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# MISH CROUPS HAIL TRUMAN DIRECTIVE ON REPUGEES OFFER AID TO SPEED INLIGRATION

MEN YORK. Dec. 23. (JTA) -- American Jewish organizations today welcomed hesident Truman's order releasing the nearly 1,000 refugees at Fort Ontario and inmucting various government departments to facilitate the immigration from Europe of displaced persons under existing quotas. The services of trained immigration specialists were offered to the government to speed release of the Oswego refugees, to aid in meparing displaced persons for emigration to the United States, and to assist them once they arrive.

The National Lefugee Service issued a statement pointing out that a bread progam of aid awaits the newcomers. Prof. Joseph Chamberlain, chairman of the board of he MS, pledged that through this program every effort would be made to prevent the promers from becoming a public financial burden, and to bring about their geographic distribution throughout the country so that their adjustment to American life would be needed. One of the first projects to be undertaken by NRS will be the resettlement the refugees from Oswego. Many communities have agreed to accept quotas of these mfugees, and some of them already have funds earmarked for the purpose, the NRS said.

Mrs. Joseph M. Welt, president of the National Council of Jewish Women, in a blegram hailing the Trumen directive as "an example to other countries of the world, dered the services of the organization's social work immigration experts in this country, and the members of its units overseas. The latter, Mrs. Welt pointed out, could assist government representatives in the American zone of occupation.

In a telegram to President Truman, Joseph Proskauer, president of the Amerion lewish Committee, said that "by this action our country will make a genuine conthution towards alleviating the sufferings of the survivors of Nazism and Fascism the are in need of immediate resettlement and rehabilitation. The President's order, higs Proskauer added, will "demonstrate to other nations that the United States is redy to take the lead in the great humanitarian task of reconstituting the lives of those who suffered most.

The President's order contained specific directives to the Secretaries of We am State, the Attorney General, the Director General of UNRRA, the War Shipping Mainistrator, and the Surgeon General of the Public Health Service to facilitate the tak of bringing the displaced persons from Europe by sending representatives of their departments to the American some of occupation. He also suggested the formation of an inter-departmental committee, under the chairmenship of the Commissioner of Immigration and Esturalization, to coordinate the work of the various government agencies involved.

Mr. Truman stressed that the immigrants, of whom a maximum of 3,900 will be duitted monthly, would enter under existing quota regulations he else pointed out that the quotas which were unfilled during the war years are not cumulative, and added that wild not plan to ask Congress to authorize their use. Most of the imaigrants, he wild come from central and eastern Europe and the Balkans. The President express the desire that as many of the visas as possible be issued to orphaned children.

In this way the transportation of the immigrants will not cost the American taxpayers a single dollar."

JERUSALDI, Dec. 23. ## MPAIN AND CREW OF SHIP CHARGED WITH CARPYING "ILLEGAL" IMMIGRANTS ACQUITTED

HAIPA, Dec. 23. (JTA) -- The captain of the Greek ship Demetrics and five it his crew were accuitted yesterday in district court here on charges of "aiding and butting persons to enter Pale stime illegally." They were immediately re-arrested, instead, by British police acting under recently enacted "emergency defense regulations." When their attorney protested to the court, the judge said that he could not interest, because once he had rendered his decision, "my job is finished."

The Demetrios was intercepted by a British naval patrol on Nov. 23, after it as charged, some 200 "illegal" Jewish immigrants had disembarked from it, and disembarked into nearby Jewish settlements.

During a three-day trial the prosecution failed to prove that a number of perters arrested on board the ship were "illegal immigrants" and, as the ship was intercepted inside territorial waters, the ship's company could not be charged with aiding present to enter Palestime.

# MADER OF "STERN GROUP", FUGITIVE FROM BRITISH, OUTLINES VIEWS OF HIS ORGANIZATION

JERUSAIEH, Dec. 25. (JTA) -- Friedman Yellin, leader of the Fighters for the headon of Israel, popularly known as "the Stern Gang", who has a price of 02,000 on its head, today gave an interview to the correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, its secluide spot somewhere in Pelestine, revealing the plans and the policy of his unergound organization.

"We are at war with the British Empire now," he said. "There is no other way. Its British are determined that Palestine shall never become a Jewish State. We are welly determined that it will."

All peaceful means of settling the question, he said, have been exploited in min. "It is clear now that the aim of the Jewish people cannot be realized through unferences, commissions and the writing of memorandums. The chief issue of the creation of a Jewish State cannot be obscured by discussions about immigration."

Emphasizing that Palestine must be opened up to Jews from all over the world inthe trestrictions or limitations of any kind," the leader of the "Stern Gang" explained that while the problem of Jews in the displaced camps of Europe is acute, the site aim of his organization is much more far-reaching. "We don't want the world's ity and we are not conducting an elementary compaign," he declared.

