## U.N. COMMISSION REDOMINED ARAB-JEWISH DIVISION OF JERUSALEM UNDER HIGH COMMISSIONER

LAUSANNE, Aug. 31. (7A) -- The U.N. Conciliation Commission will recommend to the U.N. General Assembly that both Inrael and Transjordan claims for full soversignty over part of Jerusalem be rejected.
