J.D.C. DIRECTORS KILLED IN PLANE CRASH; WERE HE ROUTE TO POLAND AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA

FRAGUE, March 7. (JTA) -- David Guzik, director of the Joint Distribution Comtee in Poland, and Gertrude D. Pinsky, director of the J.D.C. for the Netherlands, re killed on Tuesday in a plane crash at the Prague airfield, it was announced here day. Guzik was on route from Paris to Warsaw. Miss Pinsky was flying to Prague on special mission to bring relief to Czechoslovakian Jaws.

Mr. Guzik, 55 years old, was the only one of three J.D.C. directors in Poland escape death at the hands of the Mazis. He carried out an heroic underground reaf program during the years of Nazi occupation. All members of his family were kill-by the Mazis, with the exception of one son who escaped and found haven in Pales-

Miss Pinsky, 37, of Cincinnati, last month completed two years of service with a J.D.C., holding posts in South America and Europe. She was born in Russia and came the United States at the age of seven.

J.D.C. Mourns Death of Its Representatives; Warturg Lauds Their Devotion

NEW YORK, March 7. (JTA) -- Emphasizing that the sudden deaths of David Guzik at Gertrude D. Pineky is a great loss not only to the Joint Distribution Committee, at also to the hundreds of thousands of distressed Jews to whom they were bringing aid at confort, Edward M.M. Werburg, chairman of the J.D.C., today issued the following tatement in behalf of the organization:

"In the deaths of both Miss Pinsky and Mr. Guzik, the J.D.C. has lost two of its not valued and devoted representatives. Their loss will come as a personal grief to makeds of thousands of distressed Jows who benefited by their skilled and understanding efforts. Both died in action, as it were, on missions of mercy for the surviving ews of Europe. Miss Pinsky was flying to Prague to extend further help to the surviving Jows in Czechoslovakia. Mr. Guzik was returning to Poland after conferences in wris with Dr. Joseph J. Schwartz, J.D.C. European chairmen, in which new plans were writed out to aid Poland's surviving Jows.

"David Ouzik's meme was already a legand in the work of aiding distressed and uffering peoples before death ended his twenty-six-year cereer with the J.D.C. When he kais occupied Polend, he refused to leave his people. He was underground and by servic service found the ways and means to extend help to Poliah Jewry as they passed brough the screet trial that every beset any people," the statement said.

ROME, March 7. (JUA) -- Thousands of Jave filled the streets of the city today theoring Chief Rabbi Issae Herrog of Falestine upon his arrival here from Manles where be visited Gen. Morgan, the supreme commander of the Meditorransen forces.

Zionist flags were flown from every Jevish home in Rome in honor of Rabbi Hernor's arrival. A demonstration lasting three hours greeted him. He gave his blessings to the crowd, which was compying banners of velcame. He was accompanied by Chief Rabbi Bavid Prato of Rome and by leaders of the Jevish Community.

WEIZMANN TESTIFIES TODAY BEFORE ANCLO-AMERICAN INQUIRY COMMITTEE IN JERUSALEM

JENUSALEM, March 7. (JTA) -- Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the Jewish Agen-, is scheduled to appear temorrow before the Anglo-American Inquiry Committee which 11 open its hearings with brief statements by Government officials. Dr. Weizmann 11 testify on the historical relationships of the Jewish people to the Jewish land, d on the moral and humane basis of the Jewish demand for Palestine.

Testimony concerning the demand for the immediate establishment of Pelestine a Jevish state will be given on Monday by David Ben Gurion, chairman of the execute of the Jevish Agency. Moshe Shertok, head of the political department of the many, will testify Monday on the twenty-five years of British rule in Palestine.

Members of the inquiry committee today visited the Old City section of Jerusam and were blessed by Chief Rabbi Usiel at the Churvah Synagogue, the oldest in lastine.

Sub-Committees Hold Hearings in Neighboring Arab Countries

Two sub-committees of the Angio-American inquiry committee, each composed of tree members, are now visiting Sandi Arabia and Iraq, and Syria and Lebanon, Harold ealy and Leelie Rood, British and American secretaries of the committee, today revealat a press conference here. More than 50 journalists representing the press of all ations of the world were present at the conference.

Bealy and Rood also reported that two days of the hearings in Palestine would be devoted to representatives of the Jevish Agency and two would be assigned to Arab Igher Committee spokesmen. The secretaries also disclosed that the members of the bint committee will spend five days in hearings here, then tour the country for a set, after which they will spend five more days taking testimony before proceeding o Switzerland where they will write their report.

