#### POSSIBLE AMERICAN REACTION TO TRANSJORDAN INDEPENDENCE AROUSES INTEREST IN LONDON

LONDON, March 24. (JTA) -- There is keen interest in various circles here concerping possible American and Russian reaction to Britain's granting independence to Trans.jordan.

The Manchoster Guardian commenting on the treaty, which was signed on Friday, predicts that there will be both approval and opposition by the other great powers. The article quotes from the memoirs of Emir Abdullah, ruler of Transjordan, to prove that he does not balieve in Arab unity.

The London Times, in an editorial yesterday, avoided any mention of the Jewish aspect of the issue. It emphasized that the ceremony in the Foreign Office which marked the signing of the treaty was largely recognition of an accomplished fact. The editorial praised Emir Abdullah's achievements.

The Board of Deputies of British Jews today adopted a resolution describing the granting of independence to Transjorden as "a unilateral abandonment of the obligations of the Mandatory under the Mandate, as far as three-quarters of the territory of Palestine is concerned, and a breach of Article 80 of the UNO charter," which provides that until trusteeship arrangements are entered into, the existing international instruments to which TWO members may be parties remain unaltered. The resolution also says that the Board affirms the Jewish peoples! legal claim to the whole of Palestine.

A.L. Easterman, political secretary of the World Jewish Congress, presenting the report of the Board's Palestine Committee, attacked the failure of the Colonial Office to reply to the Deputies' representations on Transjordan as a "grave discourtesy." He said that further action on the issue was planned.

#### WORLD ZIGNIST CONGRESS WILL OPEN ON AUGUST 7, JEWISH AGENCY DECIDES

JERUSALFM, March 24. (JTA) -- The 22nd World Zionist Congress, the first since 1939, will open here on August 7, it was decided today at a meeting of the Jevish Agency executive.

The first anniversary of the establishment of the Arab League was celebrated here yesterday, by both Moslem and Christian Arabs. Rev. Nikilai Khoury, a leader of the 130,000 Christian Arabs in Palestine and Transjordan, spoke from the pulpit of the Aska Mosque, one of the holiest shrines of Talem, from which no Christian had ever before spoken.

Jamal Russeini, head of the Pelestine Arch Party, who was recently permitted by the Government to return to Pelestine, also spoke from the same pulpit. He deliverid a violent anti-Jewish address, urging complete social and moral ostracism of Arab land brokers who sell land to Jews.

#### CERMAN COURT TO TRY NAZIS CHARGED WITH DESCRIPTION OF SYNAGOGUES IN 1938 POGROM

WEYSSENBURG, Germany, March 24. (JTA) -- Gormans accused of anti-Jewish activities will be tried before a German court here this week, in the first legal action by Germans against Germans since the collapse of the Nazi regime.

The defendants who are charged with burning down the Weissenburg synagogue in the 1938 pogroms, are forty Nazis, including the district gauletter and other local officials. They have been in American custody for several months. The trial, which will open on Tuesday, is expected to last three weeks. It will be conducted by the county court with headquarters at Nuramberg, which will move here for the occasion.

#### WEREBERG TRIBUNAL IS ASKED TO WITHDRAW "RITUAL MURDER" CHARGE AGAINST STREICHER

NURCHEERG, March 24. (JTA) -- The International Military Tribunal was urged yesterday to withdraw the charge that Julius Streicher disseminated "ritual murder" propaganda against Jews by falsifying quotations from the Talmud.

Streicher's counsel indicated that if the prosecution would not agree to withdrawal of this charge, a certain Dr. Bishof, described by Streicher's lawyer as "a great expert" will be summoned to testify in behalf of the Mazi Jew-baiter. Bishof, the attorney said, will prove that certain excerpts from the Talmud appearing in Streicher's publications were not translated "thoughtlessly or inaccurately."

