had been imposed more than a year ago for the attempted hijacking of a Soviet sirliner was described by

an American Jewish Congress spokesman as "part of a Soviet propaganda campaign to prepare the world for the Limitent show trial and punishment of 34 Jews whose only crime is their desire to make their home in Israel." Richard Cohen, associate executive director of the Congress, said that the delay in the show trials, originally scheduled to take place in November and now set for Dec. 15, "may well have been caused by the Soviet regime's desire to launch a more extensive effort to whip up public opinion on the hijacking issue." He said that the year-old hijacking sentence, reported several days ago by UPI Moscow's correspondent, Henry Shapiro, apparently did not involve Jews but rather a family headed by one Galina Slovenchik. But he warned that the 34 Russian Jews charged with air piracy would face the same peralty as that imposed on the Slovenchik family.

The two El Fatah men, one of them trained as a diver in Red China and the other as a seaman in India, each received 20 years' imprisonment for smuggling arms and explosives into Israel by sea. A 25 year sectence was imposed on their companion, a former resident of Acre, who served as their guide. He was charged with arms smuggling and plotting to shell Haifs port with Katvusha rockets mounted on a boot. The other two were planning to detonate explosives at the oil refineries north of Haifa. All three were captured last month when their craft, bound from Latakia, Syria with arms and explosives, was intercepted by an israeli Navy natrol boat in Israel territorial waters off Ras el Nakira. The court reduced their request for prisoner-of-war status. An Israeli-owned citrus packing house in Gaga was damaged last night when an explosive charge detonated near a packing machine but it continued to operate today. The

Two Arab-Inspired Resolutions Not Much For Israel To Worry About, Israeli Sources Say UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., Dec. 7 (JTA) -- Israeli sources today described two Arab-inspired revolutions passed Friday evening as anti-Israel but not much for her to worry about. One of the drafts -- spon sored by Afghanistan, Guines, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mali, Mauritania, Pakistan and Somalia -- stated that "the people of Palestine" deserve "equal rights and self-determination" and that "full respect for (their) inalienable rights...is an indispensable element in the establishment of a just and lasting peace in the Mid die East," It was approved in Special Political Committee by a vote of 46-19 with 17 abstentions, Israel

and the United States were among the opponents; Britain and France abstained. The other draft--sponsored by Afghanistan, India, Mali, Mauritania, Pakistan and Somalia -- "calls once more" on Israel to repatriate the refugees immediately. It passed by a vote of 83-7 with 12 abstentions. Israel voted against the draft and the U.S., Britain and France voted for it. The Soviet Union and the Arab bloc voted for both

measures. Israeli sources said that the eight-nation draft was "bud from our point of view" and that their goverement opposed the six-nation draft "for obvious reasons -- we cannot admit large numbers of refugees for very vital, valid security reasons." But the sources added that the measures will likely have little effect and be quickly forgotten, as they "to not introduce any new political facts." The resolutions now

go to the General Assembly. The Special Political Committee also approved, by a vote of \$1-0-2, a U.S. draft stressing the "critical" financial plight of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugoes in the Near East (UNRWA), Israel abstained. The committee approved, by 97-0-3, a 17nation draft calling for continued "humanitarian as sistance" to the 1967 refugees and issuing a "strong appeal" for funds for UNRWA, Israel voted in favor,

High School Teachers Continue Strike; Reject Latest Government Offer JERUSALEM, Dec. 7 (JTA) -- Israel's striking high school teachers have rejected the latest govern-

ment offer to end their month old walk-out and have stopped tutoring 12th grade pupils who must take their matriculation examinations early next year. The teachers had agreed two weeks ago to continue to hold classes for the 18-year-olds in the hope that the strike would be settled. But yesterday's offer by the Cabinet was termed unsatisfactory by spokesmen for the 5000 teachers although it was said to contain several concessions. The Cabinet agreed that any wage increase granted the teachers would be retroactive to April 1, 1970. Union leaders will meet with Premier Golda Meir tomorrow in what they described as a final attempt to reach a settlement. Shalom Levin, chairman of the elementary school teachers union warned yesterday that its members would strike if the high school teachers' demands are not met
