# EUROPEAN ASSEMBLY COMMITTEE VOTES FOR CREATION OF INTERNATIONAL COURT ON HIMAN RIGHES

STEMSCORS, Sept. 2. (JTA) -- A decision to create an international court for human rights was adopted here last night by the leading countties of the European Consultative Assembly following a long discussion. The decision was approved by a vote of 13 to 7. The opponents argued that no international court is needed in view of the fact that national courts in each country on enforce the human rights charter.

The committee also voted for the establishment of a commission of inquiry to deal with questions concerning the violation of human rights. This commission will refer the cases to the international court with the aim of enforcing a proposed the valve-point bill of rights by each of the marker states of the Council of Europe.

NEW YORK, Sept. 2. - Palestine received and settled 390,000 immigrants with the aid of the committed Palestine Appeal. of these, shout 250,000 ontered eince the setablishment of Eareal on May 14, 1985. Somo 35,000 of the immigrants in the ten-year period were children under the age of 15.
- One-hundred and forty now agricultural settlements were established in Palestine to house and provide employment for the immigrants, halping to lay the groundwork for the setablishment of the Javish state. These settlements were set up on land of the Javish National Fund, which sequired 1,603,392 dumme with funds provided by the U.J.A.
- 3. Approximately 200,000 Jewish refugees entered the United States. Of this number 120,000 were resettled and enabled to become self-supporting by the United Service for New Americans with the sid of U.J.A. funds. The bulk of these have already become American citizens.
- 4. During the war, whon non-military shipping was reduced to a minimum, more than 80,000 refugees were nevertheless transferred to Palestine, the United States said other countries from Ailloid and neutral nations to which they had escaped from Rati-coupled Europe.