The lawyer for Alfred Rosenberg, who is also charged with spreading anti-Jevish propaganda throughout the world, also filed a plea with the court. Stating that
anti-Semitiem in Germany "is an irrational force," Rosenberg's lawyer asked the tribunal to permit him to present additional documents proving that anti-Semitiem was not a
new movement introduced into Germany by the teachings of Rosenberg, but existed there
since the 6th century. "National Socialism," he argued, "was not the first to lead
the German people astray in the direction of anti-Semitiem."

#### UNDERGROUND RADIO ADMITS PALESTING NAZI MURDERED BY MEMBERS OF JENISH RESISTANCE

JENUSALIM, March 24. (JTA) -- The "Voice of Israel" transmitter, which is operated by the Esganah, said today that Cotthell Megacy former mayor of the Germany colony of Serons and leading Palestine Mazi, was killed by members of the Jewish Resistance Movement. Wagner was shot dead by an unidentified youth on Friday on the outskirts of Tel Ariv.

The broadcast declared that the Palestine Jevieh community "will not tolerate Germans living here in a sare haven, while Jeve are being deported without trial. It demanded that all Germans be deported from Palestine, that their property be confiscated and that demobilized Jevieh servicemen be settled on their land.

#### AMERICANS CAPTURE FORMER OSWIECIM GUARD; KILLED MANY CZECHOSLOVAKIAN JENS

PRAGUE, March 24. (JTA) -- Heinrich Sommerhoff, a former guard at the Oswiecim extermination camp, has been captured by American military police, the Czech press reports. His extradition to Czechoslovakia will be demanded since he is charged with murdening menny Czechoslovakian Jews.

Eliahu bobkin, head of the immigration department of the Jevich Agency, arrived here today to negotiate for the emigration of Jevs from Czechoslovaria to Palestins.

### BEID-AMERICAN INQUIRY COMMITTEE HEARS PALESTINE COVERNMENT SPOKESMAN, CHURCH LEADERS

JERUSALEM, March 24. (JTA) -- John V.W. Shaw, Chief Secretary of the Palestine Government, and ranking British administrative official after High Commissioner Sir Alan Cunningham, appeared before the full Anglo-American inquiry committee yesteray. It is presumed that Secretary Shaw presented the official Government position, mut no definite information is available at present because his testinony was given at a closed session.

In a statement to the press, the inquiry committee replied to the American Mendet Emergency Council's charges that the official transcript of the committee's messions had deliberately emitted those sections of the testimony of Jemal el Hussenin and Aumi Bey Abdul Hadi, Arab Higher Committee spokesmen, which admitted the association between the Nazis and the ex-Muttl. The committee replied that the Arabs had spoken in English with an accent which was not familiar to the American court reporter and that he had, therefore, missed parts of the witnesses' statements.

The committee, however, insisted that its members were well aware of the Arab testimony and that efforts were being made to correct the official transcript. The press statement also said that the committee regretted that the American Zionists had released their accusation to the press before asking the inquiry body for its explanation.

Yesterday's morning session was devoted largely to religious spokesmen, with representatives of the Anglican Church, the American Episcopal Church, the Greek Ortho-ion Church, and various other Eastern Christian Churches, all of Pelestine, appearing. The representative of the Maronite Church, who's Beirut Archbishop, Monsignor Ignatz Kumberak, last week called for a Jewish state in Palestine, did not appear for "reasons of health."

#### Anglican Bishop Opposed To JVA Because It Would "Sacrifice" Holy Places

The Right Reverend Dr. Weston H. Stevart, Anglican Bishop of Jerusalem, expressed opposition to the proposed Jordan Valley Authority for the harnessing of the ordan's vaters for irrigation and electric pover. "because Christian sentiment would be profoundly shocked if the holy places were secrificed to any nationalist or imperialist scheme of industry or commerce." He said that if Palestine is partitioned, bottler Bethlehem nor Galiles eshould be included in the Jevish or Arab sections.