Nevemen asked Bealy and Rood whether the sub-committees now touring the Arab tates would take measures to protect Iraqi Jeve giving pro-Zionist testimony, in view if the fact that Zionism is illegal in Iraq. Rood replied: The committee is taking ill precautions possible, but obviously the safest procedure is to submit written vicence. The committee can also be depended upon to know if anyons is testifying maker presents."

Committee Doesn't Want Newsmen on Its Tour of Palestine

The secretaries also stated that no arrangements had been made for press repsentatives to accompany the committee on its tour of Palestine, because the members sol that they might learn more if their arrival at villages, collective farms and red settlements is not announced beforehend. They added:

"The committee is going to have great difficulty getting the feel of the county in such a short time. They do not want to feel they are walking into places as a lateon or as people talking to a large audience. There will be both conducted tours no random sampling of the population. Certainly there is nothing secret in the comfittee's course," they concluded.

Asked why no interim report had been issued at Vienna, Rood declared that it as thought that the interrelation of the two problems—the problem of the European extends and an examination of the political, social, and economic problems of Pales—ins—was too great to permit the issuance of an interim report at that time. Rood lee pointed out physical difficulties were involved, since the committee was both aking testimony and colleting reports, with some reports still unwritten and some moyean testimony still untained at the time. Beely intimated that the issuance of an aterim report was still not ruled out.

TI-SEMITES ATTEMPT TO SET FIRE TO ZIONIST CLUBS IN RUMANIA; SPLIT AMONG JEWS GROWN

BUCHAREST, March 7. (JTA) -- An attempt to set fire to all Zionist youth clubs the city of Dorchoi, near the Bessarabian border, was barely prevented by action of cal authorities, it was reported here today.

The report said that anti-Semitic hoodlums this week raided the clubs and wreckall the furniture there, before the police arrived. They also invaded a synagogue attempted to set the building afire.

The internal strife within the Jewish community in Rumania is assuming a sharper aracter with the passing of each day, and is being watched by the Government. Of the mpeting groups, one is led by Dr. William Filderman and the other by M.A. Saraceanu, prmer executive secretary of the Union of Rumanian Jews.

The fight between the two started after the formation, last summer, of a Demoatic Committee in Rumania, in which the Jevish Communists, the Hashomer Hatzair, the chuld Party and various outstanding Jews participated. The Zionist Organization, the wish Party and the local section of the World Jevish Congress refused to join the new dy. The central committee of the Union of Rumanian Jews similarly decided not to in the Democratic Committee. However, Seraceann joined the new body contrary to the scision of his central committee. Whereupon he was expelled from the Union.

New Jewish Group Claims To Be the Sole Representative Body

The expulsion of Saraceanu resulted in the establishment, by him and his followre, of a Democratic Jewish Union which held its own conference last January, attended 7 109 delegates. Later the new organization changed its name to Jewish Union and adlated its claim as the only Union of Jews in Rumania.

Dr. William Filderman, president of the Union of Rumanian Jews, who is not recogized by the new central Jewish body, does not deny the existence of the Union formed by . Saraceenn. He has dealt with various Government offices as president of the Union f Rumanian Jews, was condicilly received there, and was also given replies by them. Owever, last week, the Rumanian radio carried a broadcast declaring that there are no wo Unions of Rumanian Jews, and that the only union existing is the one led by Mr. araceanu. The broadcast added that "Dr. Filderman is not authorized to speak for the nion,"

The Zionist Organization of Rumania, the Jewish Party and the local branch of the World Jewish Congress do not recognize Saraceanu's organization and are all main-sthing contact with Dr. Filderman's group. The Yichud, which unites various Zionist roups, has, thus fer, taken no stand in the conflict between the two competing Unions. The Filderman is still holding his post as president of the Federation of Jewish Communities, since no congress of Jewish communities has been held subsequent to Rumania's liberation from the pro-Mazi regime.

ZECH COVERNMENT BARS MEMBERS OF ANTI-SPACTIC CROUPS FROM VOTING IN NATIONAL ELECTIONS

FRAGUE, March 7. (JTA) -- The Czech Government today published a list of 34 reganizations, whose numbers will not be permitted to take part in the coming national elections.

Included emong the groups on the list are all anti-Semitic organizations and any association which used the word "aryan" in its title. In Slovakia, all those who were coipients of Jewish property which had been "aryanized" will be barred from the polls.

