NETEN PERSONS REPORTED KILLED IN ANTI-JEWISH RIOTS IN LEBANON; TROOPS CURB OUTBREAKS

LONDON, Nov. 6. (JTA) — Fourteen persons were killed during anti-Jewish fits in the city of Tripolis, Lebanon, yesterday, the Daily Mail reports today from Mrs. It says that troops were called out to quell the disturbances.

Another report from Cairo says that Syrian Premier Saadullah el Jabry, in satement issued after a meeting of the Arab League, declared that the cause of the Mestine Arabs has never been better understood. He expressed the hope that a satisfactory solution of the Falestine problem could be achieved.

MINIUMAY NOT ISSUE STATEMENT ON PALESTINE; WANTS JOINT ANGLO-AMERICAN DECLARATION

LONDON, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Well-informed British sources today expressed the blisf that the long-awaited British statement on Palestine will not be made while him Ministor Attlee is in the United States. They indicated that Attlee's discussimm with President Truman regarding Palestine will now cover a wider field than cripally intended, with the aim of issuing a joint Anglo-American declaration instead of an embusively British statements

In the House of Commons today both pro-Zionist and pro-Arab members pressed for an immediate statement on Felestine. Lord Winterton, whose pro-Arab sentiments we will known, asked whether Attlee would not consider making a statement before his agrice for the United States since the long delay has been interpreted to mean that the labor numbers of Purliament made promises which they cannot carry out.

Replying, the Frims Minister again reliterated that a statement on Falestine till be made "as soon as possible." However, the same sources that predicted that no collection of policy would be forthooming before Attles concludes his talks with Predict Trumn, emphasized that even the promised meager annuncement by Foreign Secrety Bovin may not be issued while Attles is in the United States.

AUSTINE GOVERNMENT WILL USE AIR RAID SIRENS TO WARN OF TERRORIST DISTURBANCES

JERUSAIEM, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Air raid sirens may be used to give warning of others in all towns of Falestine, under a defence emergency order gazetted today. That the sirens are sounded, all vehicles must halt, and can move again only when the ill clear is given.

The return to Palestine of the ex-Mufti of Jerusalem was demanded today by the Keslem Brotherhood in Cairo in a memorandum submitted to King Farcula. The Egyptian March was asked to appeal to the French Government to release the ex-Mufti and to interem with the British Government to secure permission for the ex-Mufti to return to knuslems.

EN ROOFS LAND IN PALESTINE; DESTROYERS PATROL COASTS; JEWISH POLICE UNIT OUSTED

JERUSAIEM, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Additional British troops arrived in Palestine that togeinforce the four divisions, about 60,000 men according to reliable estimated have been pouring into this country in the past few weeks.

Today's arrivals were units of the Sixth Airborne Division, the bulk of tith is believed to be here already. They disembarked at Haifa from the troopship keeds, whose last visit to Palestine was in Sept, when it brought 1,600 refugees furframe and German concentration comps.

Anchored in Haifa harbor and in the waters offshore are four British destress and a cruiser. The destroyers Milne and Stevenstone have been patrolling the rest, apparently to thwart landings of illogal immigrants.

The Palestine Post reports today that British police armed with temmyguns kessmed yesterday on a police post at Mansoura near Haifa which had been manned by try which supernumerary police, and ordered the Jews to clear out within two hours. Itsubment of the Arab Legion was then assigned to the post. The Jewish police had ken guarding a Royal Mayal stores depot, where 300 Jewish workers are employed.

The police today issued a bulletin denying their cwn report of yesterday, title claimed that a group of armed men had attempted to break into a naval depot near Milt, resulting in an exchange of shots with police guards. The report was apparently based on shots fired by an apprehensive guard.

It is reported here that prior to the recent transfer of 250 Jewish terrorit suspects from a camp in the Sudan to Eritrea, seven of the internees escaped. One is since been recaptured in a Cairo cafe.

LL OF 75,000 WHITE PAPER IMMIGRATION CERTIFICATES EXHAUSTED; 12,700 ENTERED IN YEAR

JERUSAIEH, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- None of the 75,000 immigration certificates the available to the Jowish Agency under the White Paper of 1939 are left, it was understood here today by Eliahu Dobkin, Agency immigration chief. BYNAMION OF SYNAGOGUES AND JEWISH CEMETERIES BEGUN IN POLAND BY ORTHODOX GROUP

WARSAW, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- The Union of Orthodox Jews of Poland today anmost plans for the restoration of synagogues and Jewish cemeteries in various parts of the country where Jewish survivors have returned for permanent residence.

The Union has begun restoring the Cracew cemetery which was descrated and wallshed by the Germans. It is also making preparations for repairing the ancient pages in Kazimierz which is more than 600 years old.

Erre than fifty rare Hebrew manuscripts written in the 16th and 17th centres have been discovered in a willage near Lwow, the Warsaw radio reported today. It is believed that they are part of the library of the Lwow Jewish Community which is immored by the Gormans. Soviet authorities in Lwow are arranging for the transfir of the ranuscripts to Poland where they will be placed in the care of the Central with Committee, the broadcast said.

DATE OF JEWISH SETTIESENT IN PALESTINE WOUNDED BY ARABS; ASSAILANTS ESCAPE
