AFIRT BOMBS EXPLODE IN TEL AVIV; WOUNDED JEWISE POLICEMAN DIES IN JERUSALEM

TEL AVIV, March 10. (JTA) -- Heavy explosions, caused by leaflet bombs, toy echoed through Jaffa and in the direction of Sarona, a suburb of Tel Aviv, where Palestine police mobile force camp is located. There were no casualties and no

Earlier tenight, it was reported from Jerusalem that a Jevish policeman, who do been wounded last week during the raid of 14 armed Jevish men on the British milliry camp at Sarafand, died from the wounds he received while resisting the raiders.

THODOX JEWS TORTURED AND KILLED IN POLAND; JEWISE DEMONSTRATIONS IN CRACON AND LUBLIN

WARSAW, March 10. (JTA) -- Two Jewish demonstrations, one in Cracow and the the in Lublin, were held during the weekend at funerals of Jews killed by fascist and operating against the Government and conducting anti-Jewish terror throughout so country.

More than 7,000 Jews participated in the Cracov funeral of four orthodox Jewish assengers who were dragged from a bus and tortured and killed. The bus was on the du-Cracov road. The Jewish passengers were a route to Cracov to attend a Mizrachi inference, which was scheduled to open there with the participation of Heshl Farbstein, and Mizrachi leader, who had come to Folend from Palestine for the conference.

In Lublin, the entire Jevish population participated in the funeral of two we killed by fascist guerrillas. A Jevish woman was seriously wounded by the terprists during attacks on Jevish homes.

The continued murder of Jews by organized fascist bands is keeping the Jews moughout Poland in constant fear for their lives. There is no doubt here that the solat groups who are conducting the anti-Jewish terror are being financed by Polish tenents from abroad interested in undersining the present Government, which is doing to utnot to ourbeanti-Jewish activities, but which has not succeeded in suppressing te terrorists.

OVIET AUTHORITIES OPEN HIMANIAN PRONTER FOR UNLINDERED REPATRIATION OF JEMS

BUCHARRET, March 10. (JTA) ... Soviet authorities today opened the frontier offeen Rumania and Soviet Urraine, permitting unhindered repatriation of Rumanian Jews run the USER to their native towns.

It is estimated that at least 10,000 of the Jews who had been deported by the ro-Mari regime to Transmistris will now return to their former homes in Rumania. Hundreds of them have been coming into Rumania even before the frontier was declared open. he Joint Distribution Committee is organizing aid for the repatriates and is making reparations for receiving many thousands of survivors whose return has now been made casible.

TENS IN BUIGARIA GET BACK THEIR CONFISCATED REAL ESTATE; FORCED SALES ARE CANCELLED

SOFIA, March 10. (JTA) -- The Bulgarian Government today announced that real estate confiscated from Jews during the pro-Mazi regime will be returned to Jewsels owners without any special legal proceedings.

It is estimated that 8,288 buildings, valued at 1,850,000,000 levas, vill thus be roturned to Jews. Most of these buildings are now under the supervision of the State Property Administration. The property vill be returned not only to Bulgarian levs, but also to Jewish residents of Bulgaria who are Greek and Yugoslav citizens, the official announcement said.

Today's announcement followed the issuance of a law last week cancelling the leeds on forced seles of real estate by Jews during the pro-Nazi regime, when their property was either confiscated or "aryanized." As a result of this law, 176 deeds are cancelled over the week-end and the Jewish owners took immediate possession of their property.

BERING OF STUDENTS AT BUCHAREST UNIVERSITY TURNED INTO ANTI-SEMITIC DEMONSTRATION

BUCHAREST, March 10. (JTA) -- A student meeting at the Bucharest University, and in the presence of Prof. Fotino, dean of the law faculty, and Prof. Strat of the same faculty, was converted into an anti-Semitic demonstration yesterday.

