### E. SER ALAN CURNINGHAM APPOINTED NEW HIGH COMPUSSIONER FOR FALESTINE

LONDON, Nov. 8. (JTA) -- General Sir Alan Cunningham. Commander-in-Chief of Hitty forces in Eastern England, today was named High Commissioner for Palestine, median Lord Gort who resigned last week.

The group also included three barred orphans.