MANGERS OF ALLIED FORCES WHO ENLISTED IN PALESTINE EXEMPTED FROM IMMIGRATION LAWS

JERUSALEM, March 7. (JTA) -- Members or discharged members of the Allied forces who originally enlisted in Palestine, as well as their vives and children under the age of 18, are exempted from the laws restricting immigration to the country, it was ennounced in the Official Gazette today. They will be admitted to the country without any hindrence.

(A cable from the correspondent of the Jevieh Telegraphic Agency in Prague reported that, after several months idling in Boehmia, about 200 Palestinian Jevs, who were formerly Czech citizens and who volunteered for service with the Czech Army at the outbreak of the war under the promise that they would be allowed to return to Palestine at the end of the war, were finally informed today that they will be permitted to re-outer Palestine early next month.)

JEWISH COMMUNITY IN VIEWNA TO HOLD FIRST FREE ELECTION; HAS ORLY 3,700 WOTERS

VIEWA, March 7. (JTA) -- For the first time in eight years a free election for the Vienna Jevish Community Council will be held here on April 7, when the 36 members of the Council will be chosen, Jevish leaders announced today.

Electoral laws were recently changed so as to permit all Jews over 21 years of age now residing in Vienna, regardless of tarpaing status or nationality, to vote in the forthcoming elections. The electoral register of 138,000 before Hitler has been reduced to 3,700. Four groups have formed an alliance to present a united ticket in opposition to the Jewish merchants organization. The four are: the Zioniet Organization, the International Committee of Transient Jews, the Eungarian Joint Committee, and the Jewish Section of the Austrian Campers Organization.

After the elections, the community council will take the lead in organizing a federation of Austrian Jewish community councils, the announcement said. The federation will include the Jewish community councils of Linz, Immsbruck, and Isohl.

STATEMENT THAT BULGARIAN JEWS DO NOT WANT IMPLICATION TO PALESTINE EVOKES PROTEST

SOFIA, March ?. (JTA) -- Lionist leaders here took exception today to a statement broadcast in America and Britain, to the effect that the majority of Joss in Bulgaria do not desire to emigrate to Falsetine. The statement was made by David Jeroban, president of the Jovish Consistory in Bulgaria.

Vitali Haimoff, president of the Zionist Organization of Bulgaria, today declared: "We consider it our duty to announce that Mr. Jeroham had no right to make such a statement on behalf of Bulgarian Jewry. The Zionist Organization of Bulgaria has a membership of 13,000, which is one-quarter of the total Jewish population, and, together with their families, the organized Zionists represent three-quarters of Bulgarian Jewry.

"The large majority of the Jews in Bulgaria have a teen desire to emigrate immodiately to Palestine, as they are fully conscious of the necessity for the Jewish people establishing their can fatherland in Kretz Israel. This, and not because they disapprove of the present regime in Bulgaria, is the reason say they want to go to Palestine," the Zionist leader concluded.

NAMES YOUTHS SENTENCED IN PALESTINE FOR POSSESSION OF ARMS: NEW EXPLOSIONS REPORTED

JERUSALIM, March 7. (JTA) -- Five Jevish youths were sentenced today by a silitary court to five years imprisonment each on the charge of carrying arms illegally. They were arrested on Jan. 26 near the Dead Sea, when it was discovered that they had two pistols and four Polish hand grenades in their possession.

Three explosions were reported today from the Kfar Monahem area in Southern Felsetine, where army camps and sirficids are situated. No details were given,

WAZI WAR CRIMINALS AT NURSWIKEG TRIAL SEEK TO POSE AS "PROTECTORS" OF JEWS

NURSHEERS, Merch 7. (JTA) -- As the defense of the 20 Nazis accused of war primes at the Allied trial here begins to unfold, it is becoming more and more evident that many of the defendants will attempt to base their case on claims of having protected Jews, or at least of not having played an active part in their extermination in German and German-occupied Europe.

The military tribunal today heard counsel for Paldur von Schirach, Nazi youth leader and Gauleiter of Vienna, ask for the calling of vitnesses and admission of documents in an attempt to prove that Schirach had actually protected individual Jews in the face of criticism and had opposed the anti-Jewish policy of the Maçis.

The former Jugend leader, who once declared that his contribution to European culture was the __sportation of Vienness Jews to the East, where they were enslaved and elaughtered, will try to prove that his wife, with his permission, interceded with Hitler to mitigate the German policy of extermination of Jews.

Hjalmer Schacht, Nazi economic vizard, who financed Germany's rearmament, will call vitnesses to prove that he protected Jows and that on May 3, 1935 he presented a monorandum to Hitler asking for legal protection for the Jows. Fritz Schkel, Nazi labor chief, will also try to demonstrate that he was no enemy of the Jows, it was re-wealed today.

