## ARGENTINE GOVT. ACCEPTS PART OF ISRAEL'S REPLY ON EICHMANN CAPTURE

JERUSALEM, June 6. (JTA) -- The Argentine Government has accepted part of the Israeli Government's reply to its request for information on the capture of Adolf Eichmann, it was learned today, but has taken exception to other parts and may send Israel a further note on the subject.

The Argentine authorities, it was said here, accepted Israel's explanation of how Eichmann came into Israel's hands. They were reported displeased, however, by Eichmann remarks that numerous Nazi leaders had found refuge in Argentina and were still in hiding there.

Preparations for Eichmann's trial, it was learned today, may take considerably longer than the six to eight weeks originally estimated and may take as long as six months. Eichmann therefore is unlikely to go to trial before next year. The trial itself, it was predicted, might continue as long as six months in view of the enormous number of documents and the quantity of evidence unearthed.

### Israel Denies Report That Eichmann Attempted Suicide

TEL AVIV, June 6. (JTA) -- A London newspaper report that Adolf Eichmann had attempted suicide by bashing his head against the wall of his cell was flatly denied here today by Commander Abraham Selinger, head of the Sixth Bureau which is conducting the investigation of the Eichmann case.

Selinger insisted that there had not been any attempt by Eichmann to take his life. According to reports here, Eichmann's cell is padded to prevent the prisoner from harming himself.

Indications that Eichmann will be formally charged with crimes against the Jewish people--a capital offense under Israel law--were given last night with the disclosure of details about the secret arraignment of Eichmann before a magistrate earlier in the day. The Nazi was brought before Magistrate Alfred Back of Haifa in a specially prepared chamber at the prison where the Nazi official is being held. He was ordered remanded for another period of 15 days.

Assistant Commander Ephraim Hofstater, deputy head of the Sixth Bureau, appeared before the magistrate to ask for the remand. He also asked for a court order under the terms of the laws against crimes against humanity and against the Jewish people prohibiting publication of information on Eichmann's place of detention or security arrangements. The magistrate granted the remand requested by Hofstater and the security order.

### Eichmann Hears Charges Against Him; Has Nothing to Say

Commander Hofstater told the magistrate that Eichmann was charged with crimes against the Jewish people under the Nazis and Collaborators (Punishment) Law and crimes against humanity under another provision of the same law. In his affidavit to the court, made public later, Hofstater said: "I have reasonable ground for charging the accused with the above offenses and hereby request the extension of his detention for a period of 15 days."

This was the second detention order made against Eichmann, the first having been issued by Magistrate Yedid Halevi in Tel Aviv on May 23. Eichmann, it was reported later, listened attentively to the charges which Hofstater translated into German. When asked by the magistrate whether he had anything to say, he replied he had nothing to say.

Magistrate Back, a native of Silesia, received his degree in law in Germany but was barred from practice by the Nazi regime after 1933. His parents and many members of his family perished at the hands of the Nazis.

### Norway Holds Israel Should Try Eichmann; Justifies Capture

OSLO, Norway, June 6. (JTA) -- Norwegian thought, as reflected in private and official views in the local press and radio, holds that Israel should try Adolf Eichmann.

In the Norwegian view, Israel was justified in the extraordinary measures necessitated to take Eichmann into custody. Norwegian public opinion is that Israel would conduct the trial rather than extraditing the Nazi to West Germany.

## NIXON REJECTS SUPPORT OFFERED BY LEADER OF 'AMERICAN NAZI PARTY'

WASHINGTON, June 6. (JTA) -- Vice President Richard M. Nixon repudiated today support offered him in his presidential campaign by George Lincoln Rockwell, leader of the "American Nazi Party."

Herbert G. Klein, special assistant to the Vice President, said Mr. Nixon's views on Nazism were in the same category as his reaction to Communism. Referring to Rockwell's advocacy of the Nixon candidacy, Klein said that "all Americans should join in opposing any man who stirs up bias and hatred." He recalled Mr. Nixon's visit to the Warsaw Ghetto last year and said the Vice President was very moved by the experience.

