# JEWISH AGENCY CLOSES YEAR WITH \$30,000,000 DESICT; EXECUTIVE SESSION TO STUDY PROBLEM

NEW YORK, Doc. 22. (FPA) -- The Jewish Agency will close its books at the end of 1949 with a deficit of \$30,000,000, Dr. Nehum Goldmann, chairman of the American section of the Agency, revealed here today at a press conference. He said the problem of covering this deficit will be one of the major questions to be discussed at the forthcoming session of the Jewish Agency executive which opens in Jerusalem on January 12.

Dr. Goldmann, who will proceed to Israel within a few days to attend the Agenover country meeting, said that the money raised by the United Jovieh Appeal in 1949 was only 10 percent below the total raised during the preceding year. He attributed this decrease not to any increasing apathy toward the causes supported by the U.J.A., nor to any deterioration in Zionist morale, but to the fact that the Silver-Morgenthau dispute resulted in a three-months delay in the Launching of the U.J.A. Grive.

As far as Israel is concerned, the U.J.A. campaign of 1949 had a less happy side as a result of the increased ellocations which local Jewish federations and welfare funds deducted for their local needs, Dr. Goldmann stated. He claimed that some federations and welfare funds ellocated for local purposes as much as 50 percent of the amounts raised by their campaigns.

Dr. Goldmann estimated that between 130,000 and 150,000 Jewish immigrants will enter Israel in 1950. This number, he said, will be increased in the event that agreement in reached with any of the Arab governments on permitting the migration of Israel-bound Jews from their countries. He added that little further immigration is expected from the IP camps in Europe. The Jews remaining there, he stated, would likely emigrate to other countries. The Jewish Agency is closing its offices in these camps, he revealed.

The session of the Jewish Agency executive, Dr. Goldmann reported, will also devote much of its deliberations to the problem of the future of Zionism and the need for remodding the program of the Zionist movement. The relationship between the Jewish Agency and the Government of Israel will occupy a special place in the discussions, he emphasized.

# United Palestine Appeal Board Reconstituted; Communities Represented

NEW YORK, Doc. 22. (JTA) -- Reconstruction of the United Palestina Appeal to difference to include representatives from 2% major communities and eight regions throughout the U.S. was amounced today by Judge Morris Rothenburg, U.P.A. acting mational chairman. The U.P.A. will now be directed by a board of 48 Jewish community representatives and 72 delegates of its constituent bedies—the Palestine Foundation Fund and the Jovish Mational Fund--totalling 120.

# IBRAEL STILL FACING DIFFICULTIES, BEN GURION SAYS; URGES WRITERS TO ENCOURAGE NATION

TEL AVIV, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Israel is still facing numerous difficulties, Fremier David Ben Gurion emphasized today in a message to the fourteenth annual contenence of the Authors Guild here. He appealed to Israel's writers "to encourage the nation to endure with sevenity our transfert hardedlys,"

Addressing the opening session of the conference last night, Yeacov Cohen, well-known Estrey poet, said that the U.H. decision to internationalize Jerusalem was "a fraud not intended for the purpose of protecting the Hely Places since both sides did not need an internationalized regime to enfoquerd them."

Emphasizing that Israel is as able as Turkey or Britain to protect the Holy Places, Mr. Cohen asled: "Would anyone think of internationalizing Rome because its Boly Places offer interest to other nations?"

A group of 104 Arab women and children entered Israel today after crossing the Lebanon border. They will rejoin their families in western Galilee. Israel customs authorities examined the party before allowing the Arabs to proceed to their deatinations.

## TURKISH DIPLOMAT SAYS U.N. DECISION ON JERUSALEM IS "WRONG AND IMAPPLICABLE"

ISTANBUL, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Husseyin Djahid Yaltchin, the Turkish member of the U.W. Palestine Conciliation Commission, today told representatives of the press here that he considers the United Nations decision to place Jerusalem under international trusteeship "wrong and inapplicable."

The Turkish diplomat said that the U.W. will have to modify its decision on Jerusalem in the very near future. Recent events have already proven that the decision could not be carried out, be added.

