JEWISH AGENCY NEGOTIATES TO CONVERT THE JEWISH DRIGADE INTO PALESTINE GARRISON

LONDON, Aug. 6 (JTA) - Regotiations to convert the Jewish Erigade into a nucleus fir a permanent Jewish garrison in Falestine are now under way by the Jewish Agency, it was revealed today by Moshe Shertok, head of the Agency's political deaprement, eddressing the World Zionist Conference.

Shertok joined Dr. Weizmann and Ben-Gurion in the warning that the victory of the Lator Porty in England does not automatically mean Zionist success. However, hedded it opens "new vistas for our political struggle." He urged the Zionist leaders "to cather strength for a political offensive."

Flatly rejecting any suggestion to make Palestine a bi-national Arab-Jewish site, Shertok said that at present an understanding with the Arabs on the basis of the Zionist program is impossible, but an understanding can be reached after the Great Powers render their decisions with regard to the future of Felestine. He disclosed that a ruler of one of the Arab countries confided to him that there cannot be any talk about Arab-Jewish relations now, that such talk must wait until Pritain, the United States and the USSR come to a decision on the Falestine issue.

In the meantime, Shertok said, the Zionists must mobilize all their forces to counteract the political offensive which the Arabs are now launching in England and the United States. He concluded by proposing that the political offices of the Jewish Agency in London, Washington and Jerusalem be reorganized to work as one unit.

Members of Jewish Brigade Address the World Zionist Conference

Two members of the Jewish brigade addressed today's session of the World Zionist Conference dwelling on the moral effect which the appearance of a Jewish military unit had on Jews in liberated countries.

Greeting the conference in behalf of the Jewish Lrigade, Sergeant Feinstein stated that the Jewish order of the day must be "All Jews out of Europe." He said that members of the Brigade not onlygave of their own financial resources to help the liberated Jews, but stimulated them spiritually. In a number of liberated terms Jews came out with blue-white flags to great the units of the Juxish Brigade, he stated and thousands eagerly exchanged words in Hebrew, with the members of the Brigade and sought information as to how and when they could proceed to Palastine.

Sgt. Grabowski, another member of the Jewish Brigade, told the conference that the Irigade proposed to take to Falestine the remains of Dr. Theodore Herzl, father of political Zionism, who is buried in Vienne. He dramatically described how the dwish Brigade entered Rome on the dey when the conversion to Catholicism of Dr. Isarel Zolli, chief rabbi of Rome was announced. "The appearance of a Jewish military unit in the city restored the morale of the stunned Rome Jews," he declared,

The Jewish Drigade, Sgt. Gratowski reported, lost no war prisoners to the Germans in their fight on the Italian front. The bodies of fellow Jewish soldiers

removed from the battle field during the dark hours of the night. There are forty-three graves of fallon members of the Jewish Brigade today at the Bolzano cemetery, and many other graves elsewhere, he said.

Mizrachi President Demands Reorganization of Zionist Executive

The complete reorganization of the World Zionist Executive was demanded today at the World Zionist Conference by Leon Gellman, president of the Mizrachi Organization of America. He complained that the Zionist political activities are not coordinated and that the leaders of the world Zionist movement are concealing their real intentions and are "only paying lip service to the idea of a Jewish Commorwowlthe"

Mrs. Judith Epstein, addressing the conference in behalf the Hadassh, pleaded for the elimination of dissension in the movement. She said that the critics of the present Zionist administration are wrong when they suspect that the world Edonist executive is inclined to minimalism. She smphasized that American Zionists are "absolutely united."

Dr. Joseph Fischer and Samuel Segal, delegates from France, reported on the growth of the Zionist movement in France since the liberation of the country. They reported that the French Zionists are new organizing a strong Zionist movement in North Africa.

WHITE PAPER WILL SOON BE CANCELLED, EGYPTIAN CURRESFONDENT REPORTS FROM LONDON

JERUSAIEM, Aug. 6 (JTA).—The usually well-informed London correspondent of the Cairo newspaper Al-Aharam today reports that he has learned from reliable non-wewnsh circles that the Eritish White Paper will soon be atolished and Falestine re-opened to Jewish immigration.

"There is no doubt," the correspondent cables, "that English public opinion is in favor of the Zionist maximalist demands. However, important Pritish circles insist on the partitioning of Palestine as the lest solution of the Arab-Jewish problem."

The correspondent believes that the new Labor Government "will soon consider the Felestine problem, though there is no indication as to the precise plans which the government may have formed, beyond the rescinding of the White Fapers". He points out that the general opinion in London is that Russia will not support the convencion of all of Palestine into a Jewish State, and that American political leaders will not sulfill the promises made by the party conventions with regard to furthering Zionist alms.

TWO JEWISH YOUTHS IN PALESTINE SENTENCED ON CHARGE OF FOSSESSING HAND GREEADES

JERUSAIEM, Aug. 6 (JTA) - Two Jewish wouths, Woshe Salomon and Joshuch Mizrachi, were sentenced today by a military court to 15 and 7 years imprisonment respectively, on the charge of possessing twenty-five hand grenades. The verdict must be confirmed by higher military authorities.

When called to the stand, Salomon declared that it was useless for any Jew to defend himself against the police charges, since the court would convict him under any circumstances. He attacked the Falestine police "for suspecting and hunting Jewish youthe"

THE JETSH SCIENTISTS, REFUGEES FROM REICH, CHEDITED WITH DEVELOPMENT OF ATOMIC LONG

WASHINGTON, Aug. 6 (JTA) — Two Jewish scientists, refugees from the Reich who are now Iritish subject, are credited for considerable research and development of the devastating atomic Bomb, the first use of which was made on Japan this morning, as revealed today by President Truman in a White House statement.

