NES KILLED, 183 INJURED IN ANTI-JEWISH RIOTS IN TRIPOLI; JEWISH QUARTERS LOOTED

CAIRO, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- Soventy-four Jews have been killed and 183 hospitalted in anti-wowish outbreaks in Tripoli, which have been in progress since Sunday, it is repreted here today. (The report was confirmed today in London by the British distry of Information.)

The Jewish quarters of the city, which is the capital of the Italian colony if highlitania in western Libya, presently under temporary British administration, we lotted and gutted by Arab mobs Sunday night, the report said. One Arab was killed at 8 injured, and two Italians wounded during the disturbances.

All of Tripolitania has been placed under a rigid curfew and subversive elemin army the Arabs have been arrested, although with the exception of two small was in eastern Tripolitania, no outbreaks have been reported outside of Tripoli.

Evitish troops are patrolling Tripoli, according to a British spokesman here, digning crowds and arresting looters. All gatherings of more than five people have be tamed.

The British Ministry of Information issued a statement declaring that these wit of violence are unprecedented in the history of Tripolitania. The statement atlived the outbreak of ricting, violence and arson to "Arab bands" and added that
leading local personalities, both among the Arabs and Jews, have disassociated themshees irally from the lawbreakers and have expressed their deep regret for the occurhass.

NAMES ARRESTMENT ON FALESTINE REACHED LETYEEN TRUMAN AND ATTLES, BYRNES ANNOUNCES

WASHINGTON, Nov. 7. (JTA) - Secretary of State James F. Byrnes, questioned this ress conference today concerning Anglo-American negotiations on Poleetine and with immigration there, said that no final agreement had been reached between President Framen and Frime Minister Attles on the problem.

Queried concerning the presence in Washington of Middle East diplomats of the Midd States, Secretary Byrnes said he had seen them as a group today, but that they are not there for discussion of the Palestine problem, and that the Arab-Jewish situatian had been only casually mentioned. Asked whether the Arab league had been discussed, he said no.

Lord Halifax, British Ambassador to the United States, yesterday discussed to histine situation with Mr. Byrnes in connection with the expected arrival here dring Minister Attles. All indications point to the fact that the Palestine question will loom large on the agenda of the Trumen-Attles talks. Attles will leave for hand within a week of his arrival in Washington, it was learned here today.

ESSENTIAU TANNES UNITED NATIONS TO SOLVE IALESTINE ISSUE; ASKS ENTRY OF 100,000 JEWS

MEN YORK, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- Immediate admission into Palestine of at least m,000 displaced Jows from Europe and the placing of the whole question of Falestis's future in the hands of the United Nations Organization were urged today by form-reservery of the Treasury Henry Morganthau, Jr., in an address before 1,300 people at Merchis Etal Later, where he was tendered a dinner by E'nai B'rith in recognition of Histories to humanity and the war effort.

"There is only one solution for the homeless, stateless Jews - the immediate Existen of at least 100,000 to Palestine, for Falestine is the one refuge where they sail be assured of achieving at once the status of welcome and respected citizens," the ferms member of the Fresident's War Refugee Board asserted.

This solution, Mr. Morgenthau said, "is the one ardently desired by a great my of the displaced Jews themselves, as all competent observers have noted." He reulted that Earl Harrison, in his report to Fresident Truman, had said that "for some laveau Jews there is no acceptable or decent solution for their future other than blastims." Hr. Lorgenthau also noted that Hervey Gibson of the American Red Cross, as male atour of the displaced persons camps at General Eisenhower's invitation, will that minety-five percent of the Jewish refugees in Europe want to emigrate to hastims.

Hailing President Truman's request to Great Britain's Prime Minister Clement Hills for the admission of 100,000 Jows to Falestine as "a thoroughly statesmanlike m's thoroughly humanitarian appeal," Mr. Morganthau expressed the hope that the Resident will renow his request during Mr. Attlee's visit to this country."