War Crimes Prosecutor Trying To Reveal Story of "Greatest Murderer In History"

LOHDON, March 7. (JTA) -- An attempt to bring to light the complete story of Otto Moll, described as "the greatest nurderer in all history," has been made by British war orimes prosecutor Major Draper, the London Daily Express reports from Hemburg today.

Mall, condemned for the marder of one Jevish boy, is now awaiting death in the Landsberg fortress in the American zone. As an S.S. leader, Mall was in charge of the oreastoriums at the Birksneu and Oswiscim death camps. Major Draper asked the American commandant at Leadsberg to permit him to interrogate Mall before he diss. "The world should know the attent of this man's fantastic orimss," Major Draper said.

I.Y. STATE LEGISLATORS INFRODUCE BULL OUTLANING BIAS BY EDULATIONAL INSULTUTIONS

NEW YORK, March 7. (JTA) -- Sometor Walter J. Mahomey and Assemblyman Bernard fasts assessed the introduction in the State Legislature of a bi-partisan bill which would make racial and religious discrimination by educational institutions unlawful and subject riclators to verious penalties and to the automatic loss of tax exemptions.

The new proposal is based largely on socialogical and legal studies made by the karries Jowish Congress. As the legislature is scheduled to aljourn in less than three weeks, there appears to be little chance that the bill can be adopted at this session.

U.S. ATTORNEY GENERAL ISSUES ORDER TO PROTECT CIVIL RIGHTS OF ALL MINCRITIES

WASHINGTON, March 7. (JTA) -- Attorney General Tom C. Clark has issued a directive to all United States attorneys to protect the civil rights of minorities for the full extent and intent of the Constitution and of statutory provisions."

Pointing out increasing symptoms of intolerance, the Attorney General instructed that the attorneys "devote special attention and investigation to protection of all Magricans in their civil liberties, regardless of race or color.

"Civil rights of minorities in this country were never under greater threat then at this time," he said. "It is my purpose to protect human rights and civil liberties, whosever they are infringed, to the full extent and intent of the Constibution and of statutory provisions."

DR. CRIMPERG. LEADER OF LIBERATED JEWS IN CERMANY. ASKS THEIR TRANSFER TO PALESTINE

NEW YORK, March 7. (JTA) -- The army of Jevish fighters who battled the Nazis from the ghettos and concentration comps of Europe went to go home, and home to them is Palestine, said Dr. Zelman Grinberg, president of the Council of Liberated Jevs in Sermany, at a meeting in Membattan Center tonight. The meeting was sponsored by the American Jevish Conference, at whose request, Dr. Grinberg was flown to the United States from Munich.

"During the war, which for us has not yet ceased, the Jewish people throughout the world fought on four major fronts," Dr. Grinberg told an audience which jammed the large meeting hall. "They fought as partisons, in the European underground ermies. They fought in the Jewish Brigade from Palestine. They fought under the flage of all of the United Nations, And they fought on a too little recognized front—the front of the ghettos and concentration camps.

"In factories, in construction camps, on road-building projects, Jewish slave laborers sabotaged, slowed-down, and passively resisted the execution of Wehrmacht plans. Work on the sirdrome at Kannas, Lithuania, for instance, was so successfully sabotaged that Wehrmacht troops could not use the flying field until the Russian states were almost upon them," he declared.

Dr. Grinberg said he spoke not only for the Jevish survivors, but for those who died, and left a holy testament which was "inscribed on our scale by thattering machine gms, absorbed into our smalls through the funes of gas chambers, by uncel into our hearts by the pittless fire of crematoria." He appealed to American Jewny to help the displaced Jews achieve their goal—to heave Germany and go to Palestine.

Touro stragogue designated by U.S. Covernment as rational historic site

WASHINGTON, March 7. (JTA) -- Historic Touro Synagogue of Hosport, Rhode Island, oldest surviving synagogue building in America and one of the finest remaining examples of colonial erolitorours, has been designated as a national historic site, Acting Socretary of the Interior Oscar L. Chapman announced today.

Jews from Spain, Portugal, Holland and the West Indies settled in Newport as early as 1678. Dedicated in 1763, the synagogue has served as a place of worship for the Jovish congregation of Newport for almost 200 years. Before they were able to maild a temple the early settlers hald religious services in their house.

Ownership of the synagogue will remain unchanged, the Department announced, but the Mational Park Service will provide professional assistance in caring for the historic site and in interpreting it to the public.