In a public meeting here yesterday Rockwell asserted that his group would campaign for Nixon. He denounced the Federal Government as riddled with Jews and bracketed Jews and Communists.

For the first time since Rockwell began holding public rallies Sunday afternoons near the National Archives Building, police yesterday forbade him to use the loud-speakers which carried his voice to thousands of tourists strolling in the area.

Rockwell has announced that his organization will picket the Israel Embassy, the White House and the United Nations on June 11 to protest alleged Israeli "persecution" of Adolf Eichmann, the Nazi war criminal. Rockwell also boasted yesterday that members of his "Storm Troops" included men on active duty with the United States Armed forces. He said a marine who had been arrested a week earlier was in yesterday's demonstration and defied the authorities to do anything about it.

The Marine Corps has said that as long as the "American Nazi Party" is not on the Attorney-General's subversive list, it cannot prevent members of the corps from affiliating with the party. The Department of Justice said last week it was reviewing the status of the Rockwell organization.

## GOLDA MEIR RECEIVES DOCTORATE DEGREES FROM TWO UNIVERSITIES IN U.S.

MADISON, Wisconsin, June 6. (JTA) -- Israel's Foreign Minister Golda Meir today received an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from the University of Wisconsin at the university's annual commencement here. A similar degree was conferred yesterday on the Foreign Minister by Smith College, Northampton, Mass.

Mrs. Meir was guest of honor last night at a reception in Milwaukee tendered jointly by the University of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin Society of Jewish Learning. The Israel Foreign Minister lived in Milwaukee before she emigrated to Palestine, and attended the Milwaukee State Normal School, now the University of Wisconsin. She was described by the chairman conferring the degree as "one of the truly great women of our contemporary world."

The Wisconsin university citation read: "Golda Meir, because in your long and distinguished life of public service, you have been true to the highest ideals of patriotism; because you have fought courageously to protect human dignity in a troubled world; and because our University would like to claim some small share in shaping those early dreams and hopes to which your later life has given vitality and substance, I am happy to welcome you back to Wisconsin and to confer upon you the honorary degree, Doctor of Laws."

## WORLD SEAFARERS UNION DEMANDS FREE NAVIGATION THROUGH SUEZ CANAL

LONDON, June 6. (JTA) -- The seafarers section of the International Transport Workers Federation appealed to the United Arab Republic Government to honor its international undertakings by renouncing action against ships in the Suez Canal and placing reliance on the procedures of the United Nations.

In a resolution approved by the seafarers section at a conference concluded here yesterday, the delegates called upon seafarers throughout the world "including those of the Arab countries" to support this appeal by addressing themselves to the United Arab Republic Government in similar terms and by urging their own governments to make representations to the same end.

The conference also rejected as "totally inadequate" the justification of international interference with neutral shipping on the grounds of a state of war between Israel and Egypt.

## RENAULT FAILS IN CAR SALES IN EGYPT DESPITE WITHDRAWAL FROM ISRAEL

PARIS, June 6. (JTA) -- The latest figures of Renault Company's export sales show that less than a handful of cars were sold in Egypt since last October when the automobile company withdrew from Israel as the price of removal from the Arab boycott list.

## JEWISH AGENCY EXECUTIVE OPENS PLENARY SESSION; HAS 40 POINTS ON AGENDA

JERUSALEM, June 6. (JTA) -- The Jewish Agency executive opened its plenary meeting today to discuss problems connected with the Zionist Congress to be held in December. The meeting of the executive has 40 points on its agenda embracing all problems of the Zionist movement and organization.

## FIVE JEWISH SCIENTISTS REPORTED WINNING HIGH AWARDS IN MOSCOW

PARIS, June 6. (JTA) -- Five Jewish scientists have been given the Lenin Prize, one of the most important awards in the Soviet Union, according to a Moscow report in the Communist Yiddish press here today.

The five named are: M. Shlomovitch, a scientist in an electromagnetic laboratory attached to the USSR Academy of Science; Jacob Dzipkine, a director of technical sciences; S. M. Feinberg, chief of one of the atomic energy sections; Madame Biderman, dean of an advanced technical school; and A. J. Levine, identified as a scientist who contributed toward the construction of the new Russian plane, the Ilyushin-18.