The two, according to the Eritish information Service, are the 38-year old Frof. Rudolph Ernet Feierls, who was compalled to leave Germany, and the 41-year old Dr. Otte Robert Frisch, who was born in Vienna and was dismissed from the Hamburg University in 1933 on racinl grounds.

Prof. Feierls, the British Information Service said, is today "one of the foremost theoretical physicists in England. He was torn in Berlin, left Germany in
1933 when the Mazis came to power, and has lived in England since these. He was one
of the original members of the technical committee established on the recommendation
of the then Frime Minister Churchill and the British Chief of Staff to direct the work
of producing an atomic bomb. He was awarded a Rockefeller Fellowship in 1832,
which enabled him to visit kome and Cambridge, and after moving to England, was
successively a Research Fellow at Manchester University, carried on experimentation at
the Royal Society Mond Laboratory in Cambridge, was appointed to the chair of applied
mathematics at Birmingham University and elected a Fellow of the Royal Society in
1945.

Dr.Frisch, who was born in Vienna, is credited by the Eritish Information Service as being one of the first to realize the poss idlify that fission of uranium might leaf to development of a "bomb of unprecedented viblence." He has been working on this project since early 1940. Dismissed as a Jew from Hamburg University in 1933, Frisch went to London where he worked for a year on maclear physics, then proceeded to the institute of Frofessor Hiels-Bohr in Copenhagen for further research. While there he and his sunt, Frofessor Lise Meither, also a refugee from Germany, advanced the principle of "muclear fision" to explain the behavior of uranium under howerdent by neutrons. He became a British citizen in 1943, and Peierls in 1940.

Fresident Truman, revealing the steps in the perfecting of the Atomic Bomb and indicating that its use may lead to an early end of the war with Japan, said that stonic energy will usher in a new power age supplementing the power derived from coal, oil and falling waters. Secretary of War Henry L. Stimson also said today that the atomic power holds enourous potentialities for use in peace times as wells. He mand a committee with the approval of Fresident fruman, to formulate recommednations for the post-war development and utilization of stomic powers.

"MATIONAL ANTI-MENTSH FARTY" IS PLANNED; WILL NOWTHATE CONDIDATE FOR WHITE HOUSE

CEATTAN.CGA, TRNN., Aug. 6 (JTA) -- leaders of the Nu Klux Klan are now considering the possibilities of a "mational anti-fewish party," which could nominate a Presidential candidate in the 1948 campaign, who may be ex-Senator Robert R. Reynolds of North Carolina.

Information on the future En Elux Han palitical program, supported by sworn affidevits, has been obtained by a Jarah, correspondent from southern Elan sources. Thile it is unknown whether Reynolds, who several months are formed the "American Entimelist Party," has consulted with Elan officials, this much is certains

husinessmen for a new political party. Reynolds, it is also learned, has been smoothing the path for McWilliams by sending certain businessmen and others hor regards as potential supporters a letter in advance of McWilliams! call.

The text of the letter, as disclosed June 21 by the Waco (Texas) Times-Herald reads as follows: "I have requested our representative, Mr. Jack Williams, to call on you in the near future for the purpose of discussing with you the matter of the formation of a new political party. I am confident you are interested in such a novement and feel, as I do, that NOW is the time to give the most serious consideration to this matter. This subject has been discussed with prominent people throughout the country. I am sure that you will be interested in hearing what the plans are regarding this new party in 15 Southern Staes. We know that you will be greatly interested for the very particular reason that part of our program directly affects your business, which subject is fully set forth in the enclosed statement, outlitled 'Freedom for Managemento' I want to assure you, Mr. that I shall appreciate any courtesy you may extent to Mr. Williams when he calls on you, at which time I trust you will see him personally."

- 2, JeLe Stoner, southern "gauleiter" of the Ku Klux Klan, who is stationed in Chattanogg, recently held a caucus of tursted Klansmen at his home here for purposes of discussing a "mational anti-Jewish perty" and studying possible candidates for the White House, Aside from Reynclds, candidates discussed by Klansmen for the 1946 campaign include Cole Charles Lindbergh and Senator "Pappy" W. Lee O'Daniel, unofficial leader of the "Chritian Americans," one of the best-financed pro-fascist grups in the United States.

Klan leaders and "fuehrers" of a number of other fascist organizations in the matten will hold a secret convention this summer in some midwestern city, probably Detroit, to discuss the project of a mass fascist party which would unite all Maziminded elements. Resic units of this group would be community "Christian Action" committees, similar to those set up last year in Indiana by the Rev. J. Welter Girson, a former Klan lecturor. In addition, it is learned, there would be "storm trooper" gangs to be recruited from the ranks of unemployed ex-servicemen. The affiliation of these gangs with the parent organization, however, would be kept secret.

The J.T.A. correspondent has been informed that a number of the hood-and-shirt egitators favor the name "American Nationalist" for the prospective party, which is the latel already in use by Reynolds. They like the term "nationalist" on grounds that that label expresses the Klan's opposition not only to the Jews but to all non-aryan minorities.

In recent weeks there has been a revival of "fiery crosses" in this section of the South, And here Klansmen have been busy inciting Christians against Jews and white workers against Negroes.

HOUSE COMMITTEE IS ASKED TO FERMIT REPUGES FROM EUROPE TO REMAIN IN UNITED STATES
