ISRAEL CABINET DEFEATED AGAIN; ORTHODOX BLOC JOINS OPPOSITION IN VOTE ON GOVT. BILL

JERUSAEM, March 5. (JTA) -- The Israel Cabinet was again defeated today when Parliament by a vote of 47 to 44, rejected the Government's "Transition Bill" which amends the procedure to be followed in a partial reshuffle of the Cabinet, redistribution of portfolios, or the resignation of the Premier -- which is considered the Cabinet's resignation.

Members of the Religious Bloc voted with the opposition to return the bill to the government. Voting for the bill were the Manai Party, the Progressive Party and the Sephardic deputies.

Opening the session. Speaker Joseph Sprinzak read a letter from President Weignenn stating that after consultations with representatives of various political parties, and after a second approach by him to Premier David Ben Gurion to form a caretaker Cabinet," which failed, it is his "careful opinion" that the present Cabinet should remain in office "until new elections and the formation of a new Cabinet under a workable majority."

The Parliamentary Legal Committee reported that it has not as yet concluded its deliberations on the election law and will not be able to present its recommendations to Parliament before next week's session. This means that national elections cannot take place before the middle of June, since a minimum of three months must elapse between passage of the law and the holding of elections.

POLICE MOBILIZED IN JERUSALEM TO PREVENT RELIGIOUS DEMONSTRATIONS IN FRONT OF PARLIAMENT

JERUSAIEM, March 5. (JTA) -- The Israeli police have taken precautions to prevent demonstrations tonight in front of Parliament by religious groups opposing mobilization of woung women for service in agricultural settlements, if they claim examption from military service on religious grounds.

A proposal to smend the military service law to enable the government to mobilize Orthodox girls who have hitherto been exempt from any kind of compulsory service in Israel was presented conight to Parliament by Premier David Ben Gurion.

Presenting his bill to a tense and crowded house, Presser Ben Gurion declared that Israel, which is suffering from an acute manpower shortage, cannot rely on its army alone for defense. The entire nation, not just a part of it, must be mobilized, he said. In addition, he asserted, the move is necessary to weld a homomonus group of the various parts of the Jewish nation. He charged that the Religious Bloc is opposing the move for political, not religious, reasons, concluding that he would not permit a "political underground" to subvert a "vital national issue. (JTA) - Religious Jews in Israel in collective settlements today published a proclamation regudating the stend taken by the Chief Rabinat in opposing the mobilisation of women of military are for service in egricultural colonies. The proclamation also supported Premier David Ben Gurion's proposal for such mobilization on condition that conscripted women be assumed to service in religious settlements or religious immigrant camps.

The proclamation which was issued by the Hakibutz Hadati, central body of the religious collective settlements, points out that "the religious woman in Israel undernot training an pioneering agricultural work and participated in the defense of religious settlements in the War of Liberation as a full member and an equal partner in the struggle of the religious worker for the country's spiritual structure."

The Rabbinate's ban on compulsory service of religious women, "under the legest circumstances," is contrary to the aspirations of religious Joury as a patholic partner in Israel's upbullating and in the consolidation of the structure of the Jevish state," the document asserts. It expresses adherence to the resolution approved recently at the conference of the Orthodox Mirrachi Laborites which condened the drafting of young women into the Mahal, a semi-military youth organization.

EDAN REVRAIS DETAILS ON INFARL'S BOND ISSUE; TWO TYPES OF BONDS TO BE SOID IN U.S.

WASHINGTON, March 5. (JTA) -- Details of the Israel bond issue which will be floated in the United States were revealed here today by Israel's Ambassador Abba Eban, who said that two types of bonds will be sold.

The \$500,000,000 issue will include coupon bonds, offering three and one-half percent interest semi-annually, maturing in 15 years, and savings bonds which will appreciate in value by 50 percent in 12 years. Payments of interest and principal will be made by designated American banks in U.S. currency. All bonds will be sold at face yalue and will be available in various denominations. Purchasers may convert their bonds, at any time, into Israel currency at the prevailing rate of exchange with no restriction on the manner in which these funds may be used in Israel.

\$7,150,000 RAISED AT OPENING DINNER OF NEW YORK U.J.A.; VARBURS HUBORED

NEW YORK, March 5. (JTA) -- Contributions exceeding \$7,150,000, the largest sum ever collected in the initial stages of a United Jevish Appeal drive in any city, were amounced here tonight at the opening dinner of the U.J.A. of Greater New York. The sum was raised in the less than five weeks since February 1.

