#### MUNICARY CANCELS TRADE PACT WITH ISRAEL: REGOTIATIONS FOR NEW AGREEMENT EXPROTED

TEL AVIV, Sept. 26. (JTA) -- The first trade agreement to be signed between another country and Israel has been denounced by Hungary, officials of the Ministry of Trade and Supuly disclosed today.

NEW YORK, Sept. 26. (JTA) -- A spokesman for Francis Cardinal Spellman today refused to comment on a report that the Cardinal had interceded with President Truman to have the city of Jerusalem internationalized.

The report, which emmated from Montreal, quoted the New.
