BL AVIV, Nov. 25. (JTA) -- Police today clamped down a tight curfew on two micolonics and threw heavy cordons of troops around three others as an aftermath missions which blasted two coast guard stations last night.

ENTIRE TROOPS ATTREST JEWISH LEADERS IN BEISEN CAMP FOR PROTEST ON PALESTINE FOLICY

ERRIS, Nov. 25. (JTA) - Londers of the Central Jewish Committee in Bergenkler, in the British zone in Germany, have been arrested for protosting against the markitish policy on Falestine, it was revealed in a report received here today from the committee.

they created not only the president of the Jewish Committee, but a number of other
lasters of the committee and several of its personnel. They then took the Blue-White
flag from the office of the committee and threw it into a pile of garbage sixty feet
from the office.

Meanwhile, many of the thousands of Jews who are still in the Belsen camp altered together and voiced their protest against the German administrator. The military police then let loose with their rubber truncheons, striking at random at men and women.

Several hours leter, British troops, led by Grande, roturned to the comp an arrested another member of the Jewish Committee, two young chalutain and three Jewish; without explanation. They later returned, for a third time, and searched the office of the committee, seizing several typewriters, correspondence files and actualing ledgers.

No information econorming those arrested can be obtained, except it is known that during their interregation at the headquerters of the military police, one was struck twice by a German policemen in the presence of a British officer.

SES OF EXTERMINATION OF JEWS IN NORWAY AND CZECHOSLOVANIA PRESENTED TO NUREMBERG TRIBUNAL

MUREBERG, Nov. 25. (JTA) - The Norwegian Government has presented to the mid Military Tribunal here a special report on the cruelties inflicted by the Germonation forces upon Jews in Norway, it was learned here today.

The report omphasizes that although no Jewish problem existed in Norway and the loss constituted only a small fraction of the population, the Nazi Government in this ordered their deportation and the confiscation of their property. After enusting the barbarities committed upon the Jews in Norway, the report says that about whilf of the ontire Jewish population in the country was sent to "unknown destinating" the Gestapp, and only thirteen of them returned to Norway from extermination was in Germany and Polend after the collapse of the Nazi regime.

Witnesses Testify at Dachau Trial on Flogging of Jews

MACHAU, Nove 25. (JTA) -- Grim details of the daily flogging routine at the kews consentration camp, and of living prisoners being included in cargoos of dead, stilled for the cromatorium, were unfolded during the week-end at the hearing of wages against forty persons concerned with running the camp.

Alphonse Polles, a native of Luxembourg, told the court he saw a Folish Jew dilig up and talking among a heap of corpses at the door of the cromatorium, and that we it he accused then took a hauling pole from a cart and beat the Jew to death. Blis explained that he had been one of a working party detailed to unload trains arbing at Jachan with deed and living prisoners. He and his colleague took several of the living to hospital, but were often sont beak with live prisoners to the crematorium with bodies had gunshot wounds he said. Describing daily floggings in the camp, Wolfgang Furrer, a Swiss, said that a Spar-old Jowish prisoner was fastened to a whipping post and beaten by two block laters, after which one of the accused joined in with a cat-c-nine-tails until the nation was unconscious, and was hurled to the ground in a pool of blood.

All the women prisoners of a Dachau subsidiery camp were compelled to witress to harging of five men, Riva Levy, a pretty 29-year-old Jewish woman from Lituania tild the Court. The five men were hanged for cutting up a blanket to make foot ocverting. Riva was a prisoner at Kaufering subsidiery camp. She described how her father as a bally beaten that he was sent to hospital and finally left camp on an "invalid trasport." She never saw him again.

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J. Nev. 25. ETHE LABOR VOICES DISAFPOINTMENT AT TRUMAN RETREAT ON PALESTINE IMMIGRATION

MENT YORK, Nov. 25. (JTA) -- Resolutions expressing disappointment at Presith Fruran's failure to insist on the immediate admission of 100,000 European Jews to elating and offirming its solidarity with the Jews in Falestine "in thoir determination resist all efforts to reduce them to a permanent minority," were adopted today the closing session of the 22nd annual convention of the National Labor Committee by Alastine attended by more than 3,000 delegates.

NEW YORK, Nove 25.
