Delegation at U.N. Says Israel Has No Intention to Cross Transjordan Frontier

LAKE SUDDESS, March 9. (JPA) -- A spolusuan for the Aurenii delegation to the United Sections suphatically denied tenight that Immail forces had crossed the transforten frontier as reported today in dispatches from Ausen, the Transforden capital.

"Nowhere in the Negov are Israeli land or air forces operating outside the briers of Israel," the delegation attement declared. "They have not crossed, nor have they any intention of crossing the Transfordant Frontier at any time,

"On the other hand, dispatches from official Transfordan sources in Amman halp that the Transfordan forces have established positions illegally on Israel's territory. This fact alone," the statement concluded, "is responsible for any tention which may have arison."

The delegation's statement was issued following receipt of Amman reports that Israeli forces were righting toward Akaba, a town situated at the tip of the Gulf of Akaba, near the junction of Transjerdan territory and the scatter Relation territory senigned to the state of Terael under the United Nations partition plan.