### Believes Jews Could Reach Agreement with Arabs, if British Withdrew

Yellin, who escaped from a British internment camp in Palestine, believes that if the Pritish withdraw from Palestine, the Jews could reach an agreement with the rate and it would not be a question of imposing our will on the Arabs in Palestine, be pointed out. "It is true that we are militarily stronger than they and this would be afactor. But the important matter is that we would be able to prove to them that semish state would be advantageous, rather than detrimental, to them."

"Despite the many obstacles that the British have placed in our path, we Jews if Falestine have progressed considerably," he continued. "I do not believe the British mold allow us to make any further progress, however, out of their fear that this pross might conflict more and more with the Empire's interests in Europe and the Middle lat."

Yellin cited the fact that the British have prohibited the purchase of America mechinery and raw Laterials by Pelestine's Jews and said that in this they are cartific out two objectives: "Restricting the oconomic capabilities of Palestine, which develop a virile commercial competition in this part of the world; and deliberate—by creating unemployment among the settlers, providing one more excuse against further Edgration."

# Opposes Strategic Military Rights for Britain in Palestine

He contended that the appointment of an Anglo-American commission of inquiry stely served to "camouflage" these two aims. "We are sorry if the Americans have been then in by this British maneuver and we believe that Jews should refuse to appear beme the commission," he said.

Questioned as to various "solutions" of the Pelestine problem, such as partiion, a bi-mational state and dominion status, the young leader said he unaquivocally
speed them all. He also opposed a proposition advanced by many Jewish leaders, offer-

ing Britain the guarantee of strategio military rights in Palestine. He said: "It is nive to think that if Britain had a great naval base at Haifa and airdromes and thousands of troops throughout Palestine she would allow Jews any more freedom to conduct their own affairs than she does now."

# Says British-Russian Relations Involved in Palestine

Questioned as to Palestine in relation to the international scene, he said: To know of course that Britain's relations with the Soviet Union are also involved in this problem. Today the British are concealing their real feeling toward Russia. But their beyonets are on our backs.

Yellin said his organization has no definite political program along social and economic lines. "But we are for a truly democratio, as well as free and independent, Palestine," he declared. "We are opposed to every kind of exploitation. We are tanti-Socialist. We believe in a strong state encouraged by cooperative methods. The majority of Jewish people in Palestine are workers--we believe they will govern the country well."

### HAL HUSSEIKI AND OTHER RELEASED ARAB EXTREMISTS ARRIVE IN CAIRO IN BRITISH FLAME

CAIRO, Dec. 25. (JTA) -- Four Falestine Arab extremist leaders--Jamel Huse mini, Dawood Husseini, Kemel Osman Haddad and Amin Euweika--arrived here yesterday aftermoon by military plane from Rhodesia, where they were detained during the war.

An application for their release was granted by the High Court in Salisbury, forthern Rhodesia, on Nov. 29, the attorney general stating that information had been received that detention was no longer necessary.

Jamal Husseini, who was one of the instigators of the anti-Jewish outbreaks in Relatine, was arrested in 1941 and sent to Southern Rhodesia in 1942. He was elected resident of the Palestine Arab Party in 1943. He was a member of the Palestine Arab elegations to London in 1936 end 1939, and opened the Arab case before the British loyal Commission on Palestine in 1937.

### CHIMA ASSURES UTREA THAT JEWISH REFUGEES WILL NOT BE DEPORTED FROM SHANGHAI

NEW YORK, Dec. 23. (JTA) -- The Chinese Government appears roady to reconsider the order under which thousands of Jewish refugees from Germany and Austria would have been deported from Shanghai, it was reported today by the American Jewish Conference.

"It is confidently anticipated that the order, as it applies to Jews, will be countermanded shortly," the Conference said. It revealed that its Washington representative "drew the attention of the UNRRA to the situation in Shanghai and was assured tative "drew the attention order would not be implemented by the Chinese Government." UNRRA has already registered its objections, the Conference announcement emphasized.

It disclosed that the American Jowish Conference and the World Jewish Congress have sent a letter to the Chinese Embassy in Washington requesting that the Chinese Soverment issue specific orders exempting Jewish refugees from the application of the deportation decree.

### 1.000 AMERICAN SOLDIERS SIGN PETITION FOR FREE IMMIGRATION OF JEWS TO PALESTINE

MANIIA, Dec. 23. (JTA) - A total of 15,000 American servicemen in the Paciim Reater have signed a petition to President Truman urging that the doors of Palestime to opened to free Jewish immigration.

Sixty percent of the signatures on the petition, which is being circulated by the Servicemen's Committee for a Jewish Palestine, have been obtained from Christian midders and sailors. In one engineer company 200 servicemen signed the petition, although only eight men in the unit were Jewish.

Pointing out that the signers fought to preserve "the principles of humanity adjustice," the petition requests that Jevish survivors of the Mazi terror be peruited to enter Palestine, "the only country willing and able to receive them." Only in that country, the petition continues, "can the grim specter of the concentration map be lifted, and self-respect and dignity restored to a broken people."

It stated that the newly designated Anglo-American Commission of Inquiry would "defer unduly the immediate remedial action required."
