AMERICAN CREW OF REFUGEE SHIP TO BE TRIED TODAY: 597 PASSENCERS DEPORTED TO CYPRUS

JERUSALEM. Mar. 9. (JTA) -- Eighteen American crew members of the immigrant ship Ben Hecht are to be arraigned in Magistrates Court in Haifa tomorrow on: charges of aiding and abetting illegal immigration, while 597 of the vessel's passengers were tonight en route to Cyprus aboard two British deportation ships. Two U.S. newspapermen who travelled on the Ben Hecht may be charged with illegal entry.

The ship, also known as the Abril, was captured last night a few hours before terrorist attacks in Jerusalem. Tel Aviv and Jaffa precipitated violent battles between troops and Jewish extremists in the areas under martial law. According to the latest casualty figures, four Jews, one British soldier and one policeman were killed last night and 15 Jews injured, three of them seriously. One of the dead was an 18year-old girl, Shoshana Rachimoff, who was struck by a bullet while walking in the street in Tel Aviv. This afternoon, Esther Tashua, 18, and Yechiel Bopani were seriously wounded by a patrol which fired on a crowd in Tel Aviv.

Hassia Mizrachi. 45. a Jewish policeyoman attached to the police station at Rehovoth, was killed last night by four masked men. It is believed that she was working for the Sritish Intelligence and had been responsible for the capture of several terrorist suspects. Previously four attempts on her life had been made.

Agency Meeting Postponed When Silver, Others Fail to Arrive

Meanwhile, the Jewish Agency meeting scheduled for tomorrow morning has been postponed until Wednesday because Dr. Abba Hillel Silver and other members have not yet arrived here. When the Agency members who flew here by special plane from New York arrived at 2 a.m. this morning, they were barred from leaving the aerodrome until daylight. Goldie Meirson, chief of the Agency's political department here. who went to Lydda Airport to greet them, was not allowed to see them. The arrivals included Moshe Shertok, Dr. Moshe Sheh, Mrs. Rose Halperin, Daniel Frisch, Mrs. Herman Shulman and Joseph Schechtman.

The Haganah radio, Voice of Israel, commenting tonight on the week of martial law said that it has proved "the complete bankruptey of the Palestine police and troops, who have not succeeded in crushing terrorism." It added that "only the Yishuv itself is able to combat terrorism, without the cooperation of the British. but the British have chosen instead to destroy the Yishuv's economy by imposing martial lav." ..

The 599 refugees who arrived on the Ben Hecht carried "passports" issued by the Hebrew Committee of Liberation. They were signed by Eri Jabotinsky, son of the late Revisionist leader Vladimir Jabotinsky, and dated Feb. 20. Two of the arrivals, a husband and wife, were allowed to remain here because the woman is expecting a child. The chip, whose whereabouts had provoked a series of wild rumors for the past three weeks, displaced 800 tons and was the cleanest and most seaworthy of any of the blockade runners that have arrived in recent months.

Tension Still High in Tel Aviv After Night of Violence

Although the situation in the martial law areas had quieted down today, twistion still ram high in Tel Aviv as a result of last night's events. It was aumounced that three of the four Jews Hilled died during an attack on a police station in Sarran, while the fourth was shot dead by a military patrol around dawn this horning. In others, Marthel Mayer, 58, and Ben Ziom Shtekelis, 65, died of heart attack during the street battle around Citrus House, British military headquarters which was the chief target of the attacks.

A military camp in Maifa was also attacked during the night and three guardinjured. The attackers escaped without injury. A group or masked men invaded a sevelry shop in Maifa this afterioon and escaped with \$10,000.

Troops yesterday interrupted Sabbath services in several synagogues in the Meah Shearim quarter of Jerusales in their hunt for extremists and arms caches.

The general manager of the Palestine railway system has amounced the official closing of the port of Tal Aviv. Chigose destrined for that city will be discharged at other ports and stored there until permission is obtained to send them to Tal Aviv. Goods now on route to the city will be permitted to entar if they fall within specified categories. Storage charges will continue to accumulate on all goods destined for the controlled areas but which have been discharged elsewhere.

The Arab pross has been scoffing at the British actions in Folestins. They refer to the restrictive regulations as "childiah strategems," demanding stronger measures. The Arab advice to the British Army is: "Whenever mential law is imposed, it must be accompanied by severe restraint of freedom, large-scale military activity, the said violent pressure on public activities."

Nazi Leader Testifies Slovak Officials Grabbed Jewish Property

BRATISLAVA, Mar. 9. (JTA) -- H.H. Viszliczeny, ex-destapo leader and Nazi advisor on Jewish affairs to the puppet Slovak Government, disclosed yesterday at the Var orimes trial of Josef Timo, former head of the Slovak Government, that a major share of the property seized from Jews was distributed to the families and friends of officials of the government.

