TML AVIV, Sept. 12. (JTA) -- An attempt to assessinate Premier David Ben Gurion and other sushers of the Inneal Cabinet was folled today when guards in the Ensesseb tweepwared a young Jew who aimed a loaded Sten gun at the Ministers of the Javidh state after jumping to the Speaker's platform from the visitors' gallery.
