#### FE FOR PALESTINE ARMISTICE DIM AT RHODES PARLET; BUNCHE SEES EGYPTIANS ON DEADLOCK

LOMDON, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- Prospects of an Israeli-Egyptian armistice receded day as it became apparent that the Rhodes conference was floundering in technical diffulties, Reuters reported today from Rhodes.

Dr. Ralph J. Bunche, acting Palestine mediator, saw the Egyptian delegation way in an effort to overcome differences which were barring the way to a meeting star in the day between the two military staffs.

Espect for the success of the conference, which for almost three weeks has an swaying between success and failure, had risen in the past few days as military itemstons got under way. But they fell again when the military chiefs rose after four-hour session last night without fixing the time for the next meeting, Reuters and high conference source said today that some progress had been made in the gut two days on drafting the armistice lines but had been halted by the adament stand toth sides on certain positions, the British news service reported.

Elias Sasscon, the Israeli delegation's expert on Arab affairs, returned here way after a fortnight's visit to Israel. Usually well-informed sources said his returnindicated that he might be expecting other Arab arrivals and wanted to be on hand to sive the delegation.

Dr. Bunche's legal adviser, Dr. Constantine Stavropoulis, who began a tour of the kmb capitals yesterdey, today arrived in Damascus where he conferred with Syrian hater Khaled el Azem. He is also expected to make contact with the U.N. Conciliation Commission in Jerusalem.

### U.S. COVERNMENT IS URGING ISRAEL AND FOIFT TO MAKE ARMISTICE TALKS A SUCCESS

WASHINGTON, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- The U.S. Government is urging both the Israeli in the Egyptian Governments to do everything possible to make the armistice talks those a success, a State Department spokesman said today. He emphasized that what pleas to this effect were made by the U.S. to representatives of both government.

The Egyptian Ambassador saw Secretary of State Dean Acheson on Saturday at its own request. Shortly before his visit Acheson had called in Israeli special repmentative to the United States Eliahu Epstein. The State Department, however, would its disclose the nature of their discussion.

# ISRAELI FRENIER APPEALS TO AMERICAN JEWS FOR "MANPOWER, MEANS, SKILL AND DEVOTION"

NEW YORK, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- A call to American Jews "as the biggest community all over the world" to make its contribution in "manpower, means, skill and devotion," to the Jewish state was issued today by David Ben Gurica, Israeli Fremier, in a message cabled to the opening session of the notional board of Hedeosah, which is now holding its mid-winter conference at the Fark-Sheraton Hotel hore.

Today's session was addressed by Eliezer Kaplan, Israeli Financo Minister, the appealed for the mobilization of funds to absorb immigrants in Israel. The session was also addressed by Berl Locker, chairman of the Jewish Agency executive in Jermals; Dr. Israel Goldstein, treasurer of the Jewish Agency; Israeli Consul General arthur Lourie and Mrs. Samuel W. Halprin, natical president of Hadasseh.

"Our task after the establishment of our state is only beginning," Premier Ben Gurien said in his message. "To bring over and absorb economically and socially hadreds of thousands of irrigrants, to rebuild and develop the Negev and Galilee and Jerusalem and to chape a progressive, free and democratic cornenwealth true to the great vision of our prophets on justice, peace and human brotherhood, will resulted the creative energies of our generation.

"American Jewry, as the biggest Jewish community all over the world, will have to make its contribution in rangewer, means, skill and devotion, and I trust that Hadasah will not only carry on its specific tacks in medical help and Youth Aliyah, but will also provide general Zichiem in America with he moral, unselfish and progressive leadership which it needs new so much, and that you will strengthen the ties between American Jewry and Israel," the necessge said.

#### Israeli Finance Minister Discusses Economy of Jevish State

The government of Israel has opened the gates, but only Jowry and men of good will can help us keep them open. The American Loan is purely developmental, extended specifically to make it possible for us to produce capital goods. That is why we are deeply interested in investment capital end determined to create an economic atmosphere which will attract such capital."

## TOUDATION OF CAMP FOR JEWISH REFUGEES IN ADEN IS REPORTED; 2,800 FLOWN TO ISRAEL

TEL AVIV, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- The Hashid refugee camp for Jews, which is losted some 15 miles from the city of Alen in the British protectorate of the same see, is being liquidated despite the fact that there are still some 700 Jews whom be British will not permit to go to Israel, it was learned here today.

In October of last year the camp held some 4,000 Yemenite Jews who were waite to go to Israel, including 700 who had fied to the camp after a severe pogrom in bothy of Aden. The Joint Distribution Committee and the Aden Government agreed to ransport the refugees, except for men of military age, to Israel. Since last year 2,800 persons, including over 550 orphans, have been flown to the Jewish state.