The guest of honor at the dinner was Edward M.M. Werburg, who became general chairman of the 1951 national U.J.A. after having served six times as head of the New York appeal. In recognition of his services to Jevry, Mr. Warburg was presented with an early American silver box. Messages of appreciation of his role were received from Israel's President Chaim Weismann and Presider David Ben Gurion.

The World Jewish Congress today announced the submission of a request that United Nations economical and technical assistance to underdeveloped countries be granted only on condition that such aid be "equally available" to all inhabitants without discrimination as to race or religion. The request was submitted by Dr. Manrice L. Ferlzweig, whe Wid.C. representative, to the U.W. Economic and Social Council now meeting at Santiago, Chile.

The American Jewish Committee today announced that Maximo Yazuysky, Lating American representative of the organization, left by plage for Santiago to attend the current session of the U.N. Roomonic and Social Council there. He will represent the Consultative Council of Jewish Organizations which is composed of the American Jewish Committee, the Amplo-Jewish Association of Britain and the Alliance Immalite Universelle of France.

JEWISH COMMUNITIES IN ITALY WILL FOLLOW WORLD JEWISH CHOUPS IN STAND ON GERMANY

ROME, March 5. (JTA) -- The Union of Jewish Communities has withdrawn its support of a proposed statement being drafted by the leftist Association of Political Titues of Fascian to condemn the rearmment of Germany. Stating that it opposes thesism and favors peace throughout the world, the Union added that it will express its opinions in conjunction with world Jewish bodies.

The Italian Association of Jewish Women, through the National Council of Ralian Women, with which it is affiliated, has addressed a protest to the Italian Remainst a bill pending in the Senate barring women from jury service. The Jewish women's organization insists that such a law would violate Constitution guarantees of equality of the serges.

JESS IN AUSTRALIA DISPROVE MINISTER'S CLAIM THAT ONLY THREE EX-NAZIS HETERED COUNTRY

MEDICHER, Australia, March 5. (JTA) -- Australian Minister of Immigration Bridd Bolt, whose program to admit 100,000 German "volksdeutsche" immigrants to Australia in the next four years has come under sharp attacks by Jovish, labor and liberal circles, has written to the Fracutive Council of Australian Jewry asserting that only three former Maris have entered this country as immigrants. He added that two of the three have since been despress.

The Executive Council, however, has submitted to him efidence that at least hi moun Mazis have entered Australia as immigrants. The body is also working on the cases of 100 immigrants believed to be former Mazis. The material is being placed before the government to support the Jews' contentions that present immigrant screening methods are imadequate.

DEMER CESTARO OFFICIATS SHAFERCED IN GERMANY FOR MISTREATING INMATES OF MAZI CAMPS

DARKSTANT, March 5. (JTR) -- Rudolf Hisfeld, former Gestapo official, and H. Lorent, former policemen and Gestapo official, were sentenced in criminal court here to 15 months and one year in jail, respectively, for mistreating Jews and other concentration camp prisoners during the Hazi regime. The two men were "specialists" in obtaining "confessions" from prisoners. Their defence was that they acted under orser from their squeriors.

ESMBLISHMENT OF CANADIAN-ISBAEL TRADING CORPORATION PLANNED BY JEHIBH CHOMPERATIONS

MATRIAL, March 5. (JTR) -- A nationwide organization that will ensure Canadian Jewry's full contribution towards the solution of Israel's pressing problems is now being set up under the leadership of Samuel Bronfman in connection with the convening of the Hational Conference for Israel and Jewish Rehabilitation in Montreal on March 25 and 26.

One of the first measures planned by the Conference is the setting up of a Canada-Israel trading corporation. Spokesman for the conference are hopeful that the corporation will find it possible to enter into an agreement with the Export Credit Insurance Corporation in Ottawa which provides proper insurance coverage and financing for exports to other countries. Under certain conditions this severment agency insures the oredit on export shipment for which export orders have been obtained, sentimes as such as 85 percent of the volume of shipment. Thus, a capital of \$1,00,000 enables the seller to handle annual transactions of \$13,600,000 on credit buying.

The Canada-Israel Trading Corporation will be established jointly by the Canadian Jewish Congress and the Zionist Organization of Canada, with a board of directors of 12 men selected from their principal officers.

DUTCH OSE COMMITTEE SHIPS EQUIPMENT AND PREPARRICATED BUILDINGS FOR CRECERS IN LEGAL

AMSTERDAM, Merch 5. (JTA) -- Complete egainment and prefabricated buildings for the erection of five oracles in Israel have been shipped by the Dutch OSE Committee to Haifa, it was announced today. The materials were purchased with a grant of 65,000 guilders made by the Dutch committee of the U.N. appeal for children to the Dutch OSE.
