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GROUP OF EXODUS REFUGEES TO BE LANDED TODAY: DISEMBARKATION DELAYED BY FOG

HAMBURG, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- The Occan Vigor, first of the three British prihips returning 4,400 Jews to Germany to arrive here, was cased alongside her at 3 p.m. today, after lying anchored in the Elbe estuary since early morning for made it impossible for the vessel to proceed.

Disembarkation of her deportee passengers, which was scheduled to begin at was postponed until tomorrow morning, since British officials want to transport ews to internment camps the same day they are landed. Just before the Ocean docked, the refugees were told that they will be given an hour's grace after official disembarkation hour is set to decide whether they will leave peacefully.

No sound could be heard from the Ocean Vigor as it entered the heavily barhed dock area in a steady drizzle which kept most of the refugees in the crowded s below deck. Using field glasses, a JTA correspondent could see a few heads ge from the portholes. Several men were apparently singing but nothing could eard.

British Assign Three Soldiers To Every Deportee

According to the latest British plan, about 4,200 soldiers will be used in operation, if the refugees refuse to land voluntarily. The plan calls for the of one soldier per passenger, then two, and finally, three, if they need to quell resistance. All troops have been issued 15-inch wooden truncheons, gas masks and y sections of rubber tires for use as arm shields to ward off blows. Several liers to whom the correspondent spoke, made no effort to hide their anti-Semitism, laring that the Jews were causing them a lot of trouble. Others, however, said akly that they did not like the Job.

The dock area is so heavily guarded that it is impossible to get anywhere r the pier where the Ocean Vigor is docked. Wire fences have been erected, comtely penning in the area through which the refugees will pass efter leaving the ps. When the correspondent attempted to enter this morning, before the ships had ived, he was warned to stay out on pain of cancellation of his dock pass privileges. tomorrow and subsequent days.

The nearly 200 correspondents and photographers here were still bitter today corning the sudden British decision to refuse to allow them to witness the begins of the landings, on the grounds that their presence would encourage the deportees resist. According to present plans, the newsmen will be allowed to enter the dock a after the disembarkation has begun, peacefully or otherwise.

PARIS, Sept. 7. Emphasizing that the deportation of the Exodus refugees to Germany was "the rest blow to the hopes of European Jewry since the end of the Hitler regime," boldstein said that at the present time the UJA represents the only major instrutor preventing the complete collapse of the morale of the "Jows who have suffers to peated disappointments in their anxious search for freedom and security. "Until the doors of Pelestine are opened wide in the coming months, many of the remainflue of Europe will be doomed to the existence of outcasts and fugitives," Dr. Confetcin said.

"The United Palestine Appeal is the organization upon which great new responshillities will devolve in the implementation of the recommondations of the United Natius Special Committee on Palestine, particularly the provision for the immigration of 150,000 Jows to Palestine within the next two years," Dr. Goldstein added.

Morgenthau Says Situation of Europe's Jews Worse Than at End of War

"In many respects the situation of the Jews in Europe is worse than it was to years ago when there were no more than about 50,000 Jews in the D.P. camps ago that 250,000 today," he declared. "Those who manage to get to Palestine arrive mitiful condition, without any means at all and very often without any clothes on it backs." The UPA must have adequate resources to give the refugees who come to postine every opportunity to "take proper place in the constructive enterprise of dding the Jewish homeland," he continued. Mr. Morgenthau also pointed out that the Service for New Americans must expand its programs to provide for the needs profugees who are entering the United States at the rate of 2,000 a month.

Mr. Rosenwald told the Jewish leaders that "the entire world is watching United States for a cue in dealing with the refugee problem on a just and humano is. If we give asylum to our fair share of the homeless," he added, "other nations he impelled to do the same. By providing for the wide geographic distribution neucomers and their rapid adjustment to American life, the United Service for New ricans makes it possible for our country to keep its doors open."

A prediction that the colony of European refugees who have been stranded is Shanghai since before World War II will be practically liquidated in 1948 was ited by Mr. Rosenberg. "Shanghai will be the first major Jewish refugee problem to be cleared up completely since the end of the war," he said. "Only the existence the United Service program in this country is making that solution possible." Tugees from Shanghai are now arriving at the rate of 1,000 a month, Mr. Rosenberg ported, making San Francisco a new "port of hope" for survivors of Nazi persecution.
