#### BEATURS TAKE ISSUE WITH PRESIDENT TRUMAN ON HIS OPPOSITION TO A JEWISH STATE

WASHINGTON, Dec. 7. (JTA) -- President Truman today announced at his press whereve that the names of the members of the Anglo-American inquiry commission on histine would probably be made public on Honday.

The text of a letter addressed to the President in connection with his repits opposition to the establishment of Palestine as a Jewish Commonwealth was made while here today by Senators Robert F. Wagner and Robert A. Taft, co-sponsors of the Medium resolution new ponding in the Senate, from which Truman has withdrawn his support

In the letter, the two Senators charged that "misropresentations and false mass raised with respect to the projected Jewish commonwealth," are intended to "constate public." They expressed the belief that the passage of their resolution, which calls for the eventual establishment by Jewy of a free and democratic commonmits in falestine, is more urgently required now than ever before in view of the project inquiry by an Anglo-American committee.

"It is clear," their letter said, "that our resolution does no more than it removed expression to the purposes of the British and American statesmen who had the polities of the Allied nations." ## MINETHODS OF ORGANISING ANTI-SEMITIEM IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES REVEALED AT NUREMBERG TRIAL

EUREMEERG, Dec. 7: (JTA) -- A report giving details of how agents of Alfred basherg, Nazi racial expert, who is one of the 20 Nazi war oriminals on trial here, agained anti-Semitic activities in various countries was presented today by the British presecuting staff.

The report, which was written by Rosenberg himself, dealt with the organisatim of anti-Jewish groups in Hungary, Rumania and other East European countries and the merging local anti-Semitic parties.

The report also reveals the activities of Rosenberg's racial office in Arab matrics. It discloses the methods used by Rosenberg's agents in spreading anti-Jewin preseands among Arabs and in winning the support of Arab leaders for Mazi Germany.

#### HIED NATIONS DISCUSS PROBLEM OF INTERNATIONAL AGENCY FOR REFUGEES

LONDON, Dec. 7. (JTA) -- The question of what international body should deal nin refusee problems following the liquidation of UNRRA was discussed today at the setta, here of the steering committees of the United Nations Freparatory Commission.

Commenting on a British suggestion that the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations Organization assume the functions of the Intergovernmental Committee for Refugees, South African delegate Fouries stressed the urgency of the problem, pinting to the fact that UNRRA is scheduled to go out of existence next year, and that the Intergovernmental Committee does not have a sufficiently wide mandate to handle the problem.

A Soviet delegate stressed that the question of the refugees demands agreemations all the governments concerned. He said that without such agreement, the mixtill be storile, and asked that concrete proposals be presented. The delegate the gypt, on the other hand, said that the British recommendation was superfluous. Is debate was adjourned until a concrete resolution is drafted.

## RUIAN COURT RULES JUNISH ORPHANS MUST BE SURRENDERED BY NON-JEWISH FAMILIES

BRUSSEIS, Dec. 7. (JIA) -- In what may be a precedent-setting decision, the first Chamber of the Civil Tribunal here this week ruled that the relatives of a Jewishid whose parents were killed by the Mazis could demand that a non-Jewish family which sheltered the child during the occupation surrender it. According to the findings of the Jewish officers, it is possible that a supercentage of these accounts may be paid in the future. At present, there is possibility of transferring money abroad since the rate of exchange has not yet as set. However, the question of transfer of Jewish property abroad is being confidered and future regulations may permit the transfer of capital to Palestind.