The J.D.C. is arranging air passage for the remaining 700 men and women who ment of military age, but nothing can be done for the others. In addition, the D.C. is paying the fare to Israel for about 1,000 Jews, not now in the camp, whom he mighs have threatened with deportation to Yemen.

### UNGE-SCALE EMIGRATION OF TRIPOLITANIAN JEWS URGED IN REPORT TO BRITISH JEWISH BODIES

LONDON, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- Large-scale emigration of Jews from Tripolitania was recommended today in a report to three major Jewish organizations here by Dr. B. Segal, who has just completed a tour of the country and a study of its Jewish population at the beheat of the three groups.

The report, to the Central British Fund, the Board of Deputies of British less and the Anglo-Jewish Association, declared that the 30,000 Jews in Tripolitania are suffering from a fear psychosis since the pogrom of November, 1945, in which over 10 persons died and hundreds were injured. The Jews have not yet received indemnification for damages and losses suffered in the rioting and many are completely destitute, Dr. Segal stated.

The position of the community as a whole is "very bad," Dr. Segal asserted, siding that instances of actual starration of Jows have been reported from outlying districts. He evaluated the day-to-day relief program of the Joint Distribution Committee and expressed the opinion that it was not yet operating on a scale sufficient to meet minimum requirements.

For those Jews who cannot emigrate, Dr. Segal urges "constructive relief," including grants and loans for the acquisition of raw materials and tools. Dr. Segal is now preparing a detailed report which will be discussed by the three organizations with a view to arriving at a joint program with the J.D.C.

#### RIMANIAN COURT SENTENCES TWO GENDARMES TO LONG PRISON TERMS FOR MUPDER OF 150 JEWS

BUCHAREST, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- Two former non-commissioned officers in the Rumanian military police were today scritered to 18 and 20-year prison terms, respectively, for the murder of 150 Jews in 1941. Two civilians who helped them rob the bodies of of their victims received 15-year sentences. In addition all the property of the four conticed men was ordered confiscated.

During the trial before a Bucharest court it was established that the gentames, Dimitru Doega and Leon Grumeza, had murdered the Jews in order to steal their personal possessions. They had been ordered to escort the Jews from the village of Siscenti across the Polish border.

#### EMIN, SOVIET ECONOMIST, IS AUTHOR OF ANTI-ZIGNIST FAMPHLET DISTRIBUTED IN MOSCOW

MCSCOW, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- A pamphlet in which a distinction was made between the Soviet attitude toward the state of Israel and Zionism, emphasizing the continued appoint on the Soviet Government to the Zionist movement even after the establishment of the Jewish state, is being distributed through bookstores and newsstands in the two and in other cities in the UNSR.

The author of the pamphlet is I.A. Genin, a Soviet economist, who last year delivered a public lecture on Palestine under the auspices of the Soviet Society for the Discemination of Political and Scientific Knowledge. The pemphlet which contains his lecture was published by the Society.

# MARION OF OVER-ALL JEWISH COMMUNITY IN U.S. URGED AT RECONSTRUCTIONIST CONFERENCE

HEW YORK, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- Declaring that "the present flare-up of interest Jewish life is bound to die down when Israel is no longer front-page news," Dr. meeal M. Kaplen, founder of the Reconstructionist movement, proposed the formation an over-all Jewish community in the United States, based on regional and zonal committies unting the functions of religion, Jewish education and recreation on the sel level "as the first step toward an organic Jewish community."

Addressing an all-day conference yesterday sponsored by the Jewish Reconstructuals Foundation, Dr. Kaplan pointed out that an urgent need exists in this country ran "organic Jewish community" based on religious culture as the link between the stee of Israel and the Jews of America and, also, to afford the best means of self-gression for American Jews. About 300 leaders of Jewish communities and national smitations attended the parley.

"The theory that a Jewish Palestine will radiate spiritual influence to Diastra Jews has to be translated into a tangible and feasible program of interaction, thereise it is bound to remain a pipe-dream," Dr. Kaplan declared. The conference toted a resolution recommending that the Jewish Reconstructionist Foundation appoint a cuittee of Jewish leaders to make a study of the next steps to be taken toward the clievement of an organic Jewish community, and that the committee report its findings a conference to be held in the fall.

#### MISH CENTER MEMBERSHIP INCREASED TO 458,000 IN 1947, J.W.B. SURVEY REVEALS

NEW YORK, Feb. 7. (JTA) -- Jevish Center membership during 1947 rose three arent over the preceding year to a high of 458,000, it was disclosed here today in a sort by the Jevish Center Division of the Jevish Welfare Board.

The total cost of Center operations increased 14 percent from \$8,207,000 in \$6 to \$9,361,000 in 1947, the statistical study revealed.