"The 100,000 whose need is most urgent and who have expressed a desire to directs should be admitted without delay." Mr. Morgenthau said. "But the problem if the displaced Jew is not the sole concern of any single nation nor of any small pup of nations. It is the responsibility of all the peoples who fought Fascism and was any opportunity for democracy. Therefore, the whole question of the future of disting should be placed under the auspices of the United Nations Organisation. This was the kind of procedure most people had in mind when they acclaimed the results of the furframisco Conference as a long step toward peace."

On behalf of the 250,000 members of L'nai B'rith, Henry Monsky, president, insented to ir. Morgenthau a specially east gold medallion in recognition of his outstain; contributions to the war effort and to refugee relief. One side of the medallion mas inscribed in Hebrew: "Lower of Israel". The other side was inscribed: "Presided to Hon. Henry Morgenthau, Jr. by B'nai B'rith for his services to humanity." there seekers who joined in paying tribute to Mr. Morgenthau were Attorney General la Clark, Postmaster General Robert Hamegan; Senator Robert F. Wagner of New York and Senator Charles W. Tobey of New Hampshire.

HEW YORK, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- Dr. Abraham Granovsky, head of the Jewish Nationlind, arrived here yesterday from Jerusalen for a two-months' stay during which he has to secure the support of American Jews for a program of land acquisition in Palithe which calls for the investment this year of a sum exceeding \$20,000,000, it groupped here today by Judge Morris Rothenberg, president of the J.N.F. of America.

The announcement was made at a luncheon tendered to Dr. Granovsky in the librar librar librar, at which the leader of the Jewish National Funi reported that skettes Jewry is determined to resist the British White Paper policy which restricts to semisition of land by Jews and closes the doors of Palestine to Jewish immigration.

"The Jews of Palestine will nover acquiesce in the application to the Jewish Home of a policy which was conceived during the Munich appeasement era and ps with to 'laws' that have introduced into Palestine the gractice of racial dissimintion a la Muremberg," Dr. Granvosky said. "The inevitable progress of Jewish Abstine by the legitimate means of immigration to the full extent of the country's surptive capacity and unhampered land purchase and development will not be halted.

"The Jew, whether born in Palostine, or an immigrant of Palostinian or American miticality, may not lease, buy, or acquire a mortgage, on land, water or on the interpretation of Palostine," Dr. Granovsky pointed out, while Arabs can do a sithout restrictions. "Two categories of citizenship have thus been created by the latter Administration," he said. "One for the Arab who may buy land or lease that materiar he pleases; the other for the Jew who is restricted to the narrow strip feast where alome he may buy real property freely. This is the effect of the Land splitting which have been retained throughout the war for freedom and justice and the still in force under the British Labor Government whose party platform inthe a pleage for the abrogation of the White Paper.

"The National Fund, which obtains its support from popular gifts by all sections of the Jowish people, from dimes to hundreds of collect, has bought the most unstaing areas - swamp and marsh, arid wastes and stone hillsides, for which it has all high prices to areas, who disposed of only a portion of their surplus heldings," a granwisky declared. These lands have been converted into the most promising multy-side. These tracts have been drained to eliminate malaria; they have been lands and terraced; they have been irrigated. As a result of our reclamation work as 70,000 people are settled on land which formerly harbored only Beduins or buffales. Of the \$50,000,000 raised by the National Fund since its inception, the balk haben invested in the purchase and improvement of 800,000 dunams or about 200,000 was - three percent of the whole country of Western Palestine."

The wealthy Arab landowners were eager to dispose of their surplus land as they are anxious even today notwithstanding the public protestations to the contrary. In segorness of the Arab landowners to sell to Jews their surplus holdings is evisually by the numerous offers that have been made to us for the sale of scores of thusands of dunams of land in all parts of the country. But the Palestine Administration officials, although their own regulations permitted such transfer, have surrounded such transaction with so many difficulties and obstacles as to forge an iron ring from our land reclamation program, Mr. Granovsky stated.
