SRAEL DETERMINED TO REMOVE ARAB FORCES FROM DEMILITARIZED ZONE, SHARETT SAYS

JERUSALEM, May 1b. (JTA) -- Although Israel has accepted the cease-fire order ssued by the UiM. Security Council in connection with the Israeli-Syrian conflict, we problems still cause the Israeli authorities anxiety, Acting Premier Meshe Sharett old Parliament here today. These problems are: The Security of the Jewish settlements in the Semilitarized zone and the presence of Syrian para-military forces in that zone.

"The Covernment is resolved to do its utmost -- primarily with the assistance of the United Nations -- to remove such forces," Mr. Sharett said. He pointed it hat the Israel-Syrian conflict which seeminally broke out over the drainage of the high marshes by Israel "has its real roots in the unclear terms of the Israel-Syrian rmistics agreement and especially in Syria's exaggrated demands regarding certain high areas -- demands which Israel has always rejected and finally rejects today."

Reviewing the military developments, Mr. Sharett praised the Israel army mit which repelled the Syrian invadors under most difficult conditions, and spressed the sympathy of Parliament to the Dereaved families who lost sone, husbands and fathers during the fighting. The Israel-Syrian dispute, he reported, was aused solely by Syria's territorial ambitions which could not and would not be satisfied, he said.

"Israel's forces" he continued, "occupied large areas across the border furing the bettle, but withdrew from those areas to which Israel has no claim. Although not bent on expansion at Syrian expense, Israel is resolved to defend its resources and every inch of Israeli soil against Syrian aggression," he concluded.

An informal meeting of the Israeli-Jordan Mixed Armistice Commission was held here today to discuss cooperation between the authorities on both sides of the border to prevent infiltration and looting by Bedowins from Jordan territory and to return property stolen from Israelis which has been recovered by the Jordan authorities.

The Jordanians also made a complaint that during the Independence Day celebration last Thursday Israeli planes violated Jordan air space. The Commission, however, accepted Israel's explanation that the violation was unintentional.

Mr. Ben Gurion arrived here in the afternoon from Baltimore where he was honored in the morning by the Mayor and civic officials who welcomed him to the city. Es is proceeding tomorrow to Boston where he will be given a civic reception and will address a mass rally at the Boston Garden.

FREMIER BEN GURION WILL ADDRESS NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF UNITED JEWISH APPEAL

NEW YORK, May 14. (JTA) -- David Ben Gurion, P-ime Minister of the State of Isreal, will be the guest of honor and principal speaker at the United Jewish Appeal's extraordinary National Action Conference to be held in Chicago on May 26 and 27, it was ampoinced today by Edward M.W. Warburg, U.J.A. semeral chairman.

The two-day conference will serve as a national third anniversary celebration of Israel's independence, as a tribute by American Jewry to Mr. Ben Gunton's Leadership of the Jewish state, and as an emergency effort to plan the next steps for the rescus and transfer to Israel of tens of thousands of Jews from Rumania, Iraq, Libya and other parts of the world.

Determined to make the conference in Chicago the scene of one of the greatest tributes ever paid to a Jewish statesman, Jewish communities from coast-to-coast are assembling many millions of dollars in cash for presentation to Mr. Ben Gurion, it was revealed by Mr. Warburg. He said that on the basis of reports submitted by communities, the U.J.A.'s national leadership held high hopes that the cash gift to be made to Mr. Ben Gurion would be one of the most notable ever presented to a leading Israeli figure.

Dr. Joseph Schwartz, U.J.A. executive vice-president, today made public a report showing that 30,202 Jews vero moved from various countries to Israel during the month of April with the help of funds raised through the United Jewish Appeal. Of them, 21,472 were flown out of Iraq. A total of 80,000 Jews have been brought to Israel since the beginning of this year.

DR. SILVER RETURNS FROM ISRAEL TO U.S.; HONORED IN JERUSALEM PRIOR TO HIS DEPARTURE

JENUSALEM, May Mr. (JTA) -- Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, American Zionist leader, was honored by the Jerusalem municipality last night prior to his boarding a plane for the United States today. At a reception in his honor, following a four-day stay in the city and a tour of the surrounding area, Dr. Silver called for unity among the various political parties.

