PARES, Sept. 16. (728) — The Zionist delagation from Poland attending the European Zionist Conference here today reported that the Polich Government was permitting the free entigration of Jews leaving the country for Israel. Dr. Adolph Berman, told the conference that this policy is a "Consequence of the assistance given to the Jevich people by the new, democratic Foland in their fight for Freedom and Independence,"

Dr. S. Levenburg, London Zionist leader, expressed estisfaction with the attitude of the Polish Government on the question of Jorish migration to Imrael but condemned the "presentation of Lioniste" in Humany and Rammain. World Jowry now stands at the parting of the ways, he said, and it is necessary to unite Jovish communities throughout the world for the purpose of increasing the flow of immigration to Iranal.
