CARTER ADMINISTRATION UNVEILING

MASSIVE ARMS AID FOR ARABS

WASHINGTON, Dec. 9 (JTA) — The Carier Administration is unveiling a massive arms program for thee of Issuel's Arab neighbors that includes about \$3.5 billion in credits for Egypt, up to 200 fanks of the M-60 class for Jordan, and advanced munitions for Saudi Arabia, Informed sources reported.

Saunders, Assistant Segretary of State for Near-Eastern and South Asian Affairs. Concern And Skepticism

Last year, the Carter Administration, provided Egypt with 30 F-5E waptanes. This was port of the \$2\psi billion warplane package that included Israel and Saudi Arabia. Early this year, the Carter Administration allocated \$1.5 billion in weaponry as part of the Egyptian-Israeli peace treaty. SCHINDLER URGES CHANGE IN JEWISH LAW THAT A CHILD'S RELIGION IS DETERMINED ONLY BY THE RELIGION OF THE MOTHER

TORONIO, Dec. 9 (JIA) — A revolutionary change in Jewish Law that would regard the child with a mixed marriage as Jewish, if either parent was Jewish, was proposed by Rabbi Atexander Schindler, president of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations (UAHC), at the UAHC's 55th General Assembly meeting here.

Some 4000 delegates, representing nearly 750 Reform synagogues in the United States and Canada, heard Schindler call on the Reform movement to change the 2000-year-atd-lewigh tradition that a child's religion is determined by the religion of the mother. He urged the validation of Jewish lineage through the paternal as well as the maternal line.

Schindler's proposal was rejected today by both Chief Rabbis of Israel but hailed by a leading American Conservative rabbi. Ashkenazi Chief Rabbi Shlomo Goren told, reporters, in Jerusalem. That Schindler's proposal was aimed at. "the wind" pipe of Judaism." It's meaning was the destruction of Audaism. Sephardic Chief Rabbi Ovadia Yosef said he was not surprised to hear such a proposal coming from the Reform movement. He cited the Talmud as saying: "The son born to a gentile, is, likewise a gentile.

Hailed As A Courageous Idea

Rabbi Harold Schulweis, of Encino, Calif. secretary of the Rabbinical Assembly, hailed Schindler's proposal as "a courageous idea that goes to the heart of the struggle for Jewish sucvival. "Schulweis who addressed the convention delegates on another subject, told reporters who asked him for his comment on Schindler's proposal that it "deserves the most serious study and consideration." He said the suggested change was "based on the reality principle — the growing intermarriage rate among young Jewish people."

For this reason, Schulweis said, "I believe the Conservative movement is morally and judicially bound to respond to the deep concerns of the Jewish laity on this matter as expressed by a serious and responsible Jewish statesman. "Regarding the child of a mixed marriage as Jewish f either parent is Jewish also aims at overcoming "what amounts to a sexist distinction," Schulwe said, adding that "limiting the child to the religion of the mother is in fact discriminatory

against the father.

"A child who is raised by a Jewish father who takes his or her father's name, who adopts the Jewish Lifestyle and Jewish identity of the fother - this child has a right to be considered Jewish and in such a case the religion of the mother is no longer relevant, "Schulweis said.

Cites Internarriage As A Major Factor

In his presidential address-last Friday night, Schindler declared: "the status of Jewshould be conterred on any child; either of who parents is Jewish, provided they both agree to raise their child Jewishly and do so. " He called on the congregational, rabbinical and seminary bodies of Reform Judaism, in cooperation with the Conservative movement, to "initiate a decision-making process" that would lead to valida-tion of Jewish lineage through the paternal as vell as the maternal line.

A major factor cited by Schindler in urgingthe historic change is that the Jewish intermarriage rate is currently approaching 40 percent with the "prepanderant majority" of such marriages involving Jewish men and non-Jewish women.

"The right of these men to determine the religious character of their children must be se cured, "he said. "Here is still another way to make certain that our grandchildren will be Jews, that they will remain a part of our community and share the destiny of this people Israel." He added: "I want the child's rearing and ultimately his or her self-definition to be on a par with geneological factors in determining Jewishness. And I want the geneological factors to be paternal as well as maternal.

Schindler conceded that a "tradition stand-Ina two millenia should not be altered lightly" but he said that the circumstances which gave rise to that "time honored usage" no longer applies. The tradition of Jewish lineage on the maternal side only, he said, reflected a polyga-mous society in which the children of the various

wives lived with their mothers

We no longer live in such a society, in part at least because in the 11th Century, Rabbi Gershom issued an edict that changed the Hatacha and outlawed polygamy, "Schindler said. The matriffical tradition was reinforced by "brutal persecution" during the Middle Ages, " Schindler said, when a "compassionate law" permitted children of women who had been raped to be considered as Jewish.