SE COMMUNITY IN MUNICH DEMANDS IMMEDIATE ACTION ON BAYARIAN RESTITUTION PROGRAM

MUNICH, May 14. (JTA) -- The General Assembly of the Jewish community of this this week-end demanded that the Bavarian restitution program be immediately put operation again.

The Assembly, at a formal meeting, accused the Bayarian authorities of antiitic bias in the manner in which they publicized the Auerbach case, pointing out t many similar scandals were given wither little publicity or were actually kept in the public. It appealed to Jewish organizations throughout the world to help I attention to anti-Jewish developments in Germany.

Meanwhile, rightist opposition deputies in the Bavarian Parliament have acsed Minister-President Hams Ehard of unwillingness to prosecute Dr. Auerbach, former ad of the Restitution Office, who is under arrest on sharges of fraud. One deputy, must Equasicity, of the Taitsche Gemeinschaft, charged that Dr. fears to procute Dr. Auerbach because the latter has documentary proof of the former's record of illaboration with the Waria.

From Frankfurt it was reported that the sum of 5,000,000 Deutschemarks will paid out over a period of four years to the brothers George and Homann Tists, Jewal owners of pre-Hitler Germany's largest department store chain, by "West Deutsche aufhof Aktiengesellschaft," This sum will be paid in settlement of a claim of 11,000-00 marks seked as restitution by the brothers, who loft Germany for the United tatas in 1976.

CSCANINI REPORTEDIN REFUSED TO CONDUCT AT SALZEURG FETE BECAUSE OF ANTI-JEWISH RICTS

VIENVA, May 14. (JTA) -- Arturo Toscanini and Bruno Walter, world femous confectors, are believed to have cancelled their engagements to conduct at the 1951 Selzburg Music Festival because of the recent anti-Jewish excesses by police and neo-Fazis in Salzburg, it was learned here today.

Austrian officials are quite concerned over the unfavorable reaction the incidents caused overseas. The head of the provincial government, Dr. H. Klaus, told the Selzburk council that the incidents have done the province much harm and will affect adversely attendance at the Balzburk festival because many American and British tourists have already cancelled reservations for the event.

FRENCH MILITARY COURT GRANTS AMERSTY TO ANTI-SEMITE WHO COLLABORATED WITH MAZIS

BARIS, May 1h. (JTA) -- A French military court today granted amnesty to Louis Ferdinand Celine, novelist and anti-Semitic Mazi collaborator during the occupation of Frence. Celine, who was sentenced to a prison term and conflication of his property in absentia, is now free to return from Holland to which he fled after the liberation.

His anti-Semitic ravings were considered by some to be worse than those of Julius Streicher, Hitler's top Jew hater. Celine worked under Otto Abetz, Mazi envoy to Vichy France, and preached the extermination of the Jews.

TWO GERMANS SERVERCED TO EARD LABOR FOR MURDERING JIS BURING MAZI REGIME

BERLIN, May 14. (JIA) - Erwin Benkendorf and Willi Boehme, assassins who were found suilty of murdering Jews in Germany in 1944, were sentenced by a jury here to 12 and 15 years at hard labor, respectively.

H COMMUNITY IN BOSTON CALLS FOR POLICE ACTION TO CHECK ANTI-SEMITIC GANGS

BOSTON, May 14. (JTA) -- The Mayor's Committee on Civic Improvement has been st upon by the Jewish Community Council here to take immediate action following ipt during the past few days of reports of new incidents involving Jewish youths attacking hoodlams in the Dorchester and Roybury area.

A public meeting which had been planned in Dorchester for tomorrow has been elled by the Community Council pending the action of the Mayor's Committee. In meantime, new disturbances were reported to have taken place at a terminal, result-in injuries to at least two Jewish boys and one bystander, a non-Jew, who came to assistance of one of the Jewish youngsters and was himself set upon by the attack-mans.

Quick action by Sermeant Abraham Morse, detailed by Police Commissioner Thomas Sullivan to handle incidents of this kind, has brought police reinforcements to the ubled area. Over the past weekend, reports of four separate incidents, all turning a the use of anti-Semitic remarks and involving physical injury, were received by local offices of the Anti-Permation Leggue.

The meeting, held at His Majesty's Theatre, was arranged by the United Zionist Council of Canada. Dr. Goldstein, who was the principal speaker, predicted that "in 25 years Israel will have 4,000,000 people and will be a harbinger of peace and prosperity to the entire Middle East."
