#### BEN CURION RETURNS TO ISRAELS SAYS DISCUSSED SECURITY PROBLEMS WITH U.S. GOVERNMENT

TEL AVIV, Jino 7. (JTA) -- Promior Devid Ben Gurion today returned to Israel from a three-week tour of the United States, where he helped launch the \$500,-000,000 Israel bond drive.

In a short nation-wide broadcast from Lydda Airport, where his Constellation landed, the Premier outlined the purposes of his journey to America and reported on the "splendid welcome and warm hospitality" he received in the U.S. He then told his listeners that "whoever thinks that the Israel Bond issue will interfere with the United Jewish Appeal is mistaken." Ho said that he had some to the U.S. to discuss political and security problems with the American Government and to strongthen the ties with American Jewry, which he said he found very sympathetic toward Israel.

The Premier's plane was picked up by an Israeli Air Force squadron some 30 miles off the coast and was escorted to the air field. When the plane came to a halt the tired but visibly happy Premier descended to be greated by Acting Premier KOshe Sharett members of the Cabinet, various municipal officials and representatives of several foreign governments. In addition, a good-sized crowd of spectators mathered at the airport where an honor muard composed or representatives of Israel's services presented arms and a military band played "Hatikvah." After his brief radio address, the Promier and his party were escorted to Tol Aviv in a motorcade.

In the Escenet, merrihilo, leftwing Socialist Mapam deputies and Communists have asked for a Parliamentary debate on the Premior's visit to the United States and his pronouncement on German rearmament.

The elections for Israeli delerates for the World Zionist Congress will be held next Wednesday, it was amounced today. The Parliament has decided not to hold any sessions next week, on account of the election campaign.

#### ISRAEL SUCCESSFULLY COMPARTING INFLATION; FOREIGN EXCHANGE BALCINES UP

TEL AVIV, June 7. (JTA) -- Israel is successfully combatting inflation, David Horowitz, director general of the Israel Ministry of Finance, last night told a public sathering here.

Listing the chief causes of inflation as immigration, security spending and housing expenditures, Mr. Horowitz said that the inflation was being brought under control by balancing the budget, controlling distribution, greater savings and the restricting of credit. He revealed that in the first quarter of 1951 exports yielded 3,700,00 pounds in foreign exchange as compared with 1,800,000 pounds for the corresponding period of last year.

### QUIET PREVAILS IN LANDSBERG FOLLOWING HANGING OF SEVEN TOP NAZIS FOR MURDERING JESS

IANDSHERG, Gormany, June 7. (JTA) -- Quiet prevailed here today following the execution during the night of the seven top Mazi wer criminals charged with the mess murder of more than 200,000 persons-mest of them Jows-in Poland and the Ukreine during the Gorman occupation.

The seven criminals, who carried out Hitler's policy of racial extermination, were hanged behind the heavily guarded walls of the Landsberg prison, the place where Hitler wrote much of "Moin Kanf." All walked to the gallows unaided. Two official photographers took pictures of each condemned man. A half-hour after the last hanging the wives were officially informed. Five of them had made arrangements to claim their husbands socies. The hanged men were!

S.S. Gen. Oswald Pohl, dostroyer of the Warsaw Cherto and thiof administrator of the Mazi concentration camp system which annihilated hundreds of thousands of Jows.

S.S. Gen. Otto Ohlondorf, who confessed that extermination units under his command slaughtered 90,000 Jows and others in the Soviet Union.

S.S. Gon. Erich Naumann, whose extermination force wiped out 3,530 Jews and Gypsies on the central Russian front in loss than a month.

S.S. Col. Worner Braune, who directed the massacre of Jews in the Crimea.

S.S. Col. Paul Blobel, responsible for the massacre of 60,000, including 33,000 Jows, in two days at Kiev in Soptember, 1941.

S.S. Lt. Hans Schmidt, adjutant at Buchenwald when 5,000 victims died monthly in that concentration comp.

S.S. Sgt. Goorg Schallormeir, roll-call leader at Muchlandorf, a subsidiary of Dachau concentration camp, who personally beat immates to death.

The seven were the last of 275 deemed by the United States War Crimes Tribunals of 1946-47. Leaders of the West German Republic search; in vain to persuade the American authorities to make another study of the cases. Twice a last minute stay was obtained by a defense attorney in Washington.

# AMERICAN JENISH ORGANIZATIONS OFFOSE ADMISSION INTO U.S., OF EX-MEMBERS OF NAZI UNITS

NEW YORK, June 7. (JTA) -- Former members of the Nazi Waffen S.S. units are inclinible for admission into the United States, under both the Internal Security Act and the Displaced Forsons Act, it is argued in a memorandum submitted today to governmental associate by a number of major Jewish organizations.

