RECORD PRESIDENT OF ZOA; ACCUSES BRITISH GOVT. OF BETALYING JEWS AND DUPING U.S.

ATLANTIC CITY, Nov. 18. (JTA) -- Accusing the British Government of betraythe Weish people and of using the American Government as a protective device to his betrayal, Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, following his election this afternoon to the sikeny of the Zionist Organization of America, tonight sounded the keynote of what pumily regarded here as the beginning of a more militant Zionist policy.

Dr. Silver's election by acclamation set a precedent for recent years and was given here as indicating agreement by all groups that, in the light of the present light erisis, a more aggressive policy is necessary.

"The British Government," said Dr. Silver, "maneuvered our Government into thing ner action which will involve it in morel responsibility without granting amagning autonomy. America will now be used to cover Great Britain's broken this, and to act as a smokesorcen for the betreyel of our poople."

Commending President Truman for his request for the admission of 100,000 km refugees to Palestine, Dr. Silver said that "we had over-estimated the determine of the Fresident.