Confronted With A Dreadful Anomaly

In the absence of such persecution today, Schandler said, "adherence to the matrilineal prin-ciple confronts us with a dreadful anomaly; the offspting of a mixed marriage, whether reared as a Jew or hot, is automotically a Jew so long as the mother is Jewish. But if the mother is not Jewish, the child must ultimately undergo formal conversion even if he or she is mised as a lew and lives in an intersety Jewish home, "he said. "This is nonsensical, aboutd."

Schindler said he also saw the issue as part of the "strugale for the equality of the sexes, major precept of Reform Judaism. In this instance he said, "we are trying to protect the rights of men." Citing robbinic sources, he said that Jewish tradition provided, "ample justification for a paternal as well as a maternal yardstick." He explained that "tradition invokes the God of our fathers in prover. It rules that we be summoned to the Torah by our father's name. It reminds us that we live by Zechut Avot (the merits of our fathers). " Schindler also observed that in ancient Jewish Law, only the paternal line is held relevant in matters of inheritance and some aspects of gene-

For example, he said, whether one is a Kohen (priest) or a Levite depends on the father's priestly claim and not on the mother's. "Thus does tradition offer a way to heal itself, "he said. In urging that the matter be studied by the Reform mover Central Conference of American Rabbis and by the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion as well as by the Conservative movement, Schindle acknowledged that "we must always be restrained

by a reverence for the sensitivity of Klal Yismel, the Jewish people."

BEGIN ASSURES WIA CONFERENCE THAT PROJECT RENEWAL WILL PROCPED

NEW YORK, Dec. 9 (JTA) -- A message from Premier Menachem Begin of Israel declaring that "Project Renewal will proceed actively and energetically in the context of the government s new economy measures" highlighted the United Jewish Appeal's national conference here this weekend. The message was delivered at a leadership dinner at which UJA national chairman Irwin Field reported that the 1980 regular campaign total to date of \$115 million represented "the largest amount of money raised, in the most communities, at the earliest date since the 1974 campaign, which began immediately following the Yom Kippur War. "The 1980 drive seeks a regular campaign increase of some \$100 million, Field said, with maximum additional pledges for Project Renewal the social rehabilitation program designed to re-juvenate the lives of 300,000 immigrants living in Israel's distressed urban areas.

ARABS DENY ELON MOREH LAND SALES

"JERUSALEM", Dec. 9 (JTA) -- Some 20 Arab landowners from the environs of Elon Moreh swore solemally at emeeting with their mulkifur latt. Friday that they had not sold their lands to Jews. The ceremony followed Israeli press and radio-reports to the effect that several dozen dunams of land had in fact been sold secretly, and that Jews with the active involvement of Agriculture Minister Ariel Sharon and the State Lands Authority which is under his jurisdiction — hoped to buy up a total of 20 dunams (50 acres). That size of that would be sufficient, according to Jewish sources, in sustain a settlement at Elon Moreh.

In light of the swearing ceremony, East Jerusolem newspapers yesterday published firm denials of the largiteless reports in building and Jewish sources insisted, nevertheless, that the reports were true. They said the sales had not been recorded in the Land Registry as yet for fear of the vendors being murdered. (The sales would be valid even without registration.) Haaretz reported today that the Treasury had earmarked IL 10 million to finance these purchases.

ADL REPORT SHOWS INCREASE OF ASSAULTS

NEW YORK, Dec. ? (JTA) — Assauls ggainst Jewish institutions, cemeteries, houses of worthing and private property have more than doubled this year-compored to 1978, according to a national, audit conducted annyally by the Ann Detamation League of B "na" B'rith.

The findings, mode public last Friday at the ADL executive committee meeting here revealed 129 reported incidents in 1979, against. 49 in 1978. The incidents include desecrations, swastika daubings, onti-Jewish graffitt, arison attempts and firebombings. Of the 129, 51 were attacks upon homes and stores owned by Jews, the ADL said.

According to Nathan Perhautter, ADL's director, the 1979-figure is the second highest since the worldwide swaptika epidemic which by gon in Cologne, Germany, at the end of 1959 and triggered 819 anti-Jewish incidents in this country during 1960 and 170 incidents in 1961. During the rest of the 1960's and through 1977, the average anti-Jewish episodes per year was about 45.

The ADL audit is based on reports gathered by the AQL's fact-finding and research departments through its 27 regional office; throughout the country. Perlmutter pointed out that since some incidents go unreported, the Total is higher than the audit shows.

Breakdown Of Incidents By States

The report revealed that the largest number of 1979 incidents, 38, occurred in New Jersey, New York State was next with a total of 26; California had 15; Massachusetts; 14; Arizona, 11; Florida, seven; Michigan and Nebroska four each; Kansas, three; Indiana and Rhade Island; two each; Connecticut, North Carolina and Oktoboma, and expert

Perlmutter noted that the increased manifestations of ani-Semitism corresponded with the U.S.—Justice Department's report of a 450 percent increase in racially-motivated vandalism over a six-month period this year as measured against all of 1978.
