ISRAELI GOVERNMENT INTRODUCES BILL IN ENERSET FOR ABOLITION OF CAPITAL PURISHNESS

TEL AVIV. July 12. (JTA) -- A bill providing for the abolition of death sentences in Israel, except on grounds of treason when the country is in a war emer-

soncy state, was introduced today by the government in the Enesset. The bill stipu-lates that the maximum penalty should be life imprisonment. The Ministry of Justice presented to the Enesset the draft of a law under which the existing War Emergency Regulations should be enforced automatically when-

ever emergency conditions threatening the safety of the state arise. .

The draft of the projected law provides chiefly for the introduction of restrictions on individual freedom, imposition of consurship and authorization for officers to carry out administrative arrests. Members of parties opposing the government spoke in the Knesset against the proposed legislation.

The Ministry of Education today presented a bill to the Enesset providing for compulsory free education for children between six and 13 years of age. Severe messures were recommended against parents violating provisions of the bill.

The Ministry of Finance introduced a bill which recommends government financial aid to citrus grovers. Some form of loans will be granted on the basis of two percent interest while other types will carry a charge of 42 percent.

ISRAELI PREMIER CUTLINES FOUR-YEAR PLAN FOR ABSORPTION OF 750,000 IMMIGRANTS

PETACH TIEVAH, July 12. (JTA) -- A government four-year plan envisaging the arrival of 750,000 immigrants, with at least 100,000 of them settling on the land, was announced by Premier David Bon Gurion at the seventh congress of the Histadrut Agricultural Workers Union which opened here last night.

"Five hundred now settlements will be setablished for the new immigrants on 3,000,000 dunams of land," Mr. Ben Gurion said. "With planned, intensified agriculture designed to most the Tibhur's requirements, as well as provide a margin for oxport, the government will extend all necessary help to Israel's farmore." he said.

Addressing more than 300 delegates representing the Mapai, Mapam, General Zioniste, Hapoel Hamizrachi and Communist parties, the Israeli Premier reviewed the accomplishments of the first four months of the elected government. He revealed that the land area of lorest increased "peacefully by several million dumans." Asserting that construction costs were lowered during the period, Mr. Ben Gurion stated that 250,000 housing units are currently being erected, while the new state's industrial Nevelopment was enhanced through private capital investment from both Jowish and non-Jewish sources oversess.

Touching on the high cost of living, the Igraeli Premier cited the successful struggle being unsed to resolve this problem. He also pointed up improved communications in the Jewish state, and predicted that the Tel Aviv-Jerusalen railway would scon be reopened. Foundations were also laid for a system of compulatory free education for both Jewish and Arab children in Israel, he added.

"The government plans to build the largest possible Yichny with a very high standard of living, to attract equally Jose from rich and poor countries," Mr. Hen Gurion declared. The country's first defense line will be based not on military Corpes, but on the border agettlements," he emphasized. Mr. Ben Gurien also reviewed

plans for development of the Negev as an agricultural area, with the scuthern regionfronting on the Gulf of Ageba-becoming a center for fishing and shipping activity.

Mr. Ben Gurion also revealed that the government will soon submit to the Knesset a proposal to give agricultural training to Ieraell youths which, up to a given age, would be credited as most of their military service.
