13. LIGHEST HEADERS MEET TO DEFINE ATTITUDE ON AMERICA'S POLICY ON PAIESTINE

EW YORK, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- American Zionist leaders will meet here temorrow thin their attitude towards the policy of the United States Government with regard the less announced last night by Secretary of State Byrnes, and on the exchange of the subject between the late President Rocesvelt and King Ibn Saud.

THE TREED TO ADMIT 500 JEWISH CHILDREN; HICEM REQUESTED TO POST \$100,000 BOND

QUITO, Ecuador, Oct. 19. (JTA) - Attorney General Alfredo Perez Guerrero is recommended to the Ecuadorean Government that it admit 500 Jewish children from imag, growled that the Hias-Ica Emigration Association, which has requested the admin of the young refugees, posts a bond of \$100,000 to guarantee that the children will not become public charges.

This sum would be returned at such time as the youngsters have learned a trade at leaves soif-supporting. In the event that a child dies, or leaves the country, 8,00 would be returned to the Hias-Ioa. The Attorney General also recommends that the Jerish organization pay \$20 per month to the Ministry of Education for the main-tense of each young immigrant.

It is pointed out here that Dr. Guerrero's suggestions should not be intermented as indicating opposition to Jewish immigration, but are motivated only by the hall affinancial problems involved in admitting the children. He has frequently messed sympathy with Jowish causes, and last year forestalled a ban on the Zionist Orpulsation here, over the opposition of the Foreign Office.

MEDICAL ASSEMBLY AND MILWAUKEE WELFARE FUND OPPOSE NATIONAL ADVISORY BUDGETING

EW YCRE, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- The Rabbinical Assembly of America, representathe key of Conservative rabbis, has adopted a resolution opposing national advisory highing for Jewish federations and welfare funds, it was announced today by the Comnities to Oppose National Budgeting. A similar resolution was adopted by the Jewish Miker Fund in Milwaukes, the Committee reported.

The resolution of the rabbinical organization says that "the Rabbinical Assembly of Aberica believes that in this formative stage of Jowish community life, it would be very unsize and even detrimental to the full development of Jowish life in America temper the free and democratic decision of each community to determine for itself itself continuation to local, national and oversons causes." This statement, the resolution declares, is "a reaffirmation of our position which was taken in 1941. Our study of the situation leads us to endorse that attitude wholeheartedly. We further affirm that intelligent allocations can be made in the local communities."

The resolution of the Milwaukee Jewish Welfare Fund expresses appreciation of its series that the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds has rendered in the secumilation of factual data on agencies appealing for funds and urges that these factions be continued and enlarged. At the same time, it emphasizes that the leaders die which Welfare Fund in Milwaukee wish to reserve for their community the right, at the basis of full information, to determine how the funds raised by the community call be distributed.

"We believe that the establishment of a national advisory budgeting committee till retard the progress of the movement for more intelligent local action with respect to send causes, since it will divert from the local to national level decisions on the distribution of funds for purposes affecting Jewish life here and tend to eliminate to desire for wider local education on Jewish needs," the resolution says, "We believe that we are qualified in our own community to allocate funds with greater undertaining of local conditions and desires."