He also deplored the "regrettable extent to which politics was allowed to persente the education of the young," pointing out that the Jevish community conducted its own schools and that the Palestine Administration supervised Arab schools. The firector of the Government's education department, W.J. Farrel, testifying earlier, asserted that Arab schools were superior to the Jevish.

Greek Orthodox Bishop George Hakim of Galilee, speaking for the assembled spresentatives of various Eastern Christian Churches, opposed Zionism, stating that Alestine was an Arab land and should be kept that way. He further stated that Christian Arabe and Moslem Arabe live together on the best of torms.

Henry Cattan, an Arab lawyer appearing for the Arab Higher Committee, charged that the "Arabs of Palestine have been crucified and bleeding for the last 29 years," is presented a series of legal arguments asserting Arab claims to Palestine and denying Britain's right to dispose of the country. During cross-examination by American committee member Frank Ayablotte, Cattan Assied that the influx of Jews to Palestine had increased the Arab standard of living, either by improving cultivation of the land or raising wages to a higher level than that existing in other Arab countries. The Ayablotte remarked "how interesting, we heard contradictory opinions in neighboring countries."

# SUTH AFRICAN MATIONALISTS ATTACK JEWS IN PARLIAMENT FOR ASKING INCREASED IMMIGRATION

JOHANNESBURG, March 24. (JTA) -- A suggestion by a Government party member, keris Kentridge, that South Africa liberalize its immigration laws resulted in an attack on Jews in Parliament yesterday.

Kentridge, who is active in Zionist affairs here, pointed out that South Mrica needed European immigration, and criticized as short-sighted the policy of closing the country to all immigration. He urged, at the same time, that Frime Minister mats, who is going to London soon, use his influence to secure the opening of Palestine to Jews.

Kontridge was assailed by Nationalist deputies led by Dr. D.F. Malan. Malan maked the question of Germans who are still interned, declaring that if the Government punished Germans as Germans, Jows should be deported tecams they are Jows. Deputy M.S. Bremmer said that history would stand aghast not at the mistreatment of Jows in Germany, but at the postwar treatment of the German people.

A Nationalist deputy named Leroux urged Jews to desist from advocating increased immigration, as "this caused increased anti-Semitism," while another Nationalist, S.D. Becker, charged that "sews had grown fat at the expense of Afrikaners."

Deputy T.J. Havorth of the United (Government) Party denounced the Nationalist deputies' anti-Semitiem, citing Jevish contributions to the South African war effort and pointing out that the Nationalist deputies remained neutral.

#### FIRST SHIPMENT OF PALESTINE ORANGES SINCE OUTBREAK OF WAR ARRIVES IN RUMANIA

BUCHARREST, March 24, (JTA) -- The first shipment of Palestine cranges to wrive in Rumania since the outbreak of the var was being unloaded today. Their import was made possible by a Covernment decree authorizing Rumanian merchants to use their assets abroad.

The importer, Moshe Rothman, told the Jevish Telegraphic Agency that he hoped to increase imports from Felestine, to include medicaments and olive oil.

The Revisionist Party here has voted to abide by the decision of its sister marties abroad and participate in the election of delegates to the forthcoming World Monist Congress.

## WITED STATES MUST TAKE LEAD IN SOLVING IMMURRATION PROBLEM, SAYS TALE SOCIOLOGIST

HEW YORK, March 24. (JTA) .- The United States must take a leading part in solving the immigration problem, Dr. Maurice R. Davie, chairman of the department of Sociology at Yale University and director of the Study of Recent Immigration from brose, declares in a pemphlet just published here. The two-year study was organized by the National Refugee Service.

Dr. Davie points out that many classes of immigrants increase economic wellleing in American by creating increased job opportunities. Among these he includes beigrants who bring capital into the country, those with business experience or skills which American may need, and those who are willing to take jobs for which American labor cannot be found. Dr. Davie finds that there is a widespread feeling against a "closed door" policy, although opinion in America appears to favor limited immigration.
