MELI-LEBANESE ARMISTICE TALES ADJURNED TO THURSDAY; MAJOR ISSUES STILL UNRESOLVED

TEL AVIV. March 7. (JTA) -- The Israeli-Lebanese armistics conference was adsurned today until Thursday. The joint five-hour meeting took place on the Arab side

It was understood here that the major issues raised by both sides have not t been resolved. Henry Vigier and Gen. William E. Riley, civilian and military ides, respectively, to U.N. mediator Ralph J. Bunche, were present at today's meets and the former is reported to have presented new U.N. compromise proposals to oth delegations.

The Israeli Government still has no official notification that Syria intends to oin the agmistice negotiations at Rhodes, a Foreign Ministry spokesman said today.

The exchange of prisoners of war between Lerael and Egypt began today, as the delet. The total number of prisoners involved, it is understood, is 1,141 Egypans and 155 Israelis. A gang of armed Arabs who infiltrated Israel from the north ast night was captured by local authorities in Westorn Galilee and turned over to greeli Army authorities.

### eralli and transjordan delegations return to rhodes infer deparately with U.N. Medikior

RHODES, March 7. (JTA) -- Acting U.N. mediator Ralph J. Bunche met this afteron and evening with the Transjordanian and Israeli delegations following the return ere of Reuven Shilosh, Foreign Ministry head of the Israeli delegation, and the chief maniordanian delegate from consultations with their respective governments, a U.N. munique stated here tonight.

Dr. Bunche's meetings with the two delegations were conducted separately. dist sessions are not expected at the present stage of the negotiations.

Thus far, there has been no enswer to Dr. Bunche's query to the Iraq Governent as to whether Transjordan is authorized to represent it at the armistice negotiaions. The mediator refused to comment on a radio report that Iraqi Prime Minister uri es Said today denied in the Iraqi parliament that Transjordan had been authorized o speak for Iraq at the Rhodes parley.

The real block to the negotiations at present is not the Iraqi situation, but to sadden demand of the Transjordanians that certain specific military demands put forward by thom be considered early in the talks. The demands, if agreed to, would reats a situation highly dangerous to the security and sovereignty of the Jewish state, it is understood here.

Specifically, the Arabs demand: access to the Lydda airport; access to the wei from Jaffa to the airport; and, the cession of Jaffa to Transjordan. Beside detwiting from the general usefulness of the airport to Israel, agreement to those deands would mean the stationing of a strong Arab force on Tel Aviv's scuthern flank hile the Arabs in the "triangle" would menace the city's northern and eastern flanks. he frensjordanians have also demanded that the Israelis withdraw from the northern ogov or at least that the area he demilitarized.