The memorandum maintains that under U.S. law all former Waffen S.S. members must be "excluded because they advocated and sesisted in racial and religious persecution, because the S.S. and Waffen S.S. of which they were members represented a movement hestile to the United States and its form of government, and because they voluntarily bere arms against the United States and its allies during World Wer II.

The memorandum was submitted by the National Community Relations Advisory Council in behalf of the American Jewish Committee, the American Jewish Commess, the Anti-Dofemetion Loggue of B'mai B'rith, the Jewish Labor Committee, the Jewish War Veterans of the U.S., the Union of American Hebrow Congregations and twenty-based of Jewish councils throughout the country.

(JTA) -- Radio stations in Mexico have agreed to eliminate from the air waves all material which in any way promotes projudice against any group on the basis of race, religion or national origin, it was learned here today. The greenent was reached with the active sponsorship of the Ministry of Communications.

#### 331 JEWISH COMMUNITY CENTERS NUMBERED 502,000 MEMBERS IN 1950. J.W.B. REPORTS

MEM YORK, June 7. (JTA) -- A record expansion for Jowish Community Conters throughout the United States in terms of facilities, agreement membership, and attadance at Conter activities was noted by Irving Edison, president of the Extient Jowish Wolfere Board, in the annual report of the agency for 1950 made mblic today.

During the year 1950, the JWE report says 502,000 persons of all age levels—from the pre-school child to the scale—belonged to 331 Joseph Community Contros effiliated with the National Joseph Welferr Board. These Contros wound facilities aggregately valued at \$40 million and operated on a budget aggregating \$11,700,000 for the nation. Total attendance at Center activities throughout the country came to 10,1660,000.

The work of the Centers and of JWB itself was profoundly affected by "new responsibilities thrust upon them in 1950 by the national emergency," the report emphasized. Unprecedented expansion of Jovieh Community Center facilities, coinciding with the developing national emergency, the JWB report points out, made possible the "fallost adaptation of Center programs and services to the modes of the nation's defense mobilization."

#### TEW YORK CITY EDUCATOR LAUDS ISRAEL'S EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM; PRAISES ORT SCHOOLS

HEW YORK, Juno 7. (JTA) -- A report on the educational system in Israel and the ORT schools there was given here last night by Dr. Jacob Greenberr, Associate Superintendent of the New York Board of Education, addressing a moeting of the board of directors of the American ORT Fodoration.

"I was amazed at Ieraal's knowledge of modern pedagogical methode,"
Dr. Groonborg stated. Discussing the ORT vectional training contern in perticular, Dr. Groenborg said that in view of the industrial needs and immigration

#### AMERICAN FEDERATION OF IABOR PLEDGES SUPPORT FOR GRANT-IN-AID BILL FOR ISRAEL

NEW YORK, June 7. (JTA) -- The American Federation of Labor has pledged its full support of a bill new before Congress for an American grant-in-aid to Irmel of \$150,000,000. In a letter to the American Trade Union Council for the Historut, A.F.L. president William Green said that the federation will "gladly cooperate with you in every possible way to secure passage of the bill."

The Hotel and Restaurant Employees and Bertenders International Union, A.F.L., has contributed \$210,000 to the Israel Histodrut Campaian for a special Histodrut housing project in Holon, a suburb of Tel Aviv, Isidor Laderman, executive director of the American Trade Union Council for Histodrut, announced here today. Mr. Laderman said that the street on which these houses are to be built will be named "Bake Emped Street" in tribute to the president of the International.

#### MEMBER OF ISRAEL DELECATION AT U.N. REPORTS IN ARGENTINA ON ARAB-JEWISH RELATIONS

BUENCS AIRES, June 7. (JTA) -- The Arabs admit Israel's military strength and know that they cannot destroy Israel militarily, but they hope the Jowish state will collapse through economic disruption caused by the immigration program, Gideon Raphael, a member of the Israel delegation at the United Nations, reported at a press conference here.

He caid that the Arabs oppose the Haleh drainage project because they hope to keep Israel from resettling some 40,000 immigrants on that land and thus relieving the economic crisis. The only time the Arabs will sime peace treaties with Israel is when they are convinced that their hopes of an economic broakdown in Israel are an illusion, Mr. Raphael declared. He added that further funds for the Jevish state would be a guarantee of speedier achievement of peace in the Middle Rast.

#### ISRAEL SPERT \$10,000,000 ON COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT; HALF OF THIS SUM SPERT IN U.S.

NEW ICER, June 7. (JEA) -- The Israel Government has spent about \$10,000,000 on communication equipment and more than one-half of this sum was spent in the United States, Israel's Patterstor General declared here today following his arrival on an El-Al plane.
