## JEWISH AGENCY CALLS UPON ZIONEST GROUPS IN U.S. TO GIVE "ABSOLUTE PRIORITY" TO U.J.A.

JENDRIEM, Sopt. 28. (JFA) -- All Zionist organizations and groups in the United States were called upon today by the Jovich Agency executive here "to give to the United Jovich Appeal absolute priority, cooperation and assistance in its campaign in behalf of Escal."
