WORK RESUMED IN HULEH REGION; ARMISTICE UNIT DEADLOCKED; TO MEET AGAIN TODAY

TEL AVIV, April 3. (JTA) -- Israeli workers today resumed drainage operations in the Helph area while the Israeli-Syrian Mixed Armistice Commission mot on the border to consult their governments. It is expected that both delegations will present to their governments suggestions for lessening the tension in the area and will receive further instructions.

When the meeting opened the Arabe immediately demanded that the commission order the Jows to reinstake the 650 Arabs evacuated from the Jevish demilitarized zone of the Haleh region. The armistice body, however, agreed with the Israeli representatives that the first matter to be considered was the Syrian firing upon Jevish workers. The Syrians then demanded that the Israelis suspend drainage operations, but the Israelis took the position that the Commission had no authority to rule on that matter.

Meanwhile, in Jerusalem, Fremier David Ben Gurion and Army Chief of Staff Tigal Yadin reported to the Parliamentary Security and Foreign Affairs Committee on the current situation in the Huleh region and outlined the position taken by the Israeli Coverment.

A new incident occurred in the Jerusalem area today when Arab Logion troops kidnapped three members of Kibbutz Retar. The Jews, encaged in ploughing fields man the border, saked Arab villagers on the Jordan side of the frontier if they might obtain some water at the Arabs' well. The villagers agreed, but when the Jews came arross to the well Jordan troops seized them.

As a result shote were exchanged across the border as kibbats members attempted to rescue their commades. United Nations observers, summoned to the area, established that the kidnapped Jows were safe.

U.N. Beompity Commoil Not Likely To Act On Syrian Complaint Against Israel

HEN YORK, N.Y., (JTA) -- Reliable sources here said today that it was not likely that the United Rations Security Council would take any artion on a Syrian protest against alleged armistics violations by Israel, until after U.N. officials on the spot has enhanced efforts at a solution of the dispute.

The Syrian complaint was received yesterday by the Security Council. It charmed Israel with violations in the Semilitarised wome between Syria and Israel by initiating draining projects on Labe Saleha. No meeting of the Security Council, which has just completed a series of semsions on Keshair, is scheduled.

BILLS FOR \$150,000,000 ATD TO ISRAEL REFERRED TO SENATE AND HOUSE FOREIGN COMMITTEES

WASHINGTON, April 3. (JTA) -- Rep. Joseph Martin, House Majority Leader, today introduced a bill in the House which would grant \$150,000,000 in financial aid to Israel. The bill is similar to measures submitted yesterday by House me tority Leader John W. McCormack and by 36 Sonators.

The bill introduced in the House yesterday has been sent to the House Committee on Foreign Affaire. The bill submitted to the Sonate by Son. Robert Taft and Sen. Ball A. Douglas was today referred to the Upper House's Foreign Relations Committee.

ERITISH FOREIGN SECRETARY RECRETS ISRAEL AND ARAB NATIONS ARE NOT YET AT PEACE

LONDON, April 3. (JTA) -- Foreign Socretary Herbert Morrison said last night that one of the ways in which Britain is trying to establish a stable peace throughout the world is by preacting the well-being of the people of the Middle East and by working for security in that area. He expressed regret that Israel and the Arab nations are not yet at peace.

Goorgo C. McGhoo, Assistant Secretary of State in charge of Middle East affeirs, arrived here from his trip to the Middle Eastern countries. Today he called upon high officials in the British Foreign Office and discussed with them the monoral situation in the Arab countries and Israel.

ALLIED COMMAND IN GERMANY TAKES OVER TASK OF TRACING MISSING RELATIVES

GENEVA, April 3. (JTA) -- The International Refuses Organization has turned over control of its international tracing service to the Allied High Command in Gormany, it was amounced here today by the headquarters of the I.R.O. The transfer marks the end of the active search for hundreds of thousands of people reported missing at the end of World War II, principally those who disappeared into Mazi concentration and slave labor cames.

During the three years of its existence, the tracing service established the fate of about 27,000 missing persons. To the Allied High Commission goes the task of completing the examination and processing of 100 tens of captured Rari documents which furnished the major class to the fate of the great army of people marked for extermination or slavery.

In amouncing the transfer, J. Donald Kingleoy, director general of the International Refusee Organization, called attention to the tribute paid the tracing service by the Governments of Israel, Belgium, Canada, United Kingdom, Denmark, Holland, South Africa and Swedom.

U.N. CHILDREE'S FUND ORDERS DOT FOR ISRAEL: TO BE USED FOR IMAIGRANTS FROM IRAQ

UNITED NATIONS, Now York, April 3. (JTA) -- The United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund today ordered from British manufacturers enough DDT to delete 60,000 immigrants in Israel. The organization acted immediately after receiving an urgent request for the chanical from the Israel Government which intends to use it for treating immigrants from Irag.

AUSTRIAN POLICE DISPERSE JENISH DEMONSTRATION AGAINST SHOWING OF ARTI-SENUTIC FILM

VIENA, April 3. (JTA) -- Ten Jaws were injured slightly today by police in Salzburg who used clubs to disperse a Jewish demonstration against the showing of the film "Demortal Belowed" produced by Yoit Harlen, who directed the Razi-made anti-Semitic film "Jew Suess." Five of the Jewish demonstrators were arrested, but were later released.

The Jewish communities of Salzburg and Vienna lodged a protest with the Ministry of Interior against the brutal action of the Salzburg police. The Minister of Interior promised an investigation.

34,000 GERMANS IN FRANKFURT PAYOR SHOWING FILM PRODUCED BY MAZI; 4,000 OFFOSE IT

FRANKFURP, April 3. (JTA) -- Nearly 34,000 Germans have voted in favor of e public showing for the film 'Immortal Boloved' produced by Voit Harlan, director of the Nazi-made anti-Semitic "Jew Smess," according to the results of a poll conducted here by a film distributing company and a leading cinema in Frankfurt which wishes to exhibit the film. Only 4,000 voted for beaming the film. Trade unions and many other democratic groups have protested violently against showing the film because of Harlan's past activities.

The Frankfurt District Committee of the German Federation of Trade Unions has declared that the methods used in the so-called poll were similar to those employed by the Maris in pulsescites. Altogether over 100,000 beliots were distributed by mail, but it was established by newmen that many families received no hellots while others received as many as nine beliots. The trade union group attributes the results of the poll to this and similar irresularities.

EVENILE COURT IN FRANKFURT ORDERS FIVE TOUTHS TO APOLOGIZE TO JEVISH COMMUNITY

FRANKFURT, April 3. (JTA) -- A juvenile court here let five young Germans off with a reprimend after ordering them to apologise to the Jevish community for overturning tombetones in the Jevish cometery a year ago.

The defendants pleaded not guilty, several asserting that they entered the cemetery only to chase out some children who were playing there. One insisted that he went there to read the Hebrev inscriptions on the stones.

Tive Germans formerly employed by the municipal government of Rembers have been arrested on charges of descreting a local Jewish cemetery. The five were said to have dux up the remains of Jewish dead in order to remove gold-filled dentures.

The Vienna Jewish Community has provided a modest financial grant for her. Despite repeated protests, the Amstrian Pension Office, citing Mrs. B.'s jail term, has refused to reconsider its decision.