The opinion of Mr. Yaltohin with regard to the Jeruselem issue is generally shreet by political circles here as well as by the press. Articles appearing in Turkish newspapers emphasize that internationalization of Jeruselan against the will of Israel and Transjordan can never materialize. Nest papers favor an agreement on Jeruselan's status between Israel and Transjordan, with an international administration to safeguard the Bolly Filecos.

# Uruguayan Senete Hears Criticism of Jerusalem Decision

MONTEVIDEO, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Severe criticism of the decision of the U.N. General Assembly to place Jerusalem under international trusteeship was voiced in the Urugusyan Senate here today by Senator Dr. Paise Rezecs.

The Senator said that the decision of the Israel Government to transfor its offices to Jornselem is fully justified. He expressed estisfaction with the attitude taken by the Uruguayan delegation to the U.N., which strongly opposed the resolution to internationalize the Holy City.

# Swedish Government Thanked for Its Stand on Jerusalem at V.W.

STOCKHOLM, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- A mass meeting held here last night under the auspices of the Zionist Federation of Sweden voiced its thanks to the Swedish Government for this country's "just and dignified" stand on the Jerusalem issue at the United Mations. The meeting also voiced its solidarity with world Jewry in the fight for Jerusalem, "which is inseparable from Israel."

#### RUMANIAN GOVERNMENT SIMPLIFIES PROCEDURE FOR JIMS TO CORRECT OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS

BUCHARST, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Rumanian Jovs whose birth, marriage or identity records are incomplete, inaccurate or lost as a result of the war or anti-Semitio activities on the part of officials of the Rumanian Government before and during the war, will be able to rectify the errors end replace missing documents under a new, simple procedure announced here today by the government.

The new procedure, which entails no payment of fees, will permit Jows and color Rumanian sitizens to make documentary changes and corrections merely by stating the facts. This includes even name changes, the amountement in the Official Gasette said. The establishment of legal death certificates will undoubtedly facilitate many problems facing the Jewish population.

#### TURKISH GOVERNMENT TO PROMULGATE LAW CUTLINING JEWISH COMMUNITY ELECTION PROCEDURE

ETAMBUL, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- A new government bill outlining the procedure to be followed in elections in the Jewish and other minority communities in Turkey is due to be promulgated soon, it was reported here today.

Some months ago the government did away with the old system, under which the elections could not be held without the express permission of the governor of the city or district in which the elections were to be held. Under that system Jewish community elections in this city were not held for nearly two decades. It is expected that Jewish community elections will be held almost immediately after promulgation of the new law.

## TRACHERS IN YIDDISH SCHOOLS IN RUMANIA UPGED TO DISCARD "NATIONALIST EDUCATION"

BUCHAREST, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- A complaint that there are certain teachers in the Yiddish state schools who "have not yet thrown off the mentality of the bourgeois school and still have serious reminiscences of the nationalist education which they received when they were students themselves" was made today in an article published in Univer, organ of the Jewish Democratic Committee.

Fölia Barash, author of the article and inspector-general for Yiddish education in the Ministry of Education, cited the case of a Yiddish teacher employed in a state school who instructed his students in Hebrev, "not in order to increase the knowledge of his pupils, but in order to be able to carry on an activity of nationalist, Zionist propagadia."

### J.D.C. SPARES SHANGHAI JEWS FROM DP CAMPS IN ITALY; WILL TRANSPORT THEM TO ISRAEL

GENETA, Doc. 22. (FTA) -- The Joint Distribution Committee office here ennounced Last night that it will finance the voyage of the vessel Wooster Victorydue in Raples today-from the Italian port to Israel. The action was taken in response to a telegraphed appeal from some 375 passengers abound the vessel tringing them from Shanghhi which stated that they do not wish to be put in International Refugee Organization displaced persons camps in Italy.

MUNICE, Dec. 22. (FA) - German students today protested the showing of a Polish film dealing with Nazi atrocities in Poland during the war, including the tragedy of the Marsaw ghetto. The film is sponsored jointly by Joutha and Christian liberal groups in Germany who are attempting to recedurate the German people. The students walled out in the middle of the film sperims at it.

