THE FLAG OFFICIALLY HOISTED AT U.H. HEADQUAPTERS; SHARETT ATTENDS CEREMONY

LAKE SUCCESS, May 12. (JTA) -- The blue-white flag of Israel, 59th state to be admitted to membership in the United Nations, was hoisted for the first time the in the semicircle of flags on the lawn of U.N. headquarters here.