He also testified that as early as 1942 the Slovak officials offered Slovak Jews to the Mazis as slave laborers. He stated that when the Germans demanded the deportation of all Jews over the age of 18, the Slovak officials insisted upon extending the category to all over the age of 16.

HUNGARIAN MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AUTHORIZES USE OF JEMISH HISTORY TEXT IN SCHOOLS

BURAFEST, Mar. 9. (JTA) -- The Ministry of Education has authorized the use of a recently published history of the Jews as a textbook in Hungarian schools, it was amnounced here. The book, entitled "A History of the Jews from the Emplomian Captivity to the Present," was published by the Budapest Jewish Community.

The Jewish publication, Uj Elet, has protested the continued use of textbooks in Hungarian universities which contain anti-Semitic and fascist propagation. It asserts that some of the texts attack the Jews for their "anti-nationalistic attitude."

SCOTTAND MARD UNCOVERS UNDERCROUND ANTI-JUMISH GANG; LED BY FORMER MOSLETTING

LOHDON, Mex. 9. (JTA) -- The existence of a vell-organized gang of round storm troopers whose chiect is to terrorize the Jevish population of London and was the trade under the landership of a former associate of Sir Oswald Mouley has been uncovered by Scotland Xard, the Sunday Express reports.

According to the Express, a special squad of detectives operating under Special Yard's directions has been investigating the activities of semi-secret anti-Jevish organizations following recent attacks on symmetries and the proclamation of a "ear on Jevs" by a former associate of Sir Oswald Mosley, Victor Burgess. Burgess was recently released from prison where he was intermed during the way years-

The detectives have established that the center of enti-jewish activities is situated in the Edgere and Burnt Cak districts; where the population is mearing fifty percent jewish. Anti-jewish incidents in this eres have become so frequent that Jewish voterans have set a twenty-four hour guard eround local synapogues. See ish residents have been threatened and entire streets plastered with enti-jewish stickers and posters bearing alogans such as "Jews mast go," or "Mar on the Jews."

The Scotland Yard men discovered that most of the anti-Jevish activities serve the work of a gang of young storm troopers known as the "North-Nest Task Group for Racial Defence." A twenty-two-year-old former public school teacher is the school-teacher of the gang, which comprises, in addition to non-paying members, over fifty regular members gaying weekly dues amounting to six pence (ten cents) per person.

The aim of the organization, as stated in membership cards given duespayers, is to "operate against forces of Jovry in the life of Great Dritain and to oppose participation of any Jew in British public life." The gang has adopted a motto of the Mazi underground which is printed on the membership cards in Garmans "Vir kommen wieder," meaning "We shall return."

Host of the information on the activities of the Burnt Cal group was obtained from a 17-year-old youth who joined the group, but left it after he had found out "what it was all about." He told the Bootland Yard men that the group usually met at night, in coffee shops, where speakers attacked Jews, Rallies were also had at Brde Fark and claswhere.

CANADIAN JUNS PROTEST STATEMENT ATTRIBUTING VICE IN MONTREAL TO JUNS OTHER MINORIFE

ABOUT 5.500 JEWS RESIDE IN FAMINE-STRICKEN AREAS OF RUMANIA. JDC INFORMS RED GROSS

BUCEAREST, Mar. 9. (JTA) -- Enly about 5,500 Jews reside in the faminestricken Moldevian area, the Joint Distribution Committee today informed the Red Cross. The latter organization had contacted the JDC to inquire concerning Jewish needs in Moldavia before it began distribution of the first 4,500 tons of food ordered sent here by Freeident Truess. Most Jews were outset from the rural areas of Moldavia, where most of the relief will go, by the Pro-Mari Antonesou regime.

The J.D.C. amounced today that it will extend assistance to the OSE, Jewish health society, to enable the latter group to care for more young people and to extend its tuberculosis treatment program in Rumania.

Under the new plan, the OSE vill care for boys up to the age of 14 and girls up to the age of 20. Freviously care ended at 12 and 15 years, respectively. New disponenties vill be established for Jewish children, 60 percent of whom are afflicted with tuberculosis, and for adults and present centers will be enlarged. A special program has been worked out for the Transylvanian and Moldavian areas, where the femine has led to an increased incidence of dispasse.

The OSE has disclosed that during the past year it operated 27 branches which maintained a total of 63 centers, including ten children's homes, 24 medical centers, 17 food canteens, nine day homes and three communal haths.

PALESTINE JEWS SEND FOUR DELEGATES TO PAN-ASIATIC CONFERENCE IN DELHI

JERUSALEM, Mar. 9. (JTA) -- The Jews of Falestine will be represented by four delegates at the Pan-Asiatic Congress in New Delhi, India, it was decided jointly by the executives of the Jewish Agency and the Jewish Rational Council. The four are: Prof. Rugo Bergman, Dr. Emanuel Olsohwanger, Itzhak Shimoni and Mrs. S.M. Bevalcyalm.