# FORMER GERMAN BISHOP CONVICTED AS NAZI; PROSECUTION LISTS HIS ANTI-JEWISH WRITINGS

EREMEN, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Dr. H.B. Weidemann, a former bishop and one of the leaders of the Frangelical Church in Germany, has been convicted by a Bremen densification court of having been a major Nazi. Among the various exhibits by the prosecution were a number of Dr. Weidemann's writings, some of which were considered anti-Semitic. The former bishop was tried in absentia. He is presently in the Soviet zone where he is mayor of a town and is a representative of the Socialist Unity Party.

Two of the defendants in the trial of a number of Marks who were convicted of desecrating the only synagogue in the Bavarian town of Markstedwitz several months ago have been released in 1,500 marks bail pending a review of their case. Bail—which amounts to about \$350 each—was granted by an American district court at Bavarenth.

#### POLAND HARGS ONE, CONDEANS FOUR OTHERS FOR MURDER OF JEWS DURING WAZI OCCUPATION

WARSAW, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- One Pole was hanged this week and four others have been condemned to death for the murder of Jews during the Mazi occupation of Poland.

A Gestapo informer, Josef Dlubak, was executed in Czestochowa, while Stanislav Payrotny, a murderej was condemmed by a court in the same city. In this city Alfons Grajewski and Antoni Packudzki wore sentenced to death for participating in the murder of Jews while the Kielce district court condemned former Gestapo Major Otto Busyng, who ordered the execution of over 1,000 Jews during the liquidation of the Kielce shotto.

## RUMANIAN OFFICIALS ATTEND UNVEILING CEREMONY OF MONUMENT FOR ANTIBILATED JESS

BUUHAREST, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- A monument to the victims of the German extermination camp of Oswicein was unveiled today in the Jouish cometery of the town of Sigiscare, Transylvania. In 1944, when the town was under Hungarian fastist rule; thus whole Jouish population was deported to Oswicein.

Today's coremony was attended by representatives of the local civil and military authorities, the Rumanian Workers Party, the Jevish Democratic Committee and the German Anti-Fascist Committee. The Latter organization is a board representing the German national minority in Rumania.

#### ISRAEL SENDS HANDEKAH TORGE TO MORGENTHAU; THANKS U.S. JEWISH COMMUNITY FOR AID

TEL AVIV, Dec. 22. (JEA) -- In a simple ceremony this afternoon, one of the torches borne by Hanukhah marathon runners to Herzl's Hill in Jerusalem yesterday-mad presented to Fremier David Ben Gurion, was handed over to a United Jevich Appeal representative here for presentation to Henry Morgenthau Jr., general chairman of the U.J.A. Mr. Morgenthau will accept the torch at a special coremny in New York.

Lt. Col. A. Yishai, who turned the torch over to the U.J.A. representative, said the torch was a symbol of Israel's appreciation for the outstanding efforts of the American Jewish community in behalf of its establishment, its independence and in the program of large-ocale absorption of immigrants.

#### DEPUTY MAYOR OF JERUSALEM ADDRESSES "SAVE JERUSALEM" HANDKKAH RALLY IN NEW YORK

NEW YORK, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Declaring that Jorusalem is "the capital of our people and the state of Jerusal," Reuven Schreitman, Deputy Mayor of Jerusalem, tonight pledged, in the name of the citizens of Jerusalem: "We will not yield to a decision, which lacks all morel basis and will not accept any government except that of Israel."

Mr. Schreitman, who is in this country on a mission for the Hietadrut, spoke before an overflow audience of 2,000 persons who attended a "Savo Jerusalem" Ennable featival held here under the auspices of the American Jewish Congress. Others scheduled to speak were Aubrey Eban, chief of the Israel U.N. delegation, and Dr. David W. Petegorsky, executive director of the AJ.C.

#### FIRST IBRAEL FLANE LANDS IN ENVLAND; MOT BY REPRESENTATIVES OF BRITISH GOVERNMENT

LONDON, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Impressive scenes marked the arrival today of the first plane of the Irrael airline Et Al at Heath Row, the London airport. The Landing of the Skymaster was witnessed by a group of more than 100 guests and government officials, including Air Marshal Sir John Dalbing, representing Lord Pakenham, Minister of Civil Aviation; dajor Rowse of the British Foreign Office; E.K. Higgins, Undersecretary of the Overseas Department of the Board of Trade, and A.G. Watson, the Israel charge d'affaires.

