

# ARB-JEWISH CONFERENCE ON PALESTINE OPERS IN LAUSANNE UNDER UNITED NATIONS AUSPICES

AURANTE, April 27. (JEA) -- The preliminary Palestine peace conference, arranged by the U.N. Conciliation Commission, opened here today preceded by a meeting of the three members of the Commission under the chairmanship of Mark Ethridge, the U.S. representative.

Commission members said they expect the conference to continue for at least three weeks and possibly for three member. No formal agends has yet been arranged, since this vill depend on the preliminary exchange of views now taking place between the Israeli and Armb Oblegation.