## NAZI WORLD HEADQUARTERS RAIDED; LIST OF 800 NEO-NAZI GROUPS SEIZED

FRANKFURT, June 6. (JTA) -- World headquarters of a large, international neo-Nazi organization were uncovered by Hessian state police near here, immediately after a proposed world congress of neo-Nazis and neo-fascists, scheduled to have been convened during the week-end at Wiesbaden, was called off.

The congress organizers, headed by Friedrich Klein, had announced previously that 800 representatives were expected at the Wiesbaden parley from groups "all over Europe." As soon as the time for the opening of the congress had passed, and Klein announced that the sessions had been "called off," Hessian state police raided the headquarters of the "German Social Movement," which Klein heads. The congress is believed to have been canceled because of insufficient response from those invited.

State Prosecutor Fritz Bauer, announcing the raid, disclosed that membership lists, publications and documents, showing the worldwide ramifications of the group, were found in Klein's headquarters. Among the lists discovered in the raid was one containing the designations and addresses of 800 fascist and neo-Nazi groups in West Germany and abroad including Africa and Asia, all of which had been invited to the scheduled Wiesbaden congress.

According to Dr. Bauer, an effort to unify the various ultra-rightist groups, through formation of an international "roof organization," was made May 12, when a preliminary conference was held at Bad Nauheim. The Wiesbaden congress plans, the prosecutor said, was an outgrowth of the Bad Nauheim meeting. Klein is well known as a former leader of the Hitlerite youth movement. He succeeded recently to the leadership of the German Social Movement after the death of the organization's previous leader, Heinz Priester.

## AUTHOR OF FASCIST RACIAL MANIFESTO HONORED IN ROME; JEWS DISPLEASED

ROME, June 6. (JTA) -- Professor Nicola Pende, official author of the Fascist racial manifesto proclaimed by the Mussolini regime in 1938, as Italy's counterpart of the Nazis' racist Nuremberg laws, will be honored with an award of a gold medal at ceremonies scheduled to be held here tomorrow on Capitol Hill, it became known today.

The medal has been voted by the International Committee for Unity and Universality of Culture, which cited the Fascist author for his "great cultural and scientific achievements." Italian anti-Fascist and Jewish circles here today expressed "surprise" and "disapproval" of the award and of tomorrow's ceremony.

## GRAVE OF KARL MARX IN LONDON DESECRATED WITH ANTI-SEMITIC SLOGANS

LONDON, June 6. (JTA) -- The monument over the grave of Karl Marx, first Socialist theoretician whose work, "Das Kapital," is the foundation of Communism and Socialism, was vandalized last night. The grave is in Highgate Cemetery.

Unidentified persons daubed swastikas on the stone bright yellow paint and anti-Semitic slogans in German. The only slogan in English was: "I love Eichmann." Cemetery workers who discovered the vandalism called police who said the incident could have been the work of youths.

## JEWISH GROUPS PROPOSE SPECIAL U. N. STUDY ON BIAS AGAINST MINORITIES

PARIS, June 6. (JTA) -- A proposal that a special study be undertaken on discrimination against minority groups was made here today by Jewish organizations attending the current meeting of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization.

The proposal was made by representatives of the Consultative Council of Jewish Organizations. According to the proponents of the new study, such a worldwide survey would complement other studies already undertaken for UNESCO by non-governmental organizations having consultative status in UNESCO.

## PREMIER OF GERMAN STATE INAUGURATES NEW JEWISH HOME FOR AGED

NEUSTADT, June 6. (JTA) -- A new Jewish Home for the Aged, one of the most modern of its kind in West Germany, has been inaugurated in ceremonies attended by Peter Altmeir, Premier of the Rhineland-Pfalz state. P. Rodan, representing Israel, and Willy Thyssen, Mayor of Neustadt, also attended.