#### BRITISH OIL REFINERIES IN HAIFA SUSPEND WORK; LACK DOLLARS TO IMPORT CRUCE OIL

LONDON, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- The Haifa refineries will suspend all work tomorrow morning and 400 workers are to be discharged, Reuters reported from Israel.
The decision was due to the impossibility of getting supplies of crude oil which had
to come from South America and be paid for with dollars, the report said. The refineries, owned by Consolidated Refineries of London, closed down originally when the
British Army evacuated Palestine. Two months later they were taken over by Israel
authorities who returned them to British Managament lest March.

#### CATHOLIC SCHOOLS IN ISRAEL INTRODUCE STUDY OF HEBREM; TEACHING NOT OBLIGATORY

MEN YORK, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Some 15 Catholic schools in Jaffa, Remle, Haifa and Nazareth, so well as Jerusalem, have introduced the teaching of Hebrev in their curriculum in order to give their purils an opportunity to learn the language of the majority of Israel's citizens, Benjamin G. Broady, acting president of the Zionist Organization of America, reported today. Some of the teachers of Hebrev in the Cetholic schools are priests or nuns while others are Jews. The teaching of Hebrev, however, is not being made obligatory.

#### U.S. IMPORTS FROM ISRAEL IN NINE MONTHS TOTAL \$4,856,000; MOSTLY DIAMONDS

WASHINGTON, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- U.S. imports from Israel amounted to \$4,856,000 during the first nine months of 1949, the Department of Commerce reported today. Of the total, \$4,419,000 was made up of diamonds.

#### STRAGOGUE COUNCIL EXTENDS CERISTMAS CREETINES TO CERISTIAN COMMUNITY IN U.S.

MEW YORK, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- The Synagogue Council of America, representing all religious groups in American Jewry, today sent a message of greetings to Christians in this country in connection with the approaching Christmas holiday. The message, addressed to the Mattonal Conference of Christians and Jews, reads:

"At this season of the year the Christian community of the world is preparing to celebrate a festival which is not only one of the notable observances of the church, but is marked by great outpouring of human warmth and brotherly sentiment. The Synagogue Council of America, representing the religious forces of American Jeury, extends to the Christian people of our land the hearty good wishes of their jewish fellow citizens. May the coming holiday be to all who celebrate it a source of joy and blessing and may it corve to strengthen the ties of human friendship among all the children of God."

#### BAAC NAIDETCH, FROMINERY ZIOWIST LEADER, DIES IN PARIS; WAS 81 YEARS OLD

PARIS, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Issae Maiditch, prominent Zionist Leader and one of the founders of the Koren Hayesed, who resided in the United States since 1942, died here today at the Eotel Meurice. He was one of the most intimate friends of President Chaim Weizmann of Espael.

Born in Pinsk, Russia, in 1868, Mr. Maiditch was connected with the Zionist movement since he was 21. In 1907 he visited Falestine. Between 1913 and 1927 he served as a member of the executive of the World Zionist Organization. It was instrumental in obtaining support for the Ruttenberg electrification project in Falestine and was interested in exploitation of the natural resources of the Dead Sea. He also helped to establish an acquilitural bank in Falestine.

As far back as 1889, eight years before the first World Gionist Congress was convened, Mr. Maiditch, together with M.M. Ussichkin, the late head of the Jowish Mational Fund, founded the Sons of Zion Society in Moscow where he was residing at that time. A student of nedern Ebrew literature, he started writing Hebrew poetry and essays at the age of 18.

One of the wealthiest industrialists in Russia, he lost his fortume there after the Communist regime came to power. He moved to France in 1920 where he established alcohol and sugar factories and built up enother fortune which he lost when France fell to the Wazie. Upon his arrival in the United States in 1942, he settled in New York and took an eative interest in the Zufnish movement in this Zufnish occurry.

## MRS. VLADIMIR JABOTINSKY DIES IN NEW YORK AT AGE OF 65; FUNERAL TO BE HELD SUNDAY

NEW YORK, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Mrs. Vladimir Jabotinsky, wife of the late Revisionist Leader, died here early this morning. She suffered from a heart aliment for many years. She was 65 years old.
