Henry Hall, formerly parliamentary Under-Secretary for Colonies, who is known to be pro-Zionist, was today appointed by Prime Minister little to the post of Colonial Secretary.

Hall voted against the Government in the debates on the White Faper in May and July, 1989, as well as against the ordinance restricting Jewish land purchase in hiestine. He was also one of the participants in the Bermuda Conference on refugees kild in 1943, where he represented the British Government as Under-Secretary of the Maniralty.

THER THAN 10,000 SURVIVE OF 234,000 JEWS DEFORTED FROM WESTERN EUROFE, U.S. ARMY SAYS

FRANKFURT-ON-MAIN, Aug. 3. (JTA) — Fewer than 10,000 of the 254,000 Jews deported to Germany and Poland from France, Belgium, the Netherlands and Norway during the fail occupation have returned to their homelands, a coording to the first statistical toler on the subject prepared by U.S. military authorities.

It appears from the review, which was released today, that fewer than five erest of the deportoes are still alive. It said: "Although a few additional Jews of political deportees may still be uncovered in hespitals and other places in stmmy, the difference between the two sets of figures represents approximately the under of French, Belgian, Lutch and Norwegian racial and political deportees who led at Auschwitz, Bergen-Belsen, Sachsenhausen, Nordhausen, Dachau, Buchenwald, and ther Maii murder camps."

Political deportoes fared somewhat better than Jews, the report points out, uslosing that of 165,000 deported for political reasons, 39,000 have been repatriated. It then continues: "With respect to racial deportees, the figures indicate that the ui policy was to deport Jews from the occupied countries and then exterminate has. The physical condition of the repatriated Jews is bad on the whole, and it was researy to bring most of them home in hospital trains or special convoys."

ALL IRINCIPAL JEWISH GROUPS CAN SEND LIAISON HEN TO GERMANY , WAR DEPT. ANNOUNCES

WASHINGTON, Aug. S. (JTA)—A spokesman for the War Department said today that authorization to send representatives to Germany to act as liaison officers between the U.S. military authorities and stateless and other Jews still held in camps, will be given to all principal Jewish organizations, and is not limited to any one group.

"However, it is up to UNRRA to decide which groups are going, who is to be represented, and how many representatives they are to have," he added. The War impartment, he explained, decides only whether the individuals selected to go are satisfactory to the military authorities. The rest is up to UNRRA.

UNRA headquarters here told the JTA today that details have not yet been worked out, but that it is now considering applications from several organizations.

RELATIONS DETWEEN JEWISH LALOR AND EMPLOYERS THREATEN PALESTINE GROWTH, SAYS APPEAL

JERUSALEM, Aug. 3. (JTA) -- The present relations between Jewish labor and industry in Falestine threaten: the continued prosperity of the country and is hampering industrial development, the Jewish Industrialists Association charged today in a ceble to the World Zionist Conference in London.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 3. (JTA) — Lewis Strauss of New York, active in Jewish affairs before the outbreak of the war, and now on active cuty in the United States Naval Reserve, has been promoted to the rank of commodore, it was reported here today.

Commodore Strauss' present assignment is as special assistant to the Socretary of the Navy and Navy member of the Army and Navy Manitions Foard. He also is special assistant to the Vice Chief of Naval Operations.

He entered the Naval Reserve in 1926 as a lieutenant commander. He has received the Legion of Merit form the Navy and an Oak Leaf cluster in lieu of a second Legion of Merit from the Army.