## B'NAI ZION ANNUAL CONVENTION ADOPTS DECLARATION ON POLICY ISSUES

MONTICELLO, N. Y., June 6. (JTA) -- A declaration of principles, asserting the organization's "leadership relative to continued activity in behalf of the world Zionist movement," was adopted here last night at the closing session of the 51st annual convention of B'nai Zion, the American fraternal Zionist organization.

The declaration called for "furtherance of mutual understanding and ties of friendship" with Israel; "strengthening of the bonds of fellowship between American Jewry and others in Israel and elsewhere; economic aid to Israel and aid to absorption of refugees there; and furtherance of Hebrew culture, education and language, and Jewish traditions, in the United States."

The declaration stated further: "We proclaim our position as a non-political body, neither affiliated with nor identified with any political grouping in our country, in Israel or elsewhere. We welcome into our ranks members of all shades of opinion, united under the banner of Americanism and Zionism."

Binyamin Eliav, Israeli Consul-General in New York, addressed the convention's final luncheon, telling the 500 delegates: "Israel is making progress in establishing friendly, mutual ties with the new nations in Asia and Africa. This progress, which is even more marked in Africa, is, in effect, a breakthrough in the Arabs' political blockade of Israel and in the latter's effort to isolate Israel. We are confident that, in the not too distant future, the economic blockade will be broken, enabling Israel to play a still greater role in the general development of the Middle East."

## PHILADELPHIA STUDY SHOWS TEXTBOOKS FAIL TO PRESENT NAZI ATROCITIES

PHILADELPHIA, June 6. (JTA) -- A study of 22 world history and social studies textbooks, used in public high schools and private secondary schools in Philadelphia, shows that "the majority" of the books "fail to give adequate historical facts about Nazi racialism and genocide," The Jewish Exponent reports.

The Philadelphia Commission on Human Relations called for a re-examination of history texts last winter, after 52 anti-Semitic incidents had taken place in Philadelphia, as part of the worldwide wave of swastika-smearings that followed the daubing of the synagogue in Cologne, Germany, last Christmas Eve. Such a re-examination is now being carried out by the Philadelphia City Board of Education. The Commission itself has named a committee to contact private and parochial schools with requests for re-evaluation of history textbooks.

One textbook cited by the Exponent has this to say about the mass murder of Jews under the Nazi regime: "Thousands of Jews, including old people and small children, were herded into prison camps. Many died there." The writer raises the question whether such a statement "could give a youngster a true idea of the dangers of Nazi racialism."

## 100 RABBIS, EDUCATORS AND CANTORS GRADUATE FROM H. U. C. - J. I. R.

NEW YORK, June 6. (JTA) -- More than 100 rabbis, cantors and educators who completed studies at the New York School of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion were graduated today at ordination and commencement services at Temple Emanu-El.

Dr. Nelson Glueck, College-Institute president, who ordained the rabbis and invested the cantors, presented honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degrees to Judge Horace Stern of Philadelphia, retired Chief Justice of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court, and to U.S. Court of Appeals Judge Henry J. Friendly of New York. Ephraim E. Lisitzky of New Orleans, Hebrew poet and translator of Shakespeare into Hebrew, was awarded the Doctor of Hebrew Letters degree.

## MOSHE KATZ, U.S. JEWISH JOURNALIST, DIES IN MOSCOW; VISITED FAMILY

NEW YORK, June 6. (JTA) -- Moshe Katz, well known American Yiddish journalist, and one of the founders here, in 1922, of the Communist Jewish newspaper Morning Freiheit, died in Moscow this week-end, of pneumonia, according to dispatches received here today. He was 75. He went to Moscow last week to visit his daughter there.

Born in Dokhitz, Russia, near Minsk, Mr. Katz came to the United States in 1913, and worked in non-Communist Yiddish newspapers here. After the Bolshevik revolution, he returned to Russia, and edited a non-Communist Yiddish newspaper in Kiev. He later returned to this country. He was the author of several books in Yiddish, among them biographies of I. L. Peretz, Sholem Aleichem and Lenin.

Funeral services for Mr. Katz will be held in Moscow tomorrow, arranged by the Writers Association there. The body will be cremated in the presence of surviving members of the family, including the widow who traveled with Mr. Katz from New York to Moscow.
