MASHINGTON, Dec. 5. (JTA) — Secretary of State Byrnes today announced that med the six members of the United States representation on the Anglo-American commin on Palestine have been appointed.

# ECH COVERNMENT SEEKS TO HALT INPLUX OF FIREING JEWISH REFUGES FROM POLAND

LOMDON, Dec. 5. (JTA) - Jen Faseryk, Csechoslovakian Foreign Kinister, toby told the Jewish Tele\_raphic Agency here that he intends to meet with Jewish groups is leaden to discuss with them the problem of Jewish refugees who are continuing to ther Gsechoslovakia from Poland.

There are now thousands of such Jews in Csechoslovakia, the Foreign Minister wid, adding that they constitute "an increasingly spect problem" for the Czechoslowkia Government. He emphasized that the Frague government intends to discuss this policy with the Polish Government in an attempt to halt the influx of Jewish refugees

in the Csech border. At the same time, he admitted that most of the Jews who are play Poland have no intention of remaining in Csechoslovakia, but hope to reach button.

Questioned about the reported anti-Semitism in Slovakia, Masaryk said that gidenish excesses took place there, but the situation improved after action by the gril government in Frague. He revealed that he himself insigted on drastic measuragements the anti-Jewish elements in Slovakia and went so far as to threaten that with resign if strong measures were not taken to protect the Jews.

Surprise was expressed today in Jewish circles here over a report broadcast the frage radio, and carried by the Czechoslovak news agency CTK, that the Frague moment had submitted to the Nuremberg war crimes tribunal an indictment which seem on the fact that tens of thousands of Czechoslovak Jews were extermined by the Germans.

According to the indictment, only 22,000 Czechoslovak nationals were murdered histapo prisons, in addition to those who were tortured to death. Jewish leaders in point out that the number of Czechoslovak Jews killed by the Nazi is perhaps five tiss larger than the figure given in the indictment. They estimate that of 150,000 is deprited from Czechoslovakia to extermination camps, hardly 10,000 have returned.

#### MINIM GOVERNMENT PROMISES RESTITUTION OF PROPERTY SEIZED FROM JEWS BY NAZZ

MUHICH, Dec. 5. (JTA) — The Bavarian Ministry of the Interior announced tosymbt property seized from Bavarian Jews by the Third Reich will be returned to themhe property has been destroyed, the government will pay compensation to the former with owners, the announcement said.

It revealed that all Jews in Bavaria have reserved "concentration camp" ratm cards, enabling them to secure additional quantities of food, while special food wels will be given them around Christmas. A plan is being drafted to extend governat aid to all those who were affected by the Huremberg laws, the ministry said.

The announcement stressed, however, that "it is not the task of the Bavarian that to make good the financial losses of non-Bavarian Jews" now residing in the protes, although "it is intended to enable these Jews to maintain themselves as far as wallle." In this connection, the Ministry of the Interior said that the chief task to be Herman Aumer, newly appointed State Commissioner for Jewish Affairs, will be to full task the emigration of Jews from Bavaria to Palestine and other overseas coun-

There are in Bavaria now about 25,000 dews, of whom about 20,000 are aliens. It estimated that ninety persont of them want to go to Palestine.

# LOT AUGRICAN JEWS ENTERED PAIRSTING DURING LAST TWENTY YEARS, ERITAIN REPORTS

IDIDON, Dec. 5. (JTA) — Colonial Secretary George Hall today reported in the base of Commons that 8,507 Jews from the United States and 2,482 Jews from Great Britis entered Palestine during the years 1922-44. No figures are available for 1919 to 181, be said.

BIENCS AIRES, Dec. 5. (JTA) -- Col. Juan Peron, the "strong man" of Argen-, no has been charged with responsibility for the repeated anti-Jewish outbreaks hands Aires, today declared that he is opposed to anti-Semitic activities.

Peron made this statement in an interview published in the daily newspaper sizes, which supports the Peronist regime. The paper, commenting on the interview, that the anti-Jewish violence was carried out by enemies of Col. Peron who infilablithe his election demonstrations "in order to harm the cause" of the pro-Peron remst. The statement urges the establishment throughout the United States of prepamay schools to give young men and women the opportunity to prepare themselves for admost device studies offered by the Jewish Theological Seminary.