Prof. Fortino and Prof. Strat are leaders of the National Liberal Party of hich Dinu Bratianu is the head. Anti-Jewish speeches were delivered at the meeting by tudents, while the faculty members made no attempt to check them. The entire atmosphere of the meeting was reminispent of the pre-liberation days, when the country was fulled by the anti-Semitic and pro-Mazi Antonescu government.

erman jews, averaging 62 years of age, too old to enigrate, jewish leader says

LONDON, March 10. (JTA) -- The fact that the average age of German Jews toay is 62 and that very few young men and women survive there was advanced today as the principal reason for the small percentage of German Jews who told the Anglo-Ameritan inquiry committee that they wented to go to Palestime.

Dr. Philip Auerbach, chairman of the Jevish communities of the Rhineland and estphalia, at a press conference here arranged by the World Jevish Congress, pointed nt that such a community "ghviously" could not emigrate. He also noted that many of he Jeve had intermerried and were loth to leave their families.

Speaking of the British civil administration in Germany, Dr. Amerbach declared hat generally there was no anti-Semitism provalent among British officials, although here had been several individual instances where civilian administrators had exhibited anti-jevish bias.

KEFELLER CONTRIBUTES \$100,000 TO UNITED JEWISH APPEAL; ROSENWALD LAUDS GIFT

NEW YORK, March 10. (JTA) -- A contribution of \$100,000 from John D. Rockeller, Jr., one of the largest gifts to be made for Jevish relief and rehabilitation breash, was received by William Rosenvald, national chairman of the \$100,000,000 caming of the United Jevish Appeal, it was announced today.

The contribution was in response to a letter from Mr. Rosenwald in which he tlined the tragic needs of the 1,400,000 Jevieh survivors of Naxi oppression in rope and of the wast tasks of relief and rebabilitation that must be performed by a agencies which compose the United Jevieh Appeal. Mr. Rosenwald stressed the fact at the problem of the Jevs of Europe is not "an exclusively Jevieh problem." He it: "The problem is one of general human concern. These Jevs were the first and imary victims of what we know now was a planned conspiracy against world civilizanon and their restoration to equality with their neighbors is in the best intereste fall maniful."

In advising Mr. Rosenyald of his contribution, Mr. Rockefeller declared that he plight of the Jevish survivors abroad makes an appeal that needs no argument or inforcement. I shall count it a privilege to have a part in this campaign. May the mpaign meet with the success which it is so richly deserves." In his letter of inovledgment, Mr. Rosenvald characterized the Rockefeller gift as "a priceless symbol the cooperation between faiths, which is one of the distinctive marks of the Amerina vay of life."

Connecticut Conference Pledges \$3,200,000 to United Jevish Appeal

NEW HAVEN, Connecticut, March 10. (JTA) -- The hunger, homeleasness and destation of Europe's 1,400,000 Jevish survivors is a major issue which "the governments the world must recognize as a primary factor in the foundation of a permanent sace," Senator Alben W. Berkley, Majority Leader of the United States Senate, declarater today in addressing 350 Jevish leaders meeting at the Hotel Taft for the extra-dinary Connecticut State Conference of the United Jevish Appeal.

MANISSION LISTS 3,500,000 JEWISH BOOKS STOLEN BY NAZIS; WILL SEEK TO LOCATE THEM

NEW YORK, March 10. (JTA) -- A tentative listing of more than 3,500,000 ooks and 5,000 rare manuscripts and old prints looted by the Maris from 430 Jewish thraries, art collections, and archives was released here today by Dr. Salo W. Baron, hairman of the Commission on European Jewish Cultural Recomstruction.

The catalogue, prepared after ten months of work by a staff of scholars, iterary experts, and research workers, also lists 273 of the more important collections of Jevish books and art pieces in non-Jevish institutions, which were stolen by he lazis.

This Summer a six-man team headed by Dr. Baron, a professor of Jevish history and literature at Columbia University, will go to Europe in an attempt to locate the boks which they have listed and attempt to establish their rightful owners. They will a joined in their task by groups from England and Palestine.

The Commission was set up by the Conference on Jevish Relations in May last er with the sim of advising the United Nations on the restoration of Jevish cultural ife in Europe and establishing a trusteeship for the eventual redistribution of religious end cultural properties. It is a non-purtisan group made up of scholars and religious leaders from all over the world.
